## Oba Ewuare Elementary School Project

We have a total of 26 school children. Eleven of these children are from the families we started small scale businesses for. These children are ages 3-12 years old. The other fifteen children are those who started school but are being sent home due to lack of support and maintenance with school supplies/fees.

Our school project formerly started in September 2018, and we currently have six families in America who volunteered to sponsor some of our children for one-time donation of \$100.00 and \$25.00 monthly to maintain each child throughout the academic year with school supplies. Some of our school kids are still waiting for individual sponsorship.











### 8 Established Small-Scale Businesses

During LYNRMII's awareness kickoff in January 2018, two families of twelve people were rescued.

Established a small-scale business for the mothers in both families and LYNRMII fed each family of 6 for two and a half months in order to give their businesses the opportunity to grow.

We rescued additional one family with 4 children in May 2018. The mother in this family was doing a little business where she was selling Kerosine. Unfortunately, her two-year-old toddler drank the Kerosine and died. Her tragic loss broke my heart.

We rescued a young man with a chronic illness of epileptic seizures by supplying him 9 months' worth of anti-seizure medications.

LYNRMII rescued a young man who graduated from fashion and design school but no money to set it up. We have helped him to start up the fashion and design business.

LYNRMII set up a small-scale business for a widow who is a mother of 6 children to enable her support her family.

LYNRM-N Chapter leaders and I visited a sick woman who was admitted at Benoni Hospital and we supplied her arthritis medications and multivitamins. In addition, we gave her money to add to her discharge hospital bills.


We Rescued two farmers: one started a poultry farming, and she is doing very well; this Christmas season was a huge sale for her business. The other one maintains palm plantations and harvest is pending.

LYNRMII also engages in an ongoing collection of personal items (clothes, shoes, cooking utensils books, etc) that we ship at intervals to assist our poor families.

Our VP, Pastor Charles Omoregbee visited our Love Your Neighbor families in August 2018. ### Christmas 2018 and Rice Drive for the Families of LYNRMI-N













- 6. On-going assessment of our small-scale businesses and individual readiness to handover their capital funds to other families that we intend to rescue for 2019. Initial assessment will occur in May during the first mission trip and the second assessment will occur during our second trip before the end of the year.
