LOW FIRE CLAYS (CONE 06)	
	<p>EM-103 CLAY (CONE 06) A smooth, plastic, white body with a small percentage of talc to create an optimum glaze fit. EM-103 is very popular among production potters and is also excellent for handbuilding. It's "forgiving" nature has also made EM-103 a white clay choice for many teachers. EM-2134 clear glaze is formulated to work well with this clay body. Avg. Shrinkage 2±% , 8.2% Avg. Water Absorption 1±% , 11.1%</p>
MID FIRE CLAYS (CONE 5-6)	
	<p>WC-391, B-3 BROWN CLAY (CONE 5) A pliable clay with smooth grog. Great for sculpture (use a high gloss glaze when making dinnerware). Color comes from manganese and iron. Fires almost black when in oxidation. It is not recommended to fire this clay in reduction. *Do not fire past Cone 5 Avg. Shrinkage 2±%: 10% Avg. Water Absorption 1±%: 3%</p>
	<p>WC-401 B-MIX CLAY (CONE 5) B-Mix 5 offers the same characteristics enjoyed by our Cone 10 B-Mix. Its smooth, porcelain texture is a pleasure to throw and form, and it fires to a cream color in oxidation. Avg. Shrinkage 2±% 12.0%. Avg. Water Absorption 1± 2.75%.</p>
	<p>WC-436 B-MIX CLAY (CONE 5) Similar to WC-401, with a very fine grog. The addition of grog makes for a more forgiving body with a slight texture and minimal speckling. Avg. Shrinkage 2±%: 11.0% Avg. Water Absorption 1±%: 2.75%</p>

	<p>WC-403, SPECKLED BUFF Clay body specifically formulated by request from Midwest and Eastern U.S. potters. Low in sand and grog content, speckled buff is smooth textured.
