Despite the beauty of fall, I normally dread the leaves beginning to change because it signifies that winter is on its way. As this year has progressed, I have begun to realize that change is not always a bad thing. At the beginning of the year, the club was concerned about the unscheduled changes to our Board. Yet, we all persevered and survived and have grown as club members and individuals ever since. I personally have learned so many things this year regarding how to conduct a meeting (thank you PJ), hold a rated show, and about working with others. I am sure other board members who had to "step up" have also learned some things about themselves.

Since I dislike change so much, it is weird that I fell in love with dressage. Perhaps, I never realized in the beginning how ever-changing it is, but by the time I did realize it, it was too late as I was hooked. As I have slowly climbed up the levels, it has been hard to get excited to work on the hard stuff with my horse. You know — the stuff he doesn't do easily; the stuff that takes more effort out of me. Again, the change that I normally dread, but as we continue to work, however, each level becomes increasingly easier for both of us. I have even noticed a difference in my horse with the required changes need to progress. He has become more obedient, more supple, and a more pleasant ride all around — dare I say he has grown mentally and emotionally as well.

As I sit here on my last day of work at a position I have had for seventeen years, I can thank dressage (and my trainer) for giving me the courage to move on. Dressage has made me realize that change is a good thing. As long as I work hard and believe in myself, anything is possible as long as good basics are there. There are always road bumps in dressage as in life. I can still remember the days where not being able to leg yield brought tears to my eyes due to frustration. Now, however, we are able to practice half-pass with little effort. Change helps build character and self-esteem, and while I used to run away from it, I now embrace it. I encourage you to do the same by filling out those entry forms for the MLEC show or the championship show. I dare you to ride a test in front of some great judges despite your nerves or maybe enter a freestyle even though you have never done one before. I assure you that you and your horse can only grow from the experience.

Retirement Ceremony PJ will be retiring a horse at the show and we will invite others who are retiring a horse to bring their horse as part of the retirement ceremony to be held during the entertainment portion of the event on Saturday evening.

Awards Sherie has received the saddle pads from HORZE that will be used for Championship awards

HOY Guidelines for Eventing and Dressage

PJ has been reviewing the awards criteria and with the help of much input from our eventing members has made updates for 2013. Eventing classes only will have updated judge qualification criteria and all classes (eventing and dressage) will have a revision of the number of different judges required to allow for more ease of contracting judges with so many shows offered. Also, she updated some formatting for clarity. Stana made a motion that we approve the revised HOY guidelines for 2013, Sherie second, unanimous approval.

Education Committee-

Clinic and dinner with the judge: The possibility of bringing in "S" judge Dolly Hannon for a 2 day clinic and dinner with the judge in February 2013 was discussed. The show season is just about over....how do you know if you have qualified for the championship classes at the IaDCTA Schooling Show & Series Championship held at the Iowa Equestrian Center on October 26th-28th?

Please use the criteria below to determine if you have met the championship qualifications.

To be eligible, horse/rider must met the following qualifications:

1. Rider, trainer and/or owner must be IaDCTA member at the time qualifying scores are earned.
2. Each Horse/Rider combination must be nominated at the time qualifying scores are earned.
3. Nomination fee for each horse/rider combination must be paid prior to the time qualifying scores are earned.
4. Rider may only qualify to win at two consecutive levels on the same horse, but riders may qualify as many horses as they wish.
5. For each level, a horse/rider combination may only win the championship once. You may win in only 2 consecutive levels in the same year.
6. If riders share a horse, the horse will be limited to four rides per day at two consecutive levels and only one horse/rider combination per level or class.
7. Perform at least one type of service **per horse/rider combination**.
 - Complete 7 hours of volunteer time.
 - Recruit 4 new members to IaDCTA.
 - Raise \$200.00 in sponsorship money for IaDCTA. (example: breed association sponsorship)

Dressage:

To qualify for the IaDCTA Championships, each horse/rider combination must earn a total of three qualifying scores from highest test of the level. The qualifying scores must be at three different IaDCTA recognized schooling shows or from the Iowa Dressage Classic I & II, from three different judges at the minimum scores as listed below. Only two scores from two different judges are required for In Hand, Equitation, Quadrille, Pas de Deux, Prix Caprilli, Musical Freestyle, and FEI that meet the minimum score requirements below. Two placements between first and fourth place in Dressage Equitation.

Championship ride will be the highest test of the level, from memory and with no whips.

The rider is responsible for submitting copies of the qualifying tests with the championship entry form, with the exception of Dressage Equitation, where results from the show where placement was earned must be submitted with the entry.

The minimum qualifying score is 60% for In-Hand, Quadrille, Pas De Deux, Prix Caprilli or Freestyle for All Divisions.

Combined Test:

To qualify for the Combined Test Championships, each horse/rider combination must have placed between 1st and 4th place at a given level, in two different IaDCTA recognized schooling shows (scores earned in 3-phase classes may be considered for qualification for Championship but only 2-phase will be held at the show).

1. A High point award will be given to the Local Horse/Rider combination with the highest average score for Introductory, Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth levels, Equitation, Prix Caprilli, Freestyle, In Hand and FEI Dressage as well as for all levels of Combined Training.
2. Rider must include **three** scores from **three** different IaDCTA Locally Recognized shows (see web site for list of qualifying shows and minimum score requirements) and **three** different judges. Scores must be from the **highest** test of the level.
3. It is the responsibility of the rider to submit the scores with a copy of the front page of the test showing the test % score. A printout of the official results from the shows should be used for Equitation and Combined Training (see web site for official results).
4. Rider must be an IaDCTA member and the Rider and Horse must have been nominated prior to the show where scores were earned for the scores to count.
5. Volunteer hours are required for each horse/rider combination.

Qualified Rider Award Application

1. May be earned over one or more years of competition.
2. Must include scores from at least two different IaDCTA-Recognized shows.
3. Will be awarded for the following achievements:
 - a. **Bronze Medal** for three (3) scores of 55% to 59.99% at a given level.
 - b. **Silver Medal** for three (3) scores of 60% to 64.99% at a given level.
 - c. **Gold Medal** for three (3) scores of 65% or better at a given level.
4. Scores may be earned on one or more horses.
5. After receiving the highest Rider Award at a given level, a rider is no longer eligible to earn a Medal at that level.
6. It is the responsibility of the rider to apply for a rider award by using this IaDCTA Qualified Rider Award Application form.
7. Rider must be an IaDCTA member and the Rider and Horse must be nominated for scores to count.
8. This Rider Awards program is effective starting January 1, 1998 and is not retroactive.
