

SKATE SAFE DURING COVID-19

GUEST SAFETY STANDARDS

1 SYMPTOMS

For the safety of our staff and guests, if you have a fever or any symptoms consistent with COVID-19, you will not be allowed inside the facility.



6 DISTANCE

All guests and staff are recommended to stay at least 6 feet apart to follow social distancing guidelines.



2 EXPOSURE

If you have been exposed to anyone who has been confirmed positive for or suspected of having COVID-19 within the last 14 days, for the safety of staff and guests, please do not enter the facility.



7 DON'T TOUCH

In addition to washing your hands and sanitizing often, remember to avoid touching your face at all times.

3 RECOVERED

If you have had COVID-19 and recovered, you must be symptom and fever-free without the use of medications for a full 72-hours.



DRY COUGH

8 NO GROUPS

While we welcome your families to celebrate together, we recommend groups no larger than 10 or as otherwise instructed by state and local guidelines.



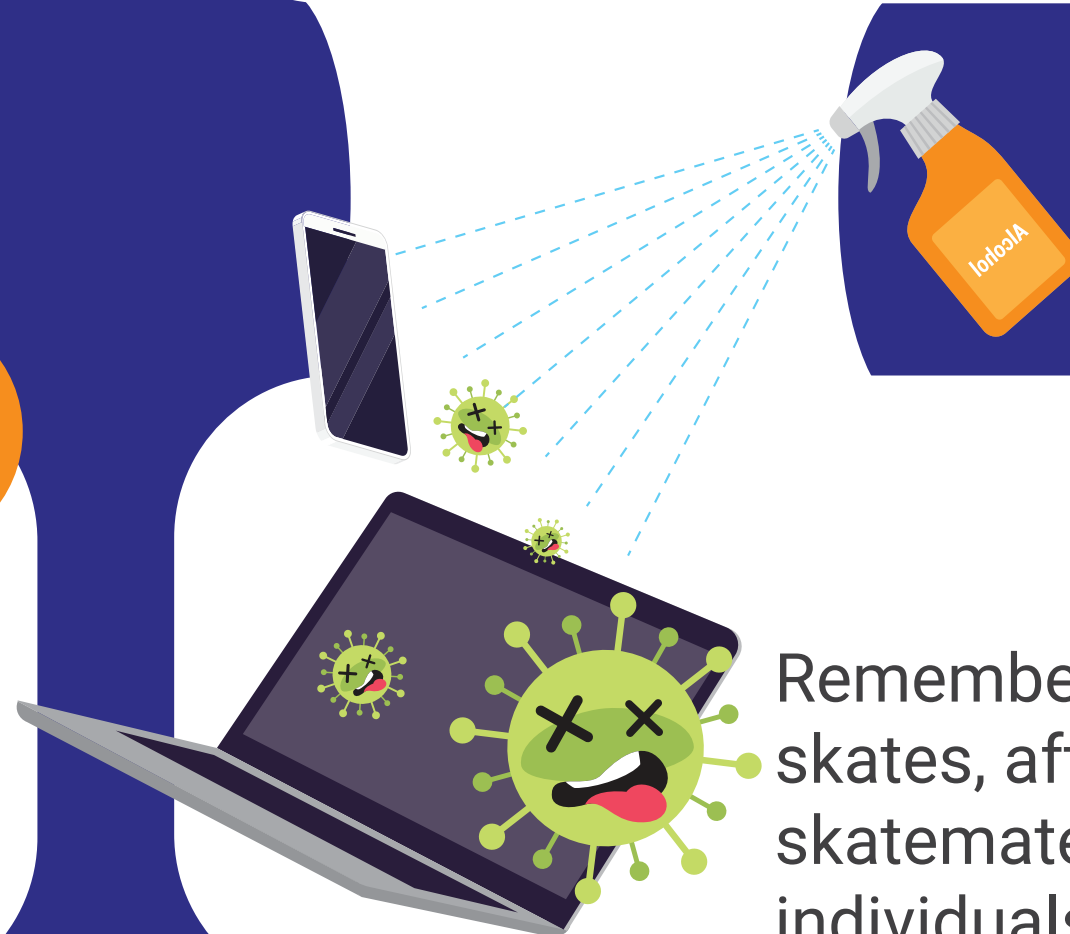
4 CLEANED

All guests must sanitize their hands before entering the building and are encouraged to sanitize and wash their hands throughout their visit.



9 SANITIZE

Remember to sanitize your hands after putting on skates, after playing arcade games, returning your skatemates or touching any surface that other individuals may have touched.



5 FACE MASKS

For the safety of all guests and staff, everyone who enters MUST wear a face mask.



10 WEAR SOCKS

All guests must wear above-the-ankle socks when wearing roller skates.
