

Present: Dawn Zwart, PJ Koehler, Chris Gutierrez, Sherie Vermeer, Heather McCauley, Vicki Gatter and Tammy Lisi.

Meeting called to order at 6:49 pm on November 15, 2012

Minutes of the October meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve as written by Vicki/second by Chris.

Agenda was read and an agenda item was added. Motion to approve revised agenda by PJ.

Treasurer's report

October's Treasurer's report was read by Chris and a motion to approve by Sherie, a second by Vicki.

Chris reported a small loss with \$101.00 loss for the Championship Show before paying for judges' lodging.

President's report: Membership: We have 131 current Members. Heather reported mostly on the championship show since she managed the show. Heather reported a lack of volunteers, especially on Sunday. Dressage judges seemed pleased while the jump judge was frustrated. Tammy & PJ will review dressage & jump judges for next year since we have had the same jump judge since hosting the show in Cedar Rapids.

Old Business: Banquet Dawn brought correspondence from Glorious Desserts rescinding offer of dessert for banquet due to internal board conflict. Tammy will locate new vendor to provide desserts. Dawn Zwart presented her resignation as Secretary at this time. Heather accepted resignation.

<u>Ballots</u> – PJ reported that more nominations are needed, as well as the newly opened Secretary position. There are also few volunteer of the year nominations and more are encouraged.

<u>Year-End Awards</u>. Board currently has some breed awards but need more. Board needs volunteers to solicit breed organizations. Heather to send an email to membership requesting volunteer to solicit breed awards for year-end awards and the 2013 Classics. Sherie reported that more silent auction items are needed. She has set a goal of \$1,500 to \$2,000 in silent auction items.

Will promote to Nebraska, eastern Iowa, Missouri, Illinois, and Wisconsin. Use FB sites to advertise.

New Business:

Show Calendar – IaDCTA will be adding late fees (\$20) and incomplete entry fees to show bills to discourage late entries. Classics secretary charges IaDCTA extra for incomplete entries. She waived fees for 2012 but will not for 2013. Due to survey sent out after Classics, membership liked PreClassics better than Warm Up. Board will host PreClassics in 2013 instead of Warm Up. Need to decide on recognition fee for 2013, as well as get show calendars from barns previously desiring recognition.

<u>Computer</u> - Club needs a new printer. Motion made to purchase new printer by PJ; seconded by Chris. Vicki also reported a need to update our Norton antivirus on laptop. Motion made by PJ to update Nortion; seconded by Sherie.

Next Meeting will be held Sunday, January 20, 2013, at the Blank Park Zoo in Des Moines, Iowa.
