

NHL STREET LEAGUE

Registration & Eligibility Policy

1. PURPOSE

This policy outlines the requirements, procedures, and eligibility criteria for participation in the Aurora North Athletics (ANA) NHL Street League. It ensures fair access, proper documentation, and alignment with program safety and operational standards.

2. SCOPE

This policy applies to all participants registering for ANA NHL Street programs, including players, parents/guardians, and program administrators.

3. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

All participants must complete the following prior to participation:

- Completed ANA registration form (Microsoft Forms or approved platform)
- Signed waiver and consent forms
- Emergency contact information provided
- Payment of registration fees or approved subsidy (as outlined in the Financial, Refund & Cancellation Policy)

Registrations are not considered complete until all required documentation and payment are received.

4. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate, players must:

- Meet the age requirements for their division
- Be physically able to participate in program activities
- Agree to abide by ANA policies, including Code of Conduct and Safety & Athlete Protection policies

ANA reserves the right to request additional information where required to ensure safe participation.

5. AGE DIVISIONS

ANA will organize divisions based on:

- Age groupings aligned with NHL Street guidelines
- Registration numbers and community demand

ANA may adjust divisions to ensure balanced teams and a positive participant experience.

6. FINANCIAL ACCESSIBILITY & SUBSIDIES

ANA is committed to reducing barriers to participation.

- Subsidies or reduced fees may be available based on need
- Partnerships (including community organizations) may support access
- Requests for financial assistance will be handled confidentially

No participant will be denied access due to financial hardship where support is available.

7. REGISTRATION FEES (REFERENCE ONLY)

Registration fees may include:

- Program participation costs
- Facility rental
- Jersey and program-related equipment

All financial terms, refunds, and cancellations are governed by the **Financial, Refund & Cancellation Policy**.

8. WAITLIST & CAPACITY

- Registration may be capped based on facility and staffing capacity
- A waitlist may be created once capacity is reached
- Waitlisted participants will be contacted if space becomes available

9. MEDICAL INFORMATION & CONSENT

Parents/guardians must:

- Disclose relevant medical conditions or concerns
- Provide emergency contact details
- Consent to emergency medical treatment if required

This information will be kept confidential and used only for safety purposes.

10. JERSEY & EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Participants are required to:

- Wear the provided NHL Street jersey during games
- Use appropriate safety equipment as outlined in ANA policies

Equipment requirements will be communicated prior to program start.

11. VOLUNTEER INTEREST

Participants and families may be asked:

- If they are interested in coaching or volunteering

ANA will follow appropriate screening and onboarding procedures for all volunteers.

12. DATA COLLECTION & PRIVACY

ANA will:

- Collect only necessary participant information

- Use data solely for program administration
- Protect personal information in accordance with privacy standards

13. PROGRAM CHANGES

ANA reserves the right to:

- Adjust schedules, locations, or format based on operational needs
- Modify program structure based on registration or facility availability

Participants will be notified of any changes as soon as possible.

14. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

By registering, participants and parents/guardians acknowledge:

- Acceptance of ANA policies and procedures
- Understanding of program expectations
- Agreement to abide by all rules and guidelines
