Most merciful God,




Second Reading Romans 1:1-7

## **Holy Gospel**


The Holy Gospel according to Matthew, the 1st chapter.

Glory to you, O Lord.

<sup>18</sup> Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be pregnant from the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup> Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace, planned to divorce her quietly. <sup>20</sup> But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. <sup>21</sup> She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." <sup>22</sup> All this took place to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet:

<sup>23</sup> "Look, the virgin shall become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means, "God is with us." <sup>24</sup> When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took her as his wife <sup>25</sup> but had no marital relations with her until she had given birth to a son, and he named him Jesus.

#### Sermon

## A Baptismal Celebration for Daniel Frededrick Jaskierny

God, who is rich in mercy and love, gives us new birth into a living hope through the sacrament of baptism.

The power of sin is put to death in this holy flood, and we are raised with Jesus Christ to new life.

We are united with all the baptized in the one body of Christ.

We are anointed with the gift of the Holy Spirit and sent out in mission for the life of the world.

A member of the Baptismal party presents the child by saying:

We present Daniel Frededrick Jaskierny to receive the sacrament of Holy Baptism.

As you present this child for baptism you are entrusted with gifts and responsibilities: to live with him among God's faithful people, to bring him to the word of God and the holy supper and nurture him in faith and prayer that he may learn to trust God, proclaim Christ through word and deed, care for others and the world God made, and work for justice and peace among all people. Parents and sponsors, I ask you, do you promise to help this child grow in the Christian life and faith?

R/ I do.

I ask you to reject sin, profess your trust in Christ and confess the faith of the church. Do you renounce the devil and all the forces that defy God, the powers of this world that rebel against God and the ways of sin that draw you from God?

R/ I renounce them.

Do you trust in Christ as your Lord and Savior?

R/ In faith I turn to Christ

With the whole church, let us confess our faith:

I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

The Lord be with you.

Let us give thanks to God.

It is right to give God thanks and praise.

Blessed are you, O God, creator of all things. Your voice thundered over the waters at creation. You water the mountains and send springs into the valleys to refresh and satisfy all living things. In the time of Noah you washed the earth with the waters of the flood, and your ark of salvation bore a new beginning. In the time of Moses your people passed through the Red Sea from slavery into freedom. In the fullness of time you sent Jesus the Christ, nurtured in the waters of Mary's womb, so that through the baptism of his death and resurrection, your children may be set free from bondage to sin and death and sent to proclaim the good news throughout the earth.

Amen.

The Child is Baptized

We give you thanks, O God, that through water and the Holy Spirit you give your daughters and sons new birth. Sustain Daniel with the gift of your Holy Spirit: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence.

Amen.

The pastor makes sign of the cross on the child's forehead:

Daniel Frederick Jaskierny, child of God, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ forever.

Amen.

As baptismal candle is lit:

As Lutherans, we consider baptism our initial call to discipleship. As we present this candle to Daniel we say:

Let your light so shine that others may see your good works and give glory to God.

As baptized children of God and disciples of the living Christ, let us proclaim:

May our lights shine in the world with God's grace!

God of grace, look with kindness upon the parents and sponsors of this child. Give them joy in the gift of this child, and help them to be examples of faith and teachers of discipleship. Strengthen them in their own baptism as they share with this child a life of trust in you.

Amen.

Through baptism Daniel has been received into the household of God.

We welcome you into the body of Christ and the mission we share. Join us as we give praise to God and bear God's creative and redeeming word to all the world.



## December Mission of the Month The Midwife Project – The Giving Circle, Inc.


A volunteer organization which focuses on providing healthcare in Uganda by establishing clinics, supporting medical staff, and delivering medical care.
