	New revision of Bylaws suggested:
	Article IV - Removal of Officers and Members
	Section 1.
	Any officer of the County Committee may be removed from Office for <u>any</u> cause. Such removal
	must be done at a proper meeting of the County Committee, provided that (a) notice of such
	removal be mailed to every member of the County Committee at least two weeks before the
	meeting; and (b) that two-thirds of the County Committee votes for such removal.
	Continu 2
	Section 2.
	As the County Committee members are duly elected by their respective districts, members can
	only be removed from the County Committee as provided by law.
	a) Notwithstanding, the Jackson County Republican Committee, in exercise of its right
	to control its internal affairs, to exercise its right of free association, and be the sole
	judge of the qualifications of its members. Jackson County Republican Committee
	may remove a member who has been absent from three consecutive meetings
	without excuse or proxy, as verified by the roll calls in each of the previous three
	meetings. Such a member may be removed in the 4th consecutive meeting of a
	member's absence by a two-thirds majority vote of the County Committee in quorum,
	whether the member is present or absent, without further notice, or obligation of
	notification.
