**NOTICE OF HEARING**

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the application of Maricopa Energy Center, LLC (“Applicant”) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (“CEC”) authorizing construction of a 500 kilovolt (“kV”) transmission line called the Maricopa Energy Center 500kV Transmission Line Project (“the Project”).

The Project will be a double circuit (“DC”) or single circuit (“SC”) 500 kV transmission line rated for up to 2,000 megawatts (“MW”) of capacity and a 500kV switchyard in Maricopa County, Arizona. When constructed, the Project will interconnect an up to 550 MW alternating current solar array and battery energy storage system (“BESS”), also to be constructed by Applicant, to the Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”) Delaney 500kV Substation (“Delaney Substation”). The Applicant is seeking a CEC application for two alternative routes as follows:

**Alternative A (Approx. 5.7 to 7.5 miles)** – S13 switchyard siting area or S17 switchyard to the Delaney Substation via the Flood Control District of Maricopa County (“FCDMC”) Saddleback Flood Retardant Structure (“FRS”). This alternative may be rated to up to 2,000 MWs of capacity and SC. A sub-alternative A-1 is an option to Alternative A and would be sited entirely north

1 of the Thomas Road alignment from the Saddleback FRS to the Delaney  
2 Substation. A distance of approximately 1.75 miles. Alternative A is  
3 approximately between 5.7 and 7.5 miles in length depending on where the  
4 Project switchyard is located. This alternative parallels existing linear features  
5 (e.g., roads, existing transmission lines, FRS) or land patterns (e.g., section or  
6 ½ section lines) for 100% of its length.

7 **Alternative B (Approx. 8.5 miles)** – S13 switchyard siting area to the Delaney  
8 Substation via the Harquahala Power Plant. This alternative may be rated to up  
9 to 2,000 MWs of capacity with approximately up to 4 miles constructed as SC  
10 and approximately 4.5 miles as DC. This alternative includes approximately  
11 4.5 miles of rebuild of the existing Harquahala to Hassayampa SC 500kV  
12 transmission line to DC 500kV. The balance of this alternative would be SC.  
13 This alternative parallels existing linear features or land patterns for 100% of  
14 its length.

15 The Applicant would construct one or the other of the alternatives depending on  
16 which one is ultimately selected by the Applicant as best suited for the Project.  
17 Depending on the alternative, the Project would traverse a mix of federal, state,  
18 county, and private land within varying rights-of-way (“ROW”). A map of the  
19 Project, and the proposed alternatives, is attached as **Exhibit A**.

20 The hearing will be held at the Hampton Inn & Suites Phoenix-Goodyear, 2000  
21 N. Litchfield Rd, Goodyear, AZ 85395. The hearing will begin on Monday, October  
22 24, 2022 at 1:00 p.m., and will continue as necessary on Tuesday, October 25, 2022,  
23 and Wednesday, 26, 2022, at 9:00 a.m., respectively. If any revisions to the hearing  
24 schedule are required, they will be noticed on the Project website

7 PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT ALL LOCAL AND STATE PUBLIC  
8 HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES REGARDING COVID-19 WILL BE  
9 FOLLOWED DURING THE HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION.

16 At least 24 hours in advance of the hearing, information regarding online and  
17 telephone hearing access, as well as any additional details regarding COVID-19 safety  
18 protocols or other revisions to the hearing schedule will be noticed on the Project  
19 website at <https://maricopasolarandstorageproject.com/>. The Chairman may, at his  
20 discretion, recess the hearing to a time and place to be announced during the hearing,  
21 or to be determined after the recess. The date, time, and place at which the hearing  
22 will be resumed will be posted on the above-noted Project websites and the  
23 Commission website. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY RESUMED HEARING WILL  
24 BE GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF SUCH A RESUMED  
25 HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.**

26 No tour of the Project area is planned by the Chairman at this time. If the  
27 Chairman or Committee later decide to conduct a tour, notice that includes a map and


16 Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project  
17 that desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before  
18 the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director  
19 of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street,  
20 Phoenix AZ 85007.

21 Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part  
22 to promote conservation or natural beauty; to protect the environment, personal health  
23 or other biological values; to preserve historical sites; to promote consumer interests;  
24 to represent commercial and industrial groups; or to promote the orderly development  
25 of the area in which the Project are located that desires to become a party to the  
26 proceedings shall, not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file a  
27 Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation  
28 Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007.

1           The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make  
2 other persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance  
3 at a hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, Arizona  
4 Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix AZ 85007, not less  
5 than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited  
6 appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine  
7 witnesses.

8           This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S.”) §§ 40-360  
9 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-3-201 to R14-3-220.  
10 No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member  
11 of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the  
12 Commission pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to  
13 the proceeding on the matter before the Commission must be a party to the proceeding  
14 before the Committee.

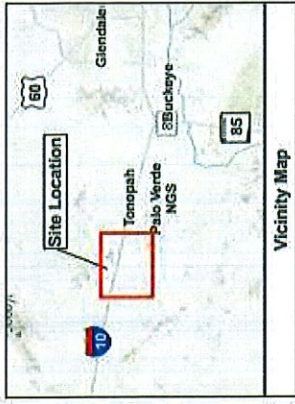
