Please note: A separate registration form must be completed and brought to camp for each attendee. The participant agreement form requires a parent or legal guardian's signature for the boys that are 17 and younger in order for them to attend Winter Camp. For everyone 18 and older, the participant agreement form requires the signature of the leader. Also, any one that is 18 and older is required to have the adult registration form (a separate form from the participant agreement form) signed by their pastor, and requires that a criminal background check have been conducted in either 2017 or 2018 (this form only needs to be completed once per year).

AR/ER Activities

If your AR/ERs want to participate in the paint ball 5 on 5 activity, there is a separate permission form for the activity in this packet. This form must be signed by the parent or legal guardian of the Ranger and brought to Winter Camp; **Royal Rangers® leaders may NOT sign in place of the parents/legal guardians.**

Camp Work Day

We will have a Winter Camp/Camp Work Day on Saturday, November 3 starting at 8:00 a.m. Leaders and outposts are encouraged to come that day to help prepare our campground for Winter Camp in the morning, and then after lunch to prepare their campsite.

Concession Stand

There will be a cash-only concession stand at the pavilion, so boys and men may wish to bring extra money. This will be open Friday and Saturday. They will have a wide variety of items available.

Weather

This camp will be held in November, so it may be damp and/or cool. Please make sure your boys are prepared with adequate jackets, rain gear, and sleeping bags, so that their time at camp will be enjoyable. Camping can be lots of fun, if you and your boys are prepared for the weather. Also, chiggers may be a problem, so you need to treat your boys and leaders for chiggers. Sulfur dust, Off, and Avon Skin-So-Soft are highly recommended.

Refunds

If someone who is registered for the camp does not attend, we will refund \$20 back to the church. This refund must be requested when you check in at Winter Camp. The refund check will be mailed to your church by the district office after Winter Camp.

Reserving Camp Sites

Work Day is the ONLY time that outposts may reserve a campsite for use at Winter Camp. If you do not participate in the work day, you may choose a campsite on Friday of Winter Camp on a first-come, first-served basis. Once you claim your spot at work day you must mark your site, and you must notify the district staff, so it can be noted on the master camp map for Winter Camp.

Electricity

Electricity may be available near some campsites for use at night for CPAP machines. We do not have electrical service to run other electrical devices or lights in individual campsites.

Trailers and Campers

For Winter Camp, utility trailers are allowed to be dropped in the campsite. As soon as the utility trailer has been dropped, the vehicle must be parked in our parking area. However, pop-up trailers and campers are not allowed in the campsite for any reason. We also do not allow generators in the campsite. Security will come around to enforce all policies at Winter Camp.

Camp Set-Up

Camp is open on Friday for you and your group to come in and set up your campsite. **Do not come to camp earlier in the week to set up as the camp staff will NOT be ready to accommodate you.**

Dress Code

DRESS CODE:

Saturday all day – 2018 Winter Camp t-shirt and jeans. We want everyone to look alike during the day on Saturday.

Morning assemblies (Sunday morning) —Royal Rangers® t-shirt and khaki pants or blue jeans, or dress or utility uniform.

Keep in mind that November can be damp and/or cool, so plan appropriately for jackets and raingear.

Volunteers

We have plenty of exciting and fun activities planned for Winter Camp; however, volunteers are needed to run the activities. Volunteers will receive a Winter Camp staff patch and the Winter Camp challenge coin. As part of our **volunteer policy**, every adult leader is required to volunteer for a minimum of one hour during the day on Saturday. This will ensure that we have plenty of volunteers to be able to run all of the fun and exciting activities in which your boys want to participate. It also ensures that we won't have to shut down or cancel an activity due to lack of volunteers. Before your outpost will be able to pick up their t-shirts, your leaders will need to have gone through the volunteer checkpoint to sign up for your time slot(s). Your assistance in this will be greatly appreciated.

Camp Store

We will have extra patches available for sale in the camp store inside the lodge beginning on Saturday. Other items will also be for sale, including old hats and t-shirts, previous event patches and medallions, as well as any extra t-shirts and challenge coins that are remaining.

Water

Water faucets are on the side of the restrooms, and other locations throughout the campsite. However, you must bring your own water containers. You need to encourage your boys to drink plenty of water throughout the day to prevent dehydration.

Ranger Kids Day Camp



Unfortunately, we had to cancel our Ranger Kids Day Camp in September because of time that we would reschedule the activities to coincide with Winter Camp this year. Some groups already bring some of their Ranger Kids to Winter Camp (if you do this, we recommend that dad comes with the Ranger Kid so he has an adult male at camp that he is comfortable with). If your Ranger Kid will already be registered for Winter Camp, he will be able to participate in the RK Day Camp activities. If you want to bring your Ranger Kids to camp just for Saturday's activities, that's great too.

Since registration for Winter Camp includes a patch, t-shirt, and coin for Winter Camp, boys and leaders who register for Winter Camp and participate in the Ranger Kids activities may purchase the RK Day Camp patch for \$2 each. Limited numbers of t-shirts will also be available for \$10 each. Those that register just for the RK Day Camp will receive the RK Day Camp patch as part of their registration in the RK Day Camp and can pre-order the RK Day Camp t-shirts as part of their pre-registration.

If you want to bring your boys out for the day on Saturday, the registration form is included in this packet on the last page. That registration is not available online, and thus would need to be mailed to the district office. Each boy will need the Participant Agreement Form completed by a parent and turned in at registration. You may pre-order t-shirts on this form also, and we will have them available for you at registration. Day Camp registration will be at the pavilion starting at 9:30, and the Day Camp activities will run from 10:00 to 3:00. A Lego Derby race will be part of the fun activities for Day Camp this year. If you need the rules, contact the [district director](#). Lunch is included in the price for those who are registering just for Saturday's Day Camp. This lunch is **NOT** included in the Winter Camp registration, so any boys and leaders registered as Winter Camp attendees will not have lunch provided to them.

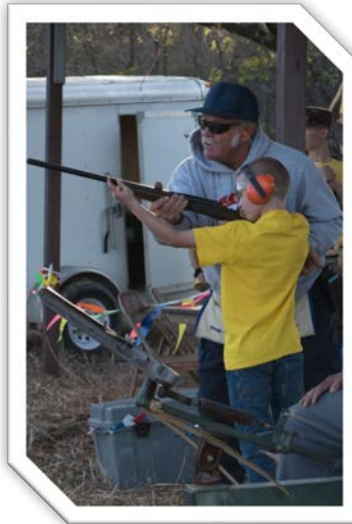


Field Games - We have a wide variety of field games planned for this Winter

Shooting Sports - The shooting ranges will be open for all boys. Activities will range from small bore rifles to shot guns. The ranges will be open all day



FCF Village - The FCF village will be open Saturday during the activities times for your boys to explore. They will be hosting several of their regular activities for boys to participate in. Knife and hawk throwing is always a favorite, but there will be other activities as well. The FCF Village will be hosting a time of fellowship and refreshments Saturday evening after the evening service. Here, your boys will be able to interact with FCF members and see the FCF village lit up at night.



Activity Center at Lakeview Camp (Expedition Rangers only) – Expedition Rangers will be able to go and enjoy the basketball courts, indoor swimming pool, and other activities after the Saturday evening service.

Paintball (Adventure Rangers and Expedition Rangers only) - Signups will be held Saturday right after morning assembly at the Ollie Henley Lodge. If you don't have a full team of 5, we can pair you with another church. PERMISSION FORMS are required for this activity, and it will be limited to Adventure Rangers and Expedition Rangers. The required permission form is attached to this packet and is located on page 14. Be sure to bring this form with you when you register at camp. The parent/guardian must sign this form; commanders cannot sign it.

Winter Camp Rules

General Rules

Attendance at the evening services, morning assemblies, Sunday school, and Sunday morning service is required of all participants. This may sound harsh, but if you do not plan on attending the services, then you have no reason to be attending Winter Camp. All adults and all boys MUST attend.

No smoking is allowed at camp. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not allowed on the premises for any reason. **Lakeview Camp is a tobacco, alcohol, and illegal drug free zone.**

No conceal and carry is permitted at any North Texas Royal Rangers® camps.

No laser pointers of any type or color are allowed in camp.

“Lights out and quiet” is at 12:00 AM (midnight). There should be no running about, loud talking, wood chopping, or other obvious distracting noises after this time. Security will enforce this rule.

No firearms or fireworks are allowed at camp.

Trash should be taken to the dumpster by the pavilion. We will not have trash pickup in the individual campsites.

Fishing in the lake is permitted only with adult supervision. Please catch and release unless you plan on eating what you catch.

No one is allowed in the lake, and boys are only allowed by the lake with adult supervision.

Do not leave trash in your campsite overnight as it will attract animals to your campsite.

Vehicle and Parking Rules

Only commanders 18 years of age or older may drive any vehicle on the camp property. This includes cars, trucks, RTVs/ATVs, golf carts, or any other motorized vehicles.

Drive carefully as you pass the homes of our missionaries as they have several small children who live in the duplexes.

Do not allow your boys to ride in the back of a pick-up or on your trailer while in camp.

Individuals may not bring RTVs/ATVs or golf carts for use at camp without the express, written permission of the district director.

If your outpost has to leave on Saturday, you need to inform registration so your outpost can camp in the designated area so your vehicle can come in early without driving through the activity areas.

The speed limit on all roads at The Royal Rangers® Camp at Lakeview is 10 miles per hour. This is for the safety of your boys.

No vehicles are permitted to stay in the camp areas. You are expected to use the parking area provided north of the challenge course. Failure to follow the parking rules will result in repeated visits from security staff and district staff.

Fire Safety Rules

Use only established fire areas if at all possible. Do NOT dig a fire pit.

No active campfires are permitted during the evening services. They are a distraction to what the Holy Spirit is doing in the service and they prevent someone from being at the service where they are required to be.

All fires need to be in a properly constructed fire ring. Make sure you have proper fire-fighting equipment available (bucket of water, bucket of sand, shovel, etc.). Your fire must be out when you leave the campsite or retire for the evening.

When you are finished with your fire ring, place all rocks at the base of a nearby tree. Also, stack any unused firewood at the base of a nearby tree. This helps those who mow in the campsites.

Why a background check and pastor certification?

Our children are under attack. Therefore, we must take extraordinary steps to protect them from abuse. Our purpose is not to eliminate parent involvement in outings, but rather to provide the safest environment possible by requiring background checks on all adults (men and women, 18 and older) attending. Because of the large number of applicants, it is impossible to check references on every applicant. As a result, great reliance is placed on the representation of each applicant's pastor to insure the applicant's suitability for working with minors.

Each adult who is registering for a district Royal Rangers® event during 2018 must have one of these on file with the district for the year. The form may be signed by the senior pastor or a staff pastor who is familiar with the adult who is attending the event. The church is responsible for completing the contact information, church information and performing the background check.
