

Sharma Campus, Vishwashrama Chetana, Basaveshwara Nagar, Gokul Road, Hubballi – 580 030, Karnataka” with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, from the academic session 2017-18, under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 – **Permission Letter** -reg.

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's letter of even No. dated 21.06.2017 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to you to establish a new Ayurveda college in the name of **Karnataka State Government Daily Wages Employee's Federation Sanjeevini Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Dr. K.S. Sharma Campus, Vishwashrama Chetana, Basaveshwara Nagar, Gokul Road, Hubballi – 580 030, Karnataka** with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations & report of the CCIM in terms of criteria as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letters No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017; **permission** of the Central Government is hereby granted to the **Vice President, Karnataka**



State Government Daily Wages Employee's Federation, C/O Dr. K.S. Sharma, Vishwashrama Chetana, Basaveshwara Nagar, Gokul Road, Hubballi – 580 030, Karnataka to start new Ayurveda College in the name of **Karnataka State Government Daily Wages Employee's Federation Sanjeevini Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Dr. K.S. Sharma Campus, Vishwashrama Chetana, Basaveshwara Nagar, Gokul Road, Hubballi – 580 030, Karnataka** with intake capacity of **60 seats** in UG (BAMS) course from the **academic session 2017-18** under the provisions of the section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.

2. The college may take admissions for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2017-18 subject to the condition that the following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2017 to get conditional permission for the session 2018-19 (a copy of Assessment sheet of CCIM is also enclosed):

- (i) All the requirements under relevant provisions of the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and Regulation 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, by 31st December, 2017 to get conditional permission for the session 2018-19;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

3. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.

4. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd, IIIrd and IVth professionals well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.

5. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
