

#### The Rocklin Library is more than books

If you are applying for a job, and you want help with your resume, head over to our website:

www.placer.ca.gov/library. There you will see a resource called Brainfuse. Once you set up your account, you can upload your resume and have expert advice on making it more compelling within 24 hours on working days. There are many other job search resources there, too.

Does your child need some reinforcement in reading or math skills between classes and tutoring sessions? Check out Brainfuse. Among the many resources for students, there is live online tutoring. All tutors are trained, located in the U.S. and have had background checks. Students can upload papers and within 24 hours (working days) get back useful notes for improvement. There are lots of practice tests, too.

When I was on jury duty recently, and running out of reading, I got out my tablet and downloaded a few ebooks from the placer County Web Site. You don't have to actually go to the library to get great reading material. An e-audiobook on your smart phone can make a wait at the airport much more bearable. But there are plenty of reasons to go to the library besides books. Some are storytimes, volunteer opportunities, and a comfortable, clean space to work with your portable device using our wifi, or our networked computers.

I see plenty of articles lamenting that children are growing up glued to computer or smartphone screens. But even those digital natives love our train table. They also enjoy interactive toys on the wall and felt boards.

And we do have books, too. Every month we get new titles. The Friends of the Library have an ongoing book sale, too.
