Volunteers Needed For the Championship Show.

Changes/Clarifications to the Show Bill

JACKPOT JUMPING - Riders need to go clear (first round only) in Class #307 in order to ride Class #308 (the Jackpot).

Rules for Jackpot:

- Participant must complete the First Round clean without any knockdowns, refusals, or eliminations and within the posted course time limit in order to proceed to the Jump Off Round.
- The rider must wait for the whistle before beginning their course.
- The judge will blow the whistle when it is time to start the Jump Off Round.
- From the whistle, the rider has 45 seconds to begin the Jump Off Round.
- The best time with least faults will place first.
- Knockdowns are worth 4 faults and refusals worth 4 faults. Second cumulative refusal is elimination.
 - Class max height 4'
 - Schooling fences max height 4'
- All contestants will complete 1st round and then the course reset for the Jump Off. Those who were clear in round 1 will proceed to the Jump Off Round. The winner will be determined by the fastest & cleanest ride. In the event of any ties, the Jackpot will be split.

FREESTYLE CHAMPIONSHIP RIDES - All freestyle Championship rides from First - Fourth Level will receive handicap percentage points to their final score. (i.e., First Level - 1%; Second Level - 2%; Third Level - 3%; Fourth Level - 4%)

1. May be earned over one or more years of competition.
2. Must include scores from at least two different IaDCTA-Recognized shows.
3. Will be awarded for the following achievements:
 - a. **Bronze Medal** for three (3) scores of 55% to 59.99% at a given level.
 - b. **Silver Medal** for three (3) scores of 60% to 64.99% at a given level.
 - c. **Gold Medal** for three (3) scores of 65% or better at a given level.
4. Scores may be earned on one or more horses.
5. After receiving the highest Rider Award at a given level, a rider is no longer eligible to earn a Medal at that level.
6. It is the responsibility of the rider to apply for a rider award by using the IaDCTA Qualified Rider Award Application form.
7. Rider must be an IaDCTA member and the Rider and Horse must be nominated for scores to count.
8. This Rider Awards program is effective starting January 1, 1998 and is not retroactive.

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

IaDCTA Meeting Minutes Tuesday, September 17, 2013 Prairie Meadows, Altoona, IA 6:30pm

Roll Call: Barb Zukowski, Stana Hanson, Tammy Lisi, Sherie Vermeer, Chris Gutierrez, Nena Denman, Taylor Hildreth, Michele Kalsem

Absent: PJ Koehler, Shana Kelly

Meeting was called to order at 7:09 pm.

Approval of minutes: Motion to approve the minutes by Sherie Vermeer. Second by Chris Gutierrez. Motion carried.

Approval of the Agenda: Added 2014 Classics and Education to old business. Motion to approve the minutes by Sherie Vermeer. Second by Stana Hanson. Motion carried.

Monthly Financial Report: Income was limited for the month. Sent out check to Healing Hearts with Horses group. Motion to approve the financial report as written by Nena Denman. Second by Barb Zukowski. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Championships: All set to go for the championship show in October. Discussion regarding adding a handicap to the freestyle championship rides. Nena motioned that a percentage point increase be added to each level, first through fourth, for the freestyle championship rides. (First level=1%, Second level=2%, Third level=3%, Fourth level=4%). Second by Stana Hanson. Motion carried. Discussion took place regarding placing a minimum percentage on test in order to receive a blue ribbon in the 2014 show year. Discussion tabled. The costume class for the 2014 championships will also be dropped, but will be available for the 2013 championships.

Awards: Currently are in good shape with ribbons for the championship show. Will need to order blue and red ribbons for next show season. Discussion took place regarding changing the year end awards by awarding the larger prizes for IaDCTA year end awards, and smaller awards for USDF awards. Discussion tabled.

Website: Chris Gutierrez found a manual for the website. Michele Kalsem came and talked to us about managing the website, the cost, and proposed that her hours spent working on the website would cover her volunteer hours (for one horse/rider combination) for year end awards. Discussion has been tabled. Still looking into background information for the website.

Banquet: Tentative date for the banquet is January 26th, 2014 at the Blank Park Zoo at 1pm. Johnny's Italian Steak House will be the caterer. More information to follow.

USDF Convention: PJ Koehler will be the proxy for the 2013 Convention. Nomination awards have been sent in by Tammy Lisi.

2014 Classics: An ad has been emailed to be printed in the 2013 Regional Championships competitor's booklet. Discussion took place regarding the cost of the 2013 Classics. Discussion also took place regarding adding jackpot and prize money classes to the 2014 classes. Details will be worked out in future meetings.
