MATERIALS TO RECYCLE IN PLEASANT HILL'S RECYCLING CONTAINER AT TOWN HALL (THURS. 2-4; SAT. 10-12. NO FEE)



AND IN CURBSIDE BINS OR BAGS ON 2ND WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH (FREE FOR <u>ALL</u> PLEASANT HILL RESIDENTS) FREE RECYCLE BINS ARE AVAILABLE AT TOWN HALL

WHAT TO RECYCLE? THESE CAN BE MIXED TOGETHER

•Paper: clean/dry cardboard including brown bags, letters, newspaper, junk mail, notes, food cartons, tissue boxes, magazines, catalogs, etc.

•Plastic Containers: clean/dry, only #1 or #2 in the recycle triangle on bottom of container. Lids must also have #1 or #2 in triangle.

•Metal Containers: clean/dry, no lids (food cans, aluminum soda cans, etc.)

SEPARATE GLASS FROM PAPER, PLASTIC, AND METAL

•Clear, Brown and Green clean/dry bottles, jars, etc. No broken glass, light bulbs, window glass, etc.

DO NOT RECYCLE – PUT IN TRASH

Food-contaminated containers, dirty paper/cardboard, lids, non-recyclable plastics (#3 - #7, any other kind of plastic such as plastic bags, garden hose, plastic chairs, kids toys, etc.), alkaline batteries, dried latex paint cans, Styrofoam, incandescent bulbs, food waste, etc.
Scrap metal, appliances, pipe, metal frames, construction waste, dry wall, wood, concrete, etc.
