Ride a test and schooling show. The March Ride a test and schooling show judge is Joyce Hardesty and Chris Gutierrez has offered to be manager and secretary if no one else wants to volunteer.

Clinic and dinner with the judge: Contracts have been sent to Dolly and Iowa State Fairgrounds. Stalls will be \$25 per horse with no jump out option. They will have concessions right in the pavilion but we can have a concierge in the barn. We cannot have horses come in on Friday night but can come early on Saturday and will offer a 9 am start time to provide opportunity to work in the arena before hand. Dolly will do 10 rides per day.

Dinner with the judge – Vicki will be looking into Chips in Ankeny and the availability of a flat rate limited menu option. This will be an informal question and answer dinner.

Banquet Dawn is to put together a flyer for the collection.

Ballots – PJ has a rough draft of the nominations for the board. We are still encouraging people to nominate or self-nominate. She has also included on the ballot the names of the organizations that people have suggested as charitable organizations to sponsor with our shows.

New Business:

Training Level Freestyle – USDF has written a training level freestyle test and we will be switching from our own schooling show test requirements to the USDF test in 2013. The test will be posted on our website for members to access. There are significant changes in the test requirements so if you have a musical freestyle for training level, you will need to revise it for 2013.

MLEC contract MLEC needs a contract signed for our shows in 2013. Stana to handle contacting them.

Upgrading our Classics show status to level 3 The show managers/secretary at MLEC have been working to get approved as show managers and secretary positions to enable the Classics I and II to be rated as a level 3 show. We will have Debbie Garis look into the feasibility of doing it in 2013 and making the request for 2014.

Year End Awards Sherie brought in the year end awards coolers that will be given at the January banquet.

Fundraising An idea was presented by a member to the board to do a schooling show omnibus with the surrounding state GMOs and sell advertising in the omnibus. The board reviewed the idea and thought that while the idea is a good one, we do not have the capacity to work on this.

Next Meeting will be held Thursday November 15, 2012, at location Okoboji Grill in Newton at 6:30 pm. All members are welcome to attend.
