Bob serves as CEO of Baker Street Scientific "BakerSci", a company which "softwared" the concepts of Deep Context and Relevance in Data which Bob pursued when establishing the Navy Information Dominance Cadre (rebranded to "Information Warfare"). Before BakerSci, Bob served in CEO/Founder positions at Triias Corp. and Argus Artificial Intelligence Systems which both focused on Artificial Intelligence and Business Applications of Intelligent Systems.

Bob previously served 36 years in the U.S. Navy retiring as a Rear Admiral. He began his Navy career flying fighter aircraft ultimately serving as a Fighter Squadron Operations Officer and F-14 Program Development Officer. He personally directed countless innovative and highly classified warfighting demonstrations during these high-tech tours.

Upon his return from Africa, he was selected for Flag Rank and served as Deputy Commander, U.S. SECOND Fleet where he directed an extensive Navy program to establish a global network of connected and inter-dependent Maritime Operations Centers. His final Navy assignment was as an Operational Deputy Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command where he directed analysis for the largest operational merger in modern Navy history which integrated U.S. SECOND Fleet into U.S. Fleet Forces Command.
