
1-Page Snapshot: U.S. Avocado Market (April 2025)

U.S. per-capita consumption climbed to \sim 9 lbs in 2024, a six-fold increase since 2000. Marketing-year imports (Jul 2023-Jun 2024) topped 2.4 B lbs, with Mexico supplying 88 %. Week 16 shipments hit 56.4 M lbs; Week 17 projections surge beyond 70 M lbs.



FOB South Texas eased to the mid-\$60s for 48-count as pre-Cinco volume expanded; 60s and 70s carry deeper discounts, making them attractive for bag programs.



Trade: Hass avocados remain duty-free under USMCA. March 2025's proposed blanket tariff on Mexican goods was suspended; supply-chain disruptions are more likely from temporary phytosanitary suspensions than new duties.
