#### From the Library

The Institute of Museum and Library Services released its latest Public Library Survey in 2012, though the data is from 2009 and 2010. (Budgets have been dropping ever since 2007.) The California Public Libraries snapshot shows each full time library staff member is serving over 3,000 population, and financial and resource numbers are down from 2009 to 2010 though circulation is up in the same period. Expenditures per capita were \$32.63, and circulation per capita was 6.35 items, or an average value of roughly \$107.00 per capita, not counting computer use, programs and other library services and materials. For this calculation I use the price of \$17.00 as an average book price.

The report also includes this information on library funding nationwide: **Total operating revenue of public libraries and percentage distribution of revenue, by source of revenue and state: Fiscal year 2010**, which reports that an estimated 84.8 percent of public libraries' total operating revenue of \$11.3 billion came from local sources; 7.1 percent from state sources; 0.5 percent from federal sources; and 7.6 percent from other sources, such as monetary gifts and donations received in the current year, interest, library fines, fees for library services, and grants.

The local, state and federal sources are all governmental. This might surprise some of our customers who have told me they thought the library was funded mostly by fines and the Friends of the Library. Vital though the Friends of the Library are, they do not have the resources to shoulder a large portion of the library budget.


