Present: Dawn Zwart, PJ Koehler, Chris Gutierrez (skype), Stana Hanson, Sherie Vermeer, Heather McCauley, Shay Frederick, Camie Stockhausen and Tammy Lisi (skype).

Meeting called to order at 6:53 pm on July 17, 2012

Minutes of the June meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve as written Tammy, Second Chris

Agenda was read. Motion to approve by Dawn, second by Sherie.

Treasurer's report: Opening Balance \$13,525.51, Total Income \$29,840.98, Total Expenses \$23,949.98. Net Income for June \$5,891.00. New Working Balance \$19,416.51, Reserve Balance \$7,768.97. Bank Balance is \$.21,185.48, CD \$5,600. Total of all accounts \$27,185.48.

Motion to approve the June's Treasurer's report made by PJ. Motion second by Stana, all in favor.

Chris provided a profit and loss statement for the Classics I and II. We had a total income of \$32,684.98 and a total expense of \$24,511.98. We had a net income of \$8,173.00

A motion was made to donate a portion of the profits to Wildwood Hills Ranch in the amount of \$500. The motion was made by Stana, Second by Dawn. All in favor. PJ to get the contact information. The remainder of the profits to go be allocated to the Classics in 2013.

A proposal was made by Dawn to offer something to MLEC in return for giving the club a considerable discount on the facilities. A counterproposal was made to offer IaDCTA bucks gift cards in the amount of \$25 per day for high point gift baskets to be given at MLEC schooling shows. Motion by Shay, Second by PJ, all in favor.

Allocation of funds from the Classics into a separate account was discussed. A motion to put remaining profits (after donation to Wildwood Hills) into this fund made by Stana/Second by Sherie. We will research the type of account to balance rates vs liquidity.



The show season is half over . . . how do you know if you have qualified for the championship classes at the IaDCTA Schooling Show & Series Championship held at the Iowa Equestrian Center on October 26th-28th?

Please use the criteria below to determine if you have met the championship qualifications.

To be eligible, horse/rider must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Rider, trainer, and/or owner must be IaDCTA member at the time qualifying scores are earned.
- 2. Each Horse/Rider combination must be nominated at the time qualifying scores are earned.
- 3. Nomination fee for each horse/rider combination must be paid prior to the time qualifying scores are earned.
- 4. Rider may only qualify to win at two consecutive levels on the same horse, but riders may qualify as many horses as they wish.
- 5. For each level, a horse/rider combination may only win the championship once. You may win in only 2 consecutive levels in the same year.
- 6. If riders share a horse, the horse will be limited to four rides per day at two consecutive levels and only one horse/rider combination per level or class.
- 7. Perform at least one type of service per horse/rider combination.
 - Complete 7 hours of volunteer time.
 - Recruit 4 new members to IaDCTA.
 - Raise \$200.00 in sponsorship money for IaDCTA. (example: breed association sponsorship)

Dressage:

To qualify for the IaDCTA Championships, each horse/rider combination must earn a total of three qualifying scores from highest test of the level. The qualifying scores must be at three different IaDCTA recognized schooling shows or from the Iowa Dressage Classic I & II, from three different judges at the minimum scores as listed below. Only two scores from two different judges are required for In Hand, Equitation, Quadrille, Pas de Deuex, Prix Caprilli, Musical Freestyle, and FEI that meet the minimum score requirements below. Two placements between first and fourth place in Dressage Equitation.

Championship ride will be the highest test of the level, from memory and with no whips.

The rider is responsible for submitting copies of the qualifying tests with the championship entry form, with the exception of Dressage Equitation, where results from the show where placement was earned must be submitted with the entry.
