HAVE YOUR SAY ON PAY

Today at 09.00 we open the pay ballot of UNISON members in the Probation Service. Please vote to show how strongly you feel about what you are paid.

In June last year, the three probation unions submitted a claim to re-open the current three year pay award. Our claim was for the following additional pay for probation staff:

- 12% increase on all pay points
- £2,500 one-off payment
- 12% increase on all cash allowances

After long delays, the Probation Service finally said no to the claim at the end of April this year. It is not prepared to top up the pay award for all staff.

UNISON says enough is enough. Probation staff are facing a huge workloads crisis, but the Probation Service won't accept that low pay is part of the problem. Until or unless the employer starts to pay probation staff properly, staff will continue to leave for better paid jobs elsewhere. This affects everyone.
