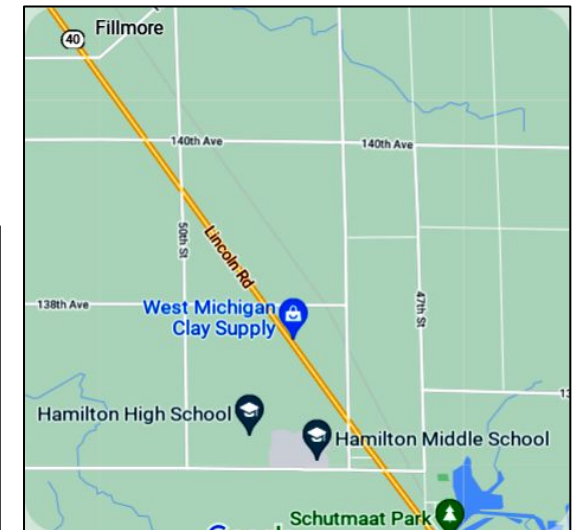
From Kalamazoo: Take 131 north to Otsego exit. Go west on M-89 through Allegan. M-89 goes west and M-40 goes north to Hamilton. West Michigan Clay is one-half mile north of 136th, the Mobil gas station on the right hand side. If you get to 138th you've gone too far!

From Grand Rapids: Take I - 196 (Ford Freeway) to Allegan exit 49. Go south on M-40 about 5 and one-half miles. West Michigan Clay is just past 138th Street, on the left.

A white firing, high temperature plastic body. Very fine white porcelain grog enhances strength and throwability.

182-182G WHITE STONEWARE (CONE 6 - 10)

Near white plastic stone ware body. Good for use with bright glazes. 182G is the same as 182 with the addition of fine grog. Gives a toothy clay that many potters prefer.
