Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the Karnataka state Government Daily Wages Employee's Federation Sanjeevini Ayurveda Medical college and hospital, Dr.K.S. Sharma Campus, Vishwashrama Chetana, Basaveshwara Nagar Gokul Road, Hubballi, Karnataka with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2018-19 –reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No. F.No.R.12011/49/2016-EP(IM-I) for 2017-2018 dated 04.09.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2018-19.


2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 02.02.2018 and re-visited on 22-23.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the college was having certain deficiencies as per RMS 2016 viz. Demonstration room, Higher faculty in Rasashastra and Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant, Web based computerized central registration system, Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college to present the case on 08.08.2018 vide Ministry's letter dated 30.07.2018.

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3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representative during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 and 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) for the UG course for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2018-19 and it has been decided by the Central Government to **grant conditional permission to Karnataka state Government Daily Wages Employee's Federation Sanjeevini Ayurveda Medical college and hospital ,Dr.K.S.Sharma Campus, Vishwashrama Chetana, Basaveshwara Nagar Gokul Road, Hubballi, Karnataka** to take admissions for **60 seats** in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by **31st December, 2018:**

- i. Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.
4. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:
 - (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
5. The fulfillment of the deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report of CCIM and hearing committee (if any) and the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.
6. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
