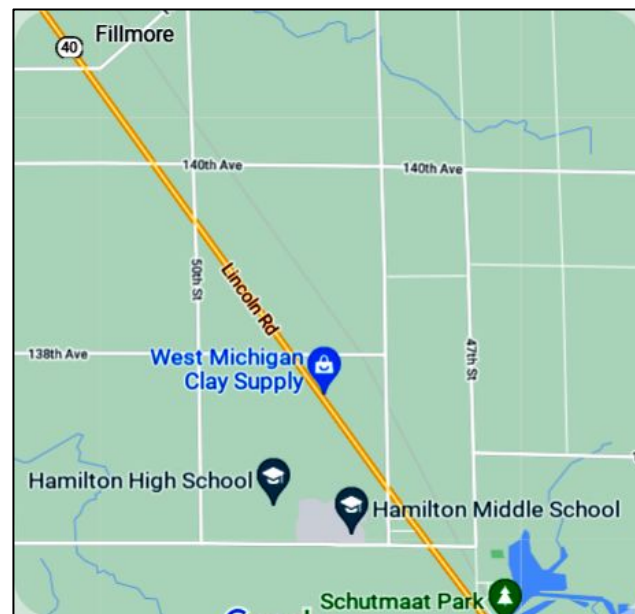

**From Kalamazoo:** Take 131 north to Otsego exit. Go west on M-89 through Allegan. M-89 goes west and M-40 goes north to Hamilton. West Michigan Clay is one-half mile north of 136th, the Mobil gas station on the right hand side. If you get to 138th you've gone too far!

**From Grand Rapids:** Take I - 196 (Ford Freeway) to Allegan exit 49. Go south on M-40 about 5 and one-half miles. West Michigan Clay is just past 138th Street, on the left.

## LOW FIRE CLAYS (CONE 06)



### EM-103 CLAY (CONE 06)

A smooth, plastic, white body with a small percentage of talc to create an optimum glaze fit.

EM-103 is very popular among production potters and is also excellent for handbuilding. It's "forgiving" nature has also made EM-103 a white clay choice for many teachers. EM-2134 clear glaze is formulated to work well with this clay body.

Avg. Shrinkage 2±% , 8.2%

Avg. Water Absorption 1±% , 11.1%

## MID FIRE CLAYS (CONE 5-6)



### WC-391, B-3 BROWN CLAY (CONE 5)

A pliable clay with smooth grog. Great for sculpture (use a high gloss glaze when making dinnerware). Color comes from manganese and iron. Fires almost black when in oxidation. It is not recommended to fire this clay in reduction. \*Do not fire past Cone 5

Avg. Shrinkage 2±%: 10%

Avg. Water Absorption 1±%: 3%



### WC-401 B-MIX CLAY (CONE 5)

B-Mix 5 offers the same characteristics enjoyed by our Cone 10 B-Mix. Its smooth, porcelain texture is a pleasure to throw and form, and it fires to a cream color in oxidation.

Avg. Shrinkage 2±% 12.0%.

Avg. Water Absorption 1± 2.75%.



### WC-436 B-MIX CLAY (CONE 5)

Similar to WC-401, with a very fine grog. The addition of grog makes for a more forgiving body with a slight texture and minimal speckling.

Avg. Shrinkage 2±%: 11.0%

Avg. Water Absorption 1±%: 2.75%

## MID FIRE CLAYS (CONE 5-6)



### WC-403, SPECKLED BUFF

Clay body specifically formulated by request from Midwest and Eastern U.S. potters. **Low in sand and grog content**, speckled buff is **smooth textured**. An **excellent throwing body**. The color palette is perhaps best described as 'desert' or 'Southwest'. Fired in oxidation, Speckled Buff **falls into the tan/brown color range**.



### WC-408, B-MIX CLAY WITH SPECKLES

This clay has the same working properties as your favorite B Mix WC-401. This is a mid temperature, smooth, porcelainous stoneware that is very plastic and workable. This clay prefers slow drying and ample compression on rims and bottoms to avoid cracks.



### WC-608, #60 CLAY (CONE 6)

Speckled tan in oxidation and slightly coarse, this clay is compounded to be a stoneware clay with specks that bleed through the glaze, giving the appearance of iron burning through, typical of reduction glazes and clays. A very popular throwing clay for production potters who want to add the speck dimension to their ware.

Avg. Shrinkage 2±%, 10.9%

Avg. Water Absorption 1±%, 1.7%

## HIGH FIRE CLAYS



### WC-379, B-MIX CLAY (CONE 8-10); WC-893 (WC-379 with grog)

A premier, cream- white, throwing clay that is easy to throw and form. Smooth porcelain texture. Fires gray/white in reduction and lighter in oxidation.

Avg. Shrinkage 2±%, 13%

Avg. Water Absorption 1±%, 1%

**WC-893** is the same as **WC-379**, but with the addition of very fine grog. The addition of grog makes for a more forgiving body with a slight texture, minimal speckling and less shrinkage.

Avg. Shrinkage ±2%: 10.3%

Avg. Water Absorption ±1%: 1%



### WC-899, B-MIX WOOD FIRE CLAY (CONE 13)

A specially formulated version of Laguna's popular B-mix body for wood and salt firing.

Takes Salt and Soda well and exhibits very nice flashing characteristics in wood firings. Holds up well in Cone 12 atmospheric firings. Sample tile exhibits results in a wood-fired kiln.

Avg. Shrinkage 2±%, 13%
