#### FROM THE DESK OF THE DEPARTMENT PRESIDENT:

First, I want to inform you that the visit from the National President Lisa Williamson will not be taking place in August as initially planned. Attempts were made to electronically file, but glitches were frequent and none of the submissions reached the desk of the schedulers. Other attempts were made to schedule a visit when we were notified that Lisa chased down Lorna our NEC at a fall meeting and asked why she was not visiting Washington.

I placed an inquiry in the Evergreen News in the fall as to which units in the department would be willing to host luncheons or a supper and set up locations for Lisa to visit while she is here in Washington. The secretary and I received no information from any unit. So I asked our district presidents to try again to see if one or two districts would volunteer. Again, no response from members. The Department office and Lorna and I requested unit or districts to host a meal or lunch in her honor. A third time we got no response from units or the districts. Having no positive response, it was decided to notify National that due to prior calendar bookings, no area, district, or unit was able to step up to assist in organizing this event.

You can renew just as easily here, or you might consider a Paid Up for Life


membership. If you are not a current member, you can join simply by clicking here.
