

While writing this book, Courtney and I had an encounter with Papa God. We were in the world and our eyes were opened to the darkness all around. All of that led me to co-author our first book Wonder Works - one, to teach my own children how to hear the voice of Papa God, and two, so other families and lost children could learn His voice too.

His voice changes everything. When my ears and heart were opened and I realized all the different ways He speaks, it was like this timeline played in my mind and I began to recognize several times throughout my life that He was speaking to me - I just didn't know it was Him. Papa God didn't wait for me to see or know Him before He started talking to me. He created me, sees me, and knows me, but He also wants me to know Him too. He is always speaking, it's just a matter of listening for His voice. When we know His voice, we are led into freedom, and our freedom prepares us to lead others too - out of the darkness into the light!
