APM Accreditations



Provides an understanding of project management principles

Ideal for anyone working on a project or with project teams

- 2-day course
- 1 hour online exam
- 60 Multiple choice questions
- Pass mark 60%
- Result is shown at end of exam



Provides a broad understanding of all key project management areas

Ideal for anyone wishing to advance their career and enhance their employability

- 5-day course
- 2.5 hour online exam
- 30-minute break between parts A & B
- 40 selected and constructed questions
- Result is sent via email from APM

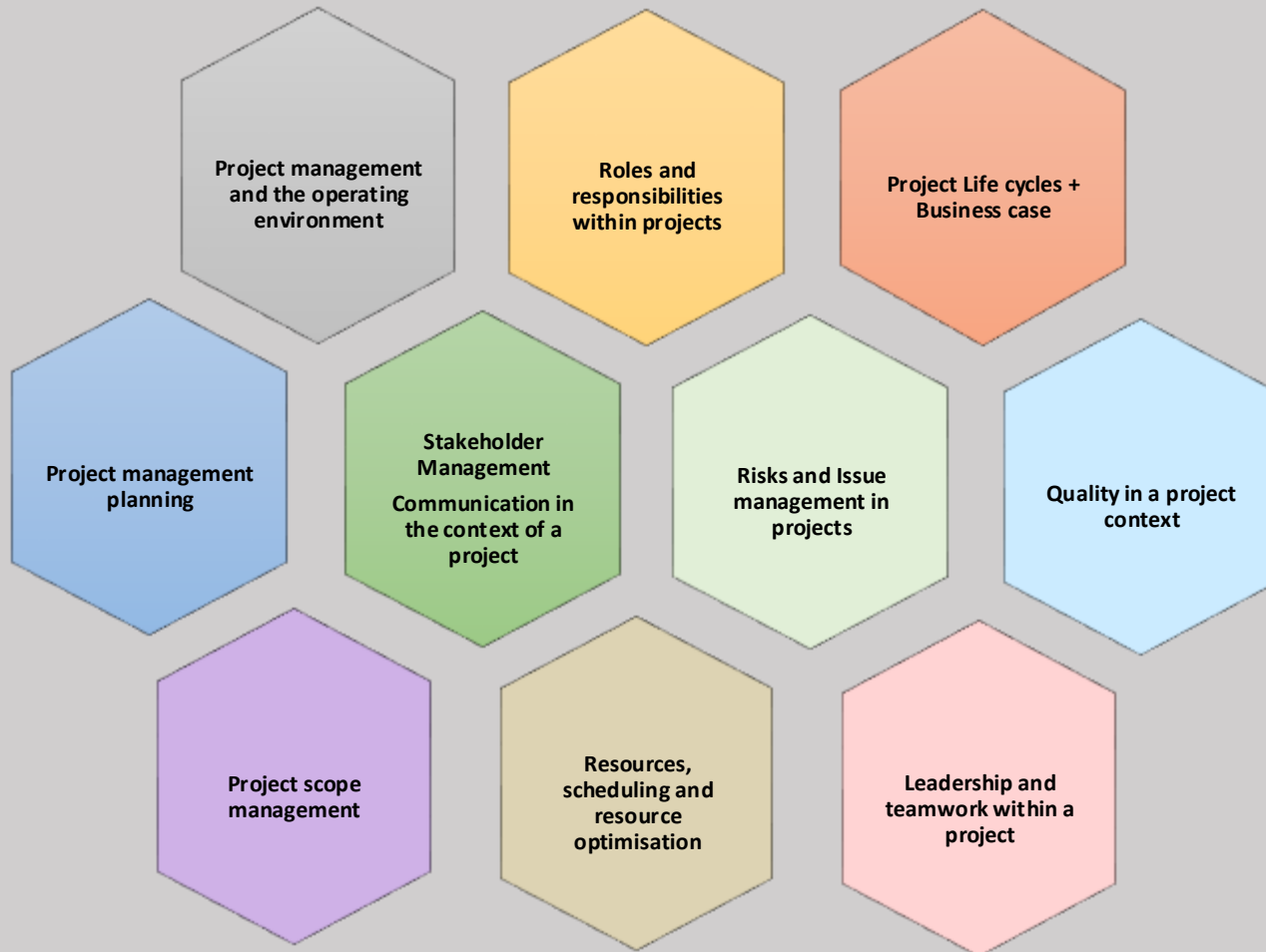


Assesses capability in delivering professional projects.

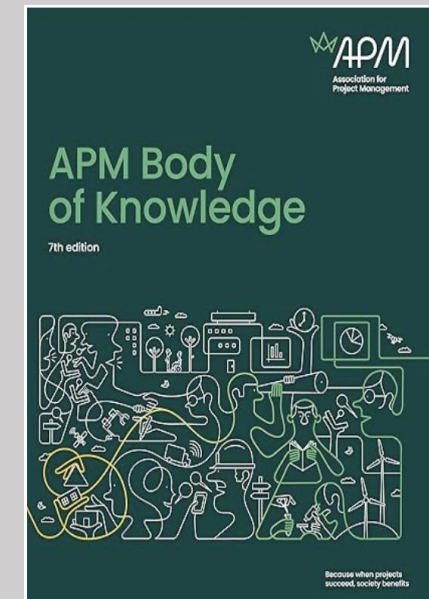
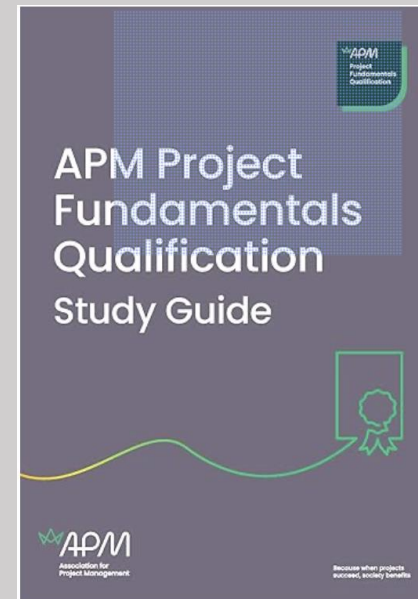
Ideal for anyone working in projects or hold APMQ qualification

- Changed on Sept 3rd 2024, from a 3-hour written exam with 10 questions
- Added four new competencies:
 - Equality, Diversity and Inclusion,
 - Sustainability
 - Ethics, Compliance and Professionalism
 - Transition Management
- Created new pathway to chartership

Basic Information

- 2.5 hours
- 40 questions
- 90 marks from those 40
- The pass mark will vary between exam versions to take account of slight differences in question difficulty between different exam versions.

Types of question

- Multiple response (20 questions × 1 mark each)
- Select from list (5 questions × 2 marks each)
- Short response (5 questions × 2 marks each)
- Long response (10 questions × 5 marks each)

Pathways to Chartership

Pathway 1

Previously route 3

For those who meet the eligibility requirements but don't have a recognised assessment.

Assessment

- Written submission including project overviews for professional practice covering 12 competences.
- Two hour interview covering professional practice and technical knowledge.

Pathway 2

Previously route 1

For those who meet the eligibility requirements and have a recognised assessment for technical knowledge.

Assessment

- Recognised Assessment for technical knowledge.
- Written submission including project overviews for professional practice covering 12 competences.
- One hour 15 minute interview covering professional practice.

Pathway 3

For those who meet the eligibility requirements and have a recognised assessment for professional practice.*

Assessment

- Recognised Assessment for professional practice.
- Written submission including project overviews for professional practice covering eight competences.
- One hour interview covering technical knowledge.

New

Pathway 4

Previously route 2

For those who meet the eligibility requirements and have a recognised assessment for both professional practice and technical knowledge.

Assessment

- Recognised Assessment for technical knowledge and professional practice.
- 30 minute interview covering CPD and currency of mandatory competences.
