- At your leisure drive your antique vehicle on a route around the museum's large campus.

- Watch a Model T Ford assembled from a pile of parts in just minutes.
- Possibly show your car in a Pass in Review, where a number of the cars are introduced to the spectators.
- Join other special presentations and demonstrations.
- Participate in fun activities geared for kids or the entire family.
- Join a Saturday evening social geared to all participants and their guests.

The CFOC is not a "static" car show, and there is no competitive judging. Hot rods and modified vehicles are not eligible. *Space is limited*, so register now. A description of your vehicle, accompanied with a picture, will help speed the application process. You will be notified as soon as possible if your vehicle has been accepted. At that time you will be asked to submit payment of \$30 per vehicle which includes passes for the driver and three guests.

There will be ample parking for your truck and trailer. Trailer parking and on-site check-in will be open as early as the Friday evening before the event. Camping and hotel accommodations are a short drive away.
