

OSJ Bio for Randy Strombeck

Randy Strombeck is President of RCD Construction, Inc. and part of the leadership of his family's ministry named <u>Koinonia Ministries</u>.

Ever since he was 2 weeks old, he has been traveling as a missionary. His life has been devoted to the Lord and to bringing the Body of Christ together through real relationship around the world. He and his family started out in the Caribbean, moved to Central and South America in the 70's and 80's where they started orphanages, bible schools, ministry training centers and churches. In 1991 his family ministry went into Eastern Europe and Ukraine and started ministry training centers and churches. They have about 100 churches in their Ukraine Koinonia church fellowship. In 13 years of MTC in Kiev, they trained and raised up about 10,000 pastors and leaders in the nation. For the last 15 years Randy has been raising up thousands of youth and young leaders in Ukraine. Some in business and in ministry. Some even into the highest levels of government and social influence.

Randy has a successful construction company in Moravian Falls NC. He builds high end homes in the mountains. He is using his company to fund the Kingdom of God and the pursuits he is called to.

Since the Russia/Ukraine war started in March 2022, Randy and his teams have been purchasing and bringing humanitarian aid into Ukraine. Their network of leaders has been very successful in bringing enough food and supplies to feed over 400,000 Ukrainians and to share the Love of the Lord with these hurting people in need. Their teams have also started building and placing small homes for people in Ukraine that have lost their homes due to the war. To date their teams have been a part of placing over 200 homes since the summer of 2022. These homes are donated. In all the things he is doing, spreading the Love of the Lord to people and the Great end-time Harvest is always the goal in mind.

Since the OSJ meeting he was able to attend in November, his teams have set 30 more homes and brought food and supplies to approximately 50,000 people.
