

RE: Public Records Act Request



This letter is in response to your recent correspondence received by the California Department of Justice (Department) on [REDACTED] in which you sought records pursuant to the California Public Records Act (PRA) as set forth in Government Code section 7920.000 et seq.

Specifically, you requested that we provide the following:

Agreements: Any executed Common Interest Agreements, Joint Prosecution Agreements, or Memoranda of Understanding between the California Department of Justice and the following entities: "Everytown for Gun Safety," "Everytown Law," "Brady Center," or "Giffords Law Center," dated from January 1, 2021, to present.

Calendars: All calendar entries and meeting logs for Attorney General Rob Bonta, Chief Deputy Attorney General, and the Solicitor General that list "Eric Tirschwell," "Alla Lefkowitz," or "Everytown" as attendees or subjects, from January 1, 2021, to present.

Communications regarding Legislation: All correspondence (emails and attachments) between CalDOJ staff and any email address ending in "@everytown.org" regarding the drafting or support of Senate Bill 2 or Assembly Bill 1078 or Senate Bill 704 dated prior to the enactment of said legislation.

On [REDACTED], the Department informed you that additional time was needed to search for potentially responsive documents. The Department has since located some responsive records and is reviewing those records to determine whether there is any information that requires withholding or the application of redactions. We anticipate that you can expect a further



response on or about [REDACTED] 2026. We will identify any bases for withholding or redacting records, if necessary, in our further response.
