# MASONIC LODGE #7 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INFORMATION MATAGORDA, TEXAS

Matagorda's Masonic Lodge #7 of Texas will provide scholarships to outstanding students residing in Matagorda County who have a parent, grandparent or legal guardian that is or was a member of Masonry in good standing.

Each separate scholarship will be awarded to deserving and qualified applicants meeting the Committee's minimum requirements.

Candidates will be confined to those who are presently enrolled, or will be enrolled, in coursework leading to a college degree. There are no stipulations placed on the type of degree, which may be sought.

Selection of the scholarship will be based on scholastic achievement, career goals, leadership and the family's association with Masonry.

To be eligible, a candidate must meet the following criteria:

**Definition of <u>DIRECT DESCENDANT</u> for this application -** a child whose FATHER or GRANDFATHER (only 2 generations accepted), is/was a Master Mason in good standing.

- 1. be a <u>legal resident of Matagorda County</u>, or a <u>direct descendant</u> of or under the guardianship of a <u>member of Matagorda Masonic Lodge #7</u>.
- 2. be a high school student who will graduate by the spring or summer of the year they apply and will enter college the fall of the same year, **OR** currently be enrolled as a full-time college student,
- 3. be a <u>direct descendant</u> or under the guardianship of a direct descendant of a Master Mason (AF & AM),
- 4. a college student who has been previously awarded this Masonic scholarship.
- 5. Candidates are only eligible to receive this scholarship a total of three (3) times.

The minimum scholastic rating for consideration of a scholarship will be:

**High School Seniors** – after completion of the first (1<sup>st</sup>) semester of the senior year the student may submit an application to the committee to be considered.

**College Students** – should have an overall grade point average of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 Grade point system for all coursework taken previous to their submitting a scholarship application (however, the committee will consider each applicant on an Individual basis).

Candidates must have their completed applications turned in to the committee no later than **April** 1st of the year in which they are applying.

The committee will make the final approval of each scholarship winner prior to May 10<sup>th</sup> of the year in which the student applies.

It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to notify the Lodge Committee with proof of their full-time enrollment to an accredited university, college or junior college for the upcoming fall and/or spring semesters or quarters, depending on the structure of the school's calendar. Failures to enroll on full time basis will automatically make the student ineligible to receive payment and the money will remain in the scholarship fund or be awarded to runners-up. Scholarships are awarded in May and must be claimed by September 1st. If <u>Proof of Enrollment</u> is not received by the lodge prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> of September, the applicant will forfeit eligibility and the funds will be granted to another student.

A candidate may re-apply each year as an applicant for the scholarship, even if they (1) are previous recipients or (2) have been turned down previously by the Lodge Scholarship Committee. Each candidate is eligible to receive this scholarship a total of 3 times.

All applicants will be given equal consideration regardless of race, color, sex, religion, or national origin. All Lodge Decisions Are Final. No Appeals will be accepted.

#### **High School Seniors Must Submit the Following Items:**

- 1. Fully completed and signed applicant form.
- 2. High School Transcript with class ranking.
- 3. SAT &/or ACT scores.
- 4. A typewritten narrative detailing: career goals; relevant activities which support these goals; and why this scholarship is desired.
- 5. Three letters of recommendation from non-family members. *Letters must be current*.

*Note:* Narrative and reference letters are extremely important in the selection process.

### **Current College Student Applicants must submit the following Items:**

- 1. Fully completed and signed applicant form.
- 2. A typewritten narrative detailing: career goals, relevant activities supporting these goals, a short summary of your recent semester, and why this scholarship is desired.
- 3. Three letters of recommendation from non-family members. Letters must be <u>current</u>.

Note: Narrative and reference letters are extremely important in the selection process.
