

Pope Leo XIV has emphasized a pastoral approach characterized by humility, service, and a focus on the needs of the marginalized, particularly those most vulnerable and suffering. In the Pastoral Care Outreach training program, participants learn how to accompany the lonely, sick, elderly, palliative, and the dying. The training is for those who are interested in being pastoral care visitors to homebound and shut-ins, and in hospitals and long term care facilities. It's also for those who wish to gain skills to help care for their family members, friends and neighbours, or as a personal undertaking. The next series of Pastoral Care Outreach trainings sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 am - 12:00 pm, from **January 24 - March 28**, with no session on March 7. Missed sessions can be made up, and a beautiful Certificate of Completion is provided to those who complete all nine sessions. Participants will require a phone number and email address, a computer, tablet or smartphone that has a web camera and microphone, a reliable internet connection, and Zoom access.
