The Elks Pediatric Clinic sees more than 65,000 children a year! Our second project is the **Jack C. Warter Elks Youth Camp**, located 40 miles northeast of Globe, Arizona, on Workman Creek in the Sierra Ancha Mountain Range. This Youth camp is open to all youth groups free of cost!



## Veterans Committee - Bob Kielsa, PER & Belinda Waller



As of September 20, 2022, our noncash donations, which include used clothing and shoes, sits at \$93,865, and our cash donations total \$5,803, bringing our total donations to date to \$99,682.

We have been helping our **Paralyzed Veterans** for a number of years now and, sadly, the coach for the group participating in the games passed away earlier this year. Because Karen Gialle was such an important contributor to these games your Lodge Past Exalted Rulers Association has decided to establish a *memorial fund*, in Karen's name, to be used primarily for our Paralyzed Veterans.

The **PERs** have decided to set the funding for the memorial fund at \$50,000. To accomplish this funding, our first event will be a *gun raffle*. We have two donated guns that will be raffled off at the same time. The first is a Ruger

M77 270 Winchester with a Bushnell 3x25 scope. The second is an Ithaca Deer Slayer pump action 12 gauge shotgun with a modified second barrel. Tickets will go on sale (1 for \$5 and 5 for \$20) October 1st through our bar stewards. The drawing will take place on Friday, December 16th, during the *Queen of Hearts*.

Because we need to establish more revenue streams for our Veteran initiatives, I would like to explore the idea of establishing a committee of "*Crafters*" to create items needed for Veterans and for us to sell at the Lodge. We have set up a first meeting for November 11th at 2 pm for those interested in participating in this fundraiser .
