




Dear Members and Friends of the American Legion Auxiliary,


Thank you for the honored privilege to serve as your 2024-2025 Department President. How swift the year has gone by in a whirlwind of activities! Thank you all for each one! Our 2025 Summer Convention at the Mirabeau Hotel and Convention Center in Spokane Valley was a tremendous success because of you!

We had reports from Department Officers, Districts, Committee Chairpersons and celebrated awards for Department Scholarships, Unit Member of the Year Susan Baker, and Unit & District "first" 100% of Goal Membership award trophies. We also had special incentive drawings for the Auxiliary Emergency Fund Challenge (a beautiful wooden eagle sign made by Department AEF Chair Tina Loomer's veteran son), 12 - 2025-2026 Memberships, the ALA Academy Challenge prize, a special 90-100% of Goal Unit Membership plaque, lots of ALA prizes and daily 50/50 drawings. The Eighth District Convention Committee provided 2 special events during the convention - a Wednesday evening Spokane Indians' baseball game at the Avista Stadium during their Family Feast Night and an American Legion Family Summer Fun Party in the Mirabeau Park Hotel Courtyard featuring live music by "My Own Worst Enemy."
