MINUTES - MARCH

Meeting was called to order at 6:43 pm on March 10, 2014

In attendance were: Barb Zukowski, Sharon Malmberg, Danielle Baker, Tammy Lisi, Chris Guitierrez, PJ Koehler, Sherie Vermeer, and Katie Barrowcliff. Not attending was Nena Denman.

Motion was made by Sherie and seconded by Danielle to approve minutes from February meeting.

Motion was made by Sherie and seconded by Danielle to approve treasurer's reports from January and February.

Website is still under construction.

A clarification was made to advertising in the Collection and having an email blast sent out. Non IaDCTA members who wish to have an email blast sent advertising their event, must buy an ad in the Collection for \$30 with the email being an additional \$10.

The Matt McLaughlin clinic was discussed. The dates are May 16, 17, and 18, 2014 and will be held at Palisades Equestrian Center in Prole, IA. Prices for IaDCTA members were decided to be \$125 for one ride or \$115 per ride for the weekend. Nonmembers would be charged \$150 for one ride or \$140 per ride for the weekend. Auditing fees would be \$30 per day or \$50 for the weekend for IaDCTA members, and \$40 per day or \$70 for the weekend for nonmembers. A dinner and lecture will be on May 16 at 6:30 pm with a \$10 charge for riders, \$15 for IaDCTA members, and \$20 for nonmembers. Topics for the lecture were discussed. Any ideas may be sent to Barb.

Motion was made by Danielle, seconded by Barb to require either 7 volunteer hours, OR gaining 4 new memberships, OR \$200 CASH to go to the general fund in order for members to be eligible for year-end awards. Motion was approved by 6 and opposed by 1.

Award standings will be kept track of electronically on the website. Members will be required to print out the sheet and turn in at the end of the year to receive their awards. Nomination fees must be paid before the class is ridden.

The club has been asked to rent the show arena for the 2014 Iowa Games. A contract will be written up for the cost of \$100 per day with the requirement of proof of insurance.

Motion was made by Sherie and seconded by Sharon to donate \$200 to Maffitt Lake to be put in the fund for a memorial bench for Stephanie Visser.

Motion was made by Sherie and seconded by Chris to designate funds from the raffle at the Classics to go to a scholarship fund in Stephanie Visser's name.

Motion was made by Chris and seconded by PJ to adjourn at 8:48 pm.

The next meeting will by April 7, 2014 at 6:30 pm at the Okoboji Bar and Grill in Newton.


