Garden Tour

We offer private garden tours to garden clubs and other organizations. During this 45 minute walking tour you will learn about the plantings and the inspiration that led to the beautiful English style gardens. Special attention is given to the unique collection of plants and trees as well as the history of the house and historic outbuildings. While on this informative guided tour with Nancy, questions are welcomed. After the tour please enjoy walking through the greenhouses, garden center and the Amaryllis Gift Shop. The garden center is filled with potted containers, elegant statuary and pottery.

Directions & Parking

Surreybrooke is located directly on US-40 (Baltimore National Pike). There is absolutely no parking permitted on Hollow Road. **All attendees of tours must park in the grass parking lot located to the left of the gravel lot.** Please ensure all drivers have a copy of the driving directions to Surreybrooke. Do NOT follow mapquest or GPS directions. **Printable directions are below and should be given to all members of the group.**

PARKING

Surreybrooke's Entrance is located directly on US-40 (Baltimore National Pike). Absolutely NO PARKING is permitted on Hollow Road. **All attendees of Special Events must park in the grass parking lot.** The gravel lot is reserved for dropping off & picking up, handicap parking and garden center customers only. Thank you for your cooperation.

***** PLEASE FOLLOW DIRECTIONS LISTED BELOW *****

Do not use Mapquest or GPS! Mapquest and GPS will give you directions to our private residence on Hollow Road, not the Surreybrooke's entrance on US-40 (Baltimore National Pike) where Garden Center and Special Event parking are located.

If you end up at 8537 Hollow Road by red barn please do not park here. To get to Surreybrooke's Entrance go West on Hollow Road, make your first right onto Hawbottom Road, then make a right on Baltimore National Pike (US-40 E). We are located about 1/3 mile on right.

Please Note: US-40 (Baltimore National Pike) is NOT US-40-ALT (Old National Pike)
DO NOT follow signs toward US-40-ALT

DIRECTIONS

Frederick Area: Follow US-40 W towards Gambrill State Park. We are located 5 miles west of Boscov's Department Store on US-40. Surreybrooke is located on US-40 on the left.

(If you reach Pacific Dr. or Hawbottom Rd. you have gone about ¼ mile too far).

Baltimore Area: Follow I-70W toward Frederick. Merge onto US-40 W via Exit #53B toward US-15 N / Gettysburg. Merge onto US-40 W via Exit #13B. Follow US-40 W for 6.2 miles going toward Gambrill State Park. Surreybrooke is located on US-40 on the left.

(If you reach Pacific Dr. or Hawbottom Rd. you have gone about ¼ mile too far).

Washington Area: Follow I-270 N toward Frederick. I-270 N becomes US-40 W. Merge onto US-40 W via exit #13B. Follow US-40 W for 6.2 miles going toward Gambrill State Park. Surreybrooke is located on US-40 on the left. (If you reach Pacific Dr. or Hawbottom Rd. you have gone about ¼ mile too far).

Leesburg Area: Follow US-15 N toward Frederick. Merge onto US-40 W / US-15 N via exit #12B toward Gettysburg. Merge onto US-40 W via Exit #13B. Follow US-40 W for 6.2 miles going toward Gambrill State Park. Surreybrooke is located on US-40 on the left.

(If you reach Pacific Dr. or Hawbottom Rd. you have gone about ¼ mile too far).

Gettysburg Area: Follow US-15 S toward Frederick. Merge onto US-40 W via Exit #13B. Follow US-40 W for 6.2 miles going toward Gambrill State Park. Surreybrooke is located on US-40 on the left.

(If you reach Pacific Dr. or Hawbottom Rd. you have gone about ¼ mile too far).

Hagerstown Area: Follow US-40 E toward Frederick for about 7 miles past Greenbier State Park. Surreybrooke is located on US-40 on the right between Hawbottom Road and Hollow Road.

(We are about ¼ mile past Hawbottom Rd. and Pacific Dr. If you have reached Rosebud Ct. you have gone a little too far).
