COVID-19 Special Conditions:

Kannada Sangha Queensland (KSQ) is committed to the safety of patrons who attend the event. To ensure your safety KSQ has adopted some special conditions that respond to the global coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

Doors will open at 4PM with event starting at 4:30pm.

1. KSQ reserves the right to change procedures and requirements for collection of tickets. Registered Patrons' name may be checked at the door against details provided at the time of booking. As a condition of entry, you may be required to present the E-Ticket or email confirmation for the event. Seating will be allocated by KSQ based on the size of the group, time of booking and venue configuration, to comply with current social distancing requirements.

2. In accordance with health guidelines, KSQ may require payments for membership/entry fee/raffle tickets/donation to be completed using contactless payments. The preferred payment is contactless transaction (Electronic Payment or Bank transfer only). EFTPOS will be available at the entrance.

3. You must not attend the event if you are required to be in isolation with a COVID-19 diagnosis or have been directed to be in quarantine because of close contact with a person with COVID-19 or if you are experiencing any of symptoms of COVID-19.

4. All visitors must comply with any COVID-19 safety protocols or requirements communicated to you by the venue (including signage at the venue or floor line markings). This includes complying with:

- Hand hygiene requirements: Practice high-level hand-hygiene using the sanitiser stations located around the venue.
- Social distancing requirements (including physical spacing requirements while queuing);
- Person limits for each space or area;
- Please sit at the seat that has been designated to you. This helps us in maintaining records and follow up if required.

You acknowledge that anyone not adhering to these requirements may be in breach of directions issued by the Queensland Chief Health Officer for which penalties may apply.

5. You acknowledge that prior or after entry the venue may be required to collect contact tracing information from you and each member of your party when you visit KSQ event. This information includes the name(s) of all the attendee(s) and phone number of one person from family that attends the event including children and babies. Via booking link provided by KSQ.

6. You agree to provide KSQ with any information we are required to collect for contact tracing purposes. The purpose of collecting this information is to assist any contact tracing in the event of an outbreak or potential exposure to someone with COVID-19 at the event. You acknowledge that we may disclose contact tracing information to health authorities or as otherwise required or authorised by law. You acknowledge that we may retain the information for 28 days (or such longer period as required by law), after which time it will be deleted or destroyed. While we hold the information, we will take all reasonable steps to keep your contact tracing information secure and free from unauthorised access or use.

7. You may be refused entry or required to leave the event if you:

- Refuse to comply with any COVID-19 safety protocols or requirements notified to you by KSQ.
- Refuse to comply with any reasonable health and safety directions given by KSQ.
- Refuse to provide contact tracing information to KSQ on request.
- Are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, as notified to or as assessed by any patrons. These include: fever, chills or sweats, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose or loss of sense or smell.
- Are required to be in isolation as a result of COVID-19 diagnosis or have been directed to be in quarantine because of close contact with a person with COVID-19.

8. We ask that every visitor make a reasonable assessment of your health status before attending our event, KSQ will not be responsible for any health outcomes.

9. We encourage all patrons to bring and wear their own face mask. (Not mandatory).

10. You must notify KSQ immediately if you develop any symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days of attending the KSQ event. Please contact us immediately via Kannadasanghaqld@gmail.com.

11. Food cannot be taken into or consumed in the venue. "Food" means anything you can eat, and includes all food items, such as meals and snacks (e.g. Biscuits, chips and nuts) due to COVID restrictions.
