## CONTRAINDICATIONS

## Doctors clearance needed if:

- History of hemophilia
- Diabetes(can cause healing complications and increased risk of infection)
- History of epilepsy, seizures, fainting or narcolepsy
- Active Rosacea, Eczema, or Psoriasis in the procedure area
- Prone to Keloid or hypertrophic scars
- Undergoing Chemotherapy or Radiation treatments
- Currently taking blood thinning medications such as Aspirin
- Currently using topical steroids such as Retin-A or Renova
- Skin cancer, skin diseases, skin lesions
- Skin sensitivities to soap or disinfectants
- Any viral infections and/or diseases
- Currently taking Antibiotics
- Allergies to metals, dyes or makeup
- Hepatitis B/C or AIDS/HIV
- Easily triggered hyper-pigmentation
- Glaucoma applies to eyeliner procedure only
- Pacemaker or major heart conditions
- Lupus/Autoimmune Disease
- Uncontrolled high blood pressure
- Insulin dependant Diabetes(Type 1)
- Cancer history
- Compromised immune system due to other health conditions

## Conditional Restrictions:

- Herpes simplex(cold sores) Only non active and healed
- Accutane 1 year after last dose
- Antibiotics 10 days after last dose
- Blood thinners (Aspirin and such or Vitamin E, Fish Oil) 48 hours after last use
- Chemotherapy or Radiation 6 month after last treatment
- Alcohol 24 hours after last use
- Botox(applies to Brow procedure only) 2 weeks after procedure
- Lip Fillers(applies to Lip procedure only) 2 weeks after procedure
- Chemical peels, Retin-A, or Renova 10 days after last use

## General warning:

- Tobacco smokers healing process is slower
- Lip procedures only history of Cold Sores needs to be pre-treated with antiviral medication(Valtrex, Zovirax or Famvir) - contact your doctor
- Allergy to latex, lidocaine, petroleum, etc. needs to be disclosed to avoid their use
