EXT. STARKE PARK - DAY

Arial Shot of an Austin Texas area disc golf course (Starke Park?) Zoom down to a man with a box of discs doing field work (Throwing each disc)

- A kid on his bicycle (11-12 years old) is riding in the park - Smash cut going back and forth with the kid pedaling and the man throwing for a few seconds.

- The kid slides his bike to a stop near the "Old Man" and watches him throw his discs

KID

Hey Mister, why do you have so many frisbees?

MAN

These are Discs for Disc golf, buddy, and I'm throwing them to see what they all do and to hopefully, learn to throw them better.

The kid parks his bike and walks over closer to examine the man's box of discs, and then watches as the man launches a disc down the fairway.

KID

Whoa, you can throw really far! Can I try one?

MAN

Sure.

The man tosses him a disc. The kid steps to throw without any form or run up and the disc wobbles out around 15 to 20 feet.

KID

How do you get yours to go so much further?

MAN

It's more about form than it is about power. You want to get the spin coming from your whole body, not just your arm. Check this out:

The man takes a three-step ex-step and launches a disc about 350-400 feet down the fairway. He picks up another disc.

MAN (CONT'D)

I'm going to do it slowly this time. Watch my feet and my arm here. It's just three steps and you don't have to go very quickly. Set up, cross, plant. Right foot forward, set up, left foot behind, cross, and then plant your right foot in front. Not too big on the last step, and with your body weight moving forward. You want your arm to be all the way back when your front foot plants, then bring your arm straight across your body leaning forward just a little so your weight is on your toes, and keep your back straight.

The man moves fairly slowly through the steps and throws again.

MAN (CONT'D)

Now try again

The man tosses another disc to the kid. The kid copies the man's form and throws the disc down the fairway just short of 300 feet.

KID

Whoa, Awesome! I can throw pretty far now too!

MAN

(Clearly impressed)

Wow, you sure can! I have to go pick all those up and get going. You should keep at this though. With a drive like that, you could be really good at this sport one day.

The man tosses him another disc (just like the one the kid threw but light green)

MAN (CONT'D)

Here. You can keep that one.

KID

Awesome Mister. Thanks!

The man walks away and the kid steps up to the tee box and begins practicing his form for a throw.

He Throws the disc - zoom in on the disc as it's flying through the air to roll the credits over and then as the disc lands zoom out to the disc laying in the seat next to a grown-up version of the kid (our main character) who is driving a lawnmower. The disc is now very worn.

ACT 1, SCENE 1: MEET GABRIEL AND RANDY EXT STARKE PARK - DAY
MUSIC STARTS ("THE WAY WE GET BY" BY SPOON) ZOOM OUT TO A GRAPHIC COMES UP "10 YEARS LATER" - THE KID IS NOW A LANKY 21-YEAR-OLD NAMED GABRIEL (GABE) REYES

WALKIE TALKIE

(Voice is heavily Texan)
Gabriel!! I got a nice one for you over here!
Meet me over by fourteen once you get done with the east pasture!

GABE

(into the walkie-talkie)
Roger.

WALKIE TALKIE

My name is Randy Dummy!

GABE

(into the walkie-talkie)
Boo.

Gabe turns the riding lawn mower around and heads across a big field eventually meeting up with Randy.

Randy is quite a bit older than Gabe and is wearing a ball cap and a shirt with no sleeves (All his shirts have the sleeves cut off) he's sitting on his lawn mower under a huge Pecan Tree and turning a disc over in his hands.

RANDY

Gabriel! You see this? It was just sitting in the fairway. Bat City signature series, over stable distance driver... I bet you could throw this one forever!

He tosses the disc to Gabe

RANDY (CONT'D)

What do you think? No name or number on it, so I think its fair game for you to keep.

GABE

This **is** a nice one! Are you sure you don't want it?

RANDY

Nah, my bag is set, and you could really use some newer, nicer discs anyway.

GABE

I have mine all beat in just the way I like them. Besides if I get too many nice discs, it'll be tougher to get people to bet that they can beat me.

RANDY

(deep voice)

Every day he's hustling, hustling!

Gabe flips the disc over in his hand and test the weight.

GABE

(to himself)

It is a nice disc though.

(To Randy)

Randy, please don't sing.

RANDY

What? I have a beautiful voice.

Gabe stares at Randy, but says nothing.

RANDY (CONT'D)

(in his best Forrest Gump)

Mama always said I had the voice of an angel.

Gabe continues to stare emotionlessly at Randy.

RANDY (CONT'D)

Nothing? Fine. We playing this afternoon, or do you have to work at the restaurant?

GABE

You know I have to work. Maybe we can get a round in before dinner rush though... Let's get everything mowed ASAP so we have time!

The two men fire up the mowers and drive off

ACT 1, SCENE 2: Lost and Found

EXT TOOL SHED AREA - DAY

WIDE SHOT OF THE COURSE TOOLSHED WHERE THE MOWERS ARE PARKED. GABE IS LOOKING THROUGH HIS DISC BAG (WHICH IS AN HEB REUSABLE GROCERY BAG) THERE IS SOME SMOKE AND COUGHING COMING FROM A BACK OFFICE.

Gabe bangs on the door

GABE

Daylight's burning old man, are you ready or what? I'm psyched about trying this new disc.

(he reads from his phone)

Twelve speed, four glide, negative one turn and three fade. Bunch of the online reviews say it's more stable than the given numbers though.

There's a knock outside the shed and woman leans around the open door. She is middle-aged with hair graying at the temples.

KATY

I lost a disc earlier today, and I heard that you have a lost and found somewhere around here?

GABE

Yes ma'am, there's a lost and found right over there. Did you have your name and number on it?

KATY

Technically it has my name on it... It was Green with a swirl, Over-stable Driver. Hundred and seventy-three grams.

Gabe looks at the disc in his hands which matches her description exactly

GABE

We actually found this one earlier today. There's no name or anything on it though.

KATY

Yeah, I need to be better about that -- Turn it over kid.

Gabe turns over the disc to see that it's a Katy Brooks Signature series Driver.

GABE

(Doubtful)

You're Katy Brooks?

KATY

I am indeed! Was my disc the one that you were just yelling at that other guy about trying out?

GABE

it was. You can have it back though.

Gabe starts to hand it over but Katy pushes it back

KATY

Tell you what kid, I have some time before I have to head out today. I'll play you for it.

GABE

Really? That would be awesome. When Randy gets done in the back, he's going to freak out... That is if you're really THE Katy Brooks.

RANDY

(From the back and coughing a little)

On my way brother, just getting a fresh T-shirt!

Randy comes out of the back room wearing sleeveless T-shirt and fitting one of its freshly cut sleeves on his head as a headband.

RANDY (CONT'D)

this one's a little tight, I guess my head is still bigger than my arms.

Randy see's the woman and immediately recognizes her as Katy Brooks (Des Reading?) who is a previous disc golf world champion.

RANDY (CONT'D)
(Star-struck))
Holy Shi- You're Katy Brooks!

Randy wipes his hands on his pants then looks at them, and then decides to offer a fist bump.

RANDY (CONT'D)
Hi there! I'm Randy... And, er,
this is my friend Gabe, so nice to
meet you!!

Randy then walks over to Gabe and tries to take the disc that they found earlier (never taking his eyes off of Katy) there is a quiet, whispered struggle as Randy eventually gets the disc.

RANDY (CONT'D)
Actually um... we found this disc
earlier today... It didn't have a
name or a number on the back.

KATY
I was just talking to your friend,
here about that, and we've decided
to play for it.

RANDY
(Immediately)
Yes, Gabe would love to play Katy
Brooks err, you, for a chance to
keep her, um your, signature series
disc!

GABE
That sounds really fun. What say we
do three holes, but to play them we
each select three discs from the
lost and found there.

RANDY
(in a loud whisper)
Gabriel!! Do NOT try to hustle Katy
Brooks!

GABE
(Also whispering)
It's not a hustle, just a fun idea.

There is a is another indistinguishable hushed argument between the two.

GABE (CONT'D)
 (Still whispering)
 Just be cool Randy

RANDY
 (also still whispering)
 I am being cool dammit!

KATY
 (selecting three discs
 from the shelf)
 I'll use these three.

ACT 1, SCENE 3: The First Round

EXT STARKE PARK OR NORTHTOWN - DAY

The three people are now out on the course near the t-box.
 Gabe and Katy are stretching and getting ready to throw. Hole
 1 at North-town would be a good place for this

RANDY
 (Using a stick as a mic)
 We have a very special round for
 you today folks. FPO five-time
 World champion, Katy Brooks is here
 to take on our Maintenance Team
 favorite, The man with all the arm
 and none of the charm, Gabriel
 Reyes!!

GABE
 Do you have to do the announcer?
 You're embarrassing both of us in
 front of the nice lady.

RANDY
 Hole one is a six-hundred and
 thirty-two foot par four. It's a
 long way to the basket people, but
 the shot is wide open with just a
 few trees at the end. How will our
 players take this one on?

KATY
 (To Gabe)
 You want to go first?

GABE

Sure. Are you sure you're okay with
this guy and his stick microphone?
(motions towards Randy)

RANDY

And Mr. Reyes is on the clock! If
he continues to hassle the booth,
he could get charged an extra
stroke, which would severely limit
his chances of victory today.

KATY

I think you better just throw.

Gabe steps up to throw and launches the disc out just over
five hundred feet.

KATY (CONT'D)

(unfazed, but still
impressed)
that one sure had some heat on it!

GABE

(Blushing)
Hey thanks!

Katy steps up and throws next. Her shot is smooth, accurate
and straight towards the basket, but well short of Gabe's.

RANDY

And our players have their drives
out on the field now. Gabe has put
his shot WAY down the fairway and
will likely be attempting to lay up
the next shot for a birdie. Katy
had a great shot down the middle of
the fairway and will need another
one just like that one to set
herself up for a birdie as well.

Katy takes the next shot from her drive. Ends up being about
a 300-foot shot that lands right next to the basket.

RANDY (CONT'D)

And Katy shows some of that world-
class talent and lays a long shot
right up under the basket.

KATY

(to Gabe)
You know, I kind of like having an
announcer.

RANDY

The heat is on for Gabe now. This shot is well out of his putting range, so he'll need to lay up for the birdie.

GABE

Me too, his analysis is usually spot on...

Gabe takes his shot and lays it up right next to Katy's and they both get their birdies on hole one. They head to the next hole. Katy nods at Gabe obviously respecting what she has seen so far.

RANDY

We're now headed to hole two and we're all tied up folks. This is a shorter hole with curve to the right past some trees. Three hundred and fifteen feet for a par three. Mr. Reyes has the box!

Gabe takes his throw and drops the disc about 10 feet past the basket.

Katy throws, and her shot lands about 35ft short of the basket.

RANDY (CONT'D)

And it looks like both of our competitors had excellent drives. Gabe's throw should be a drop in birdie. Katy has a bit of tester sitting just outside circle one, but that is well within her putting range.

Katy sinks the long putt, then Gabe makes his much easier putt as well.

KATY

Usually in pro matches, the players don't get to hear the hole breakdown or the commentary. This is actually pretty fun Randy.

Randy Blushes and smiles sheepishly

GABE

It grows on you... Of course...
It's grown on me to the point where
I hear his announcer character even
when he's not around.

KATY

And you see that as a good thing?

Gabe shrugs. And Randy cuts in.

RANDY

Okay folks we're still all tied up
after two, but let's see how our
players handle the third hole of
our competition. This one is a
tough, and technical, six-hundred-
and-fifty-foot par four. It starts
out going down an alley and then
has a sharp left turn, and about
another hundred feet to the basket.

Katy and Gabe line up and throw down the alley with very
similar shots. Gabe still has just a little more distance on
his.

RANDY (CONT'D)

This one is coming down to the
wire! Both of our contestants have
landed safely in the fair way, but
there's still a long way to go! The
next shot has to be low, and it'll
need to be shaped to come down with
a left-turning skip towards the
basket.

Katy throws and curves her shot perfectly down the lane and
it comes to stop about 60 feet out from the basket. Gabe
takes his shot, but the trees around the throwing lane and
the turn needed for the shot don't allow him to use his
superior distance and his disc drops about five feet short of
Katy's.

RANDY (CONT'D)

It looks like our two contestants
again have very similar shots, but
Gabe is back and will be taking his
third stroke first.

Gabe lightly throws the disc and it slides up to the basket.
He looks at Katy expecting her to do the same thing.

RANDY (CONT'D)
 (Seeing that Katy is
 lining up for a long
 putt)

Gabriel has laid up for what should
 be a drop in par. Will Ms. Brooks
 be able to take the victory with a
 long Circle Two putt today??

Katy lines up a long putt and it glides right into the basket
 for a birdie. Both Gabe and Randy cheer because it was such
 an awesome shot, but then they realize that Gabe has lost the
 competition.

GABE
 That was an amazing putt!

RANDY
 And we have our winner folks!
 (hands over the disc from
 earlier)
 Your winnings Ms. Brooks. Thank you
 so much for letting me announce
 during your match versus my boy
 Gabe today!

GABE
 It was an absolute pleasure to meet
 you, Katy. I'd love to play again
 sometime.

KATY
 You have a great drive kid. Really.
 If you keep practicing and work on
 getting that putt in without laying
 up, I'd say you have a real shot to
 go pretty far in this sport.

RANDY
 I've been telling him that for
 years!

GABE
 (obviously doubtful)
 I appreciate you saying that.

KATY
 Seriously! I know some pros that
 have been playing for years, that
 would kill to have your distance.

RANDY

I've been telling him that for years too! Except I don't know any real pros... Except my sweet Pea... and now you!

(Smiles sheepishly.)

KATY

Here Gabe,

(Hands him the disc from before)

you keep it. If you'd like a chance to earn it, and maybe some extra cash, I need a doubles partner for tomorrow at four PM. My normal partner...

(pauses considering her words)

Won't be able to make it for this one. I'm on a contract so I still have to play, and I'd really like to beat the other team.

GABE

(Turning the disc over in his hands and smiling)

That sounds awesome! I'm in!

KATY

Cool. I have to go, but it was nice to meet you both. This was fun.

Katy goes to leave but stops and puts a hand on Randy's shoulder.

KATY (CONT'D)

You can join us tomorrow as well, but probably those guys won't want an announcer.

(winks)

RANDY

Hey... yeah fair, I guess.

(Shrugs and turns to Gabe)

Won't you have work tomorrow at 4pm?

GABE

I'll figure something out.

ACT 1, SCENE 4: Gabe at home -

EXT REYES TORTILLAS Y'MAS - NIGHT

There is a Small house with a taco stand and a large patio built in front. A large sign out front says Reyes' Tortillas Y'Mas

GILBERTO

(Gabe's Dad)

You're late again mijo, you waste too much time hanging out with that weird gringo!

ABUELITA

(Gabe's Grandmother)

Be nice to him Gilberto! Te amo, mi dulce nino,

(pinches Gabe's cheeks lovingly and then pats them)

but we have plates up for tables four and seven, and we need you to get drink orders out for three and nine.

GABE

I'm on it Abuelita!

Gabe throws on an apron, grabs his note pad, and Scoops up the plates

GABE (CONT'D)

Randy and I met a pro player on the course today. It was awesome!

ABUELITA

That sounds nice

(raises an eyebrow to Gilberto)

but your father is right, that gringo is un poco raro!

Gabe returns from delivering the plates

GABE

Her name was Katy Brooks and she was so good. Randy found a disc that she had forgotten to pick up, and when she came to the lost and found she offered to play me for it! She won, but let me have it anyway.

GILBERTO

Pro player at Frisbee's? That's not a thing, mijo. Order up for table six!

Gabe's sister, Violet, arrives (she's a Junior in High School) and drops her school bags on a shelf next to the kitchen.

VIOLET

Hi y'all, sorry I'm late. You know if I had my own car and didn't have to ride the bus home, I could get here to help out earlier.

GILBERTO

I don't think the extra thirty minutes that you'd spend here, just looking at your phone will cover the cost of a car for you Mija.

ABUELITA

But if she did have a car, she could drive me to the fabrics store and to Bingo on Wednesday nights!

VIOLET

That wasn't exactly what I had in mind Abuelita, but if you can talk Dad into getting me a car, then you have yourself a deal!

(Then to Gabe)

Top or bottom?

GABE

I have top handled for now, can you take tables eight through fourteen tonight?

VIOLET

You got it big brother.

GABE

I met a pro player on the course today. Have you heard of Katy Brooks?

VIOLET

I think so... She's from around here, right?

GABE

I'm not sure, but she gave me her signature series disc and invited me to play doubles with her tomorrow at four PM

VIOLET

Randy lost his mind, didn't he?

GABE

A little. Busted out a stick and started doing "The Announcer".

VIOLET

Classic Randy. And she still wanted to play doubles with you?

GABE

Yes! Tomorrow, and I said I'd be there, so I need you to cover my shift.

VIOLET

No way. Fridays are always busy for Happy Hour, and you want to leave me here with just Dad and Abuelita?

GABE

Please Please Please Please! I'll get here as quick as I can after, and I'll do anything you want on Sunday morning.

VIOLET

Fine, but don't tell Dad or he'll get pre-mad about it. And on Sunday, you take me out for a round, just me and you. No Randy, no Announcer, and then after you have to buy me ice cream.

GILBERTO

(From the other room)

What are you two scheming out there?

VIOLET

Nothing Papa.

(scoops up some plates and spins away).

GABE

Thanks Vi!

ABUELITA

I heard that, young man. It's not nice to leave your sister on her own on a Friday. Also, your papa is going to be so mad at you!

GABE

Lo siento, Abuelita, please don't tell Dad. This is a really cool opportunity for me!

ABUELITA

No soy una rata!
(Raises an eyebrow but smiles at her grandson)

ACT 1, SCENE 5: Enter Big Bob

EXT STARKE PARK OR NORTHTOWN - DAY

Katy, Big Bob and Eric Stein (Real life Pro Player?) are waiting at hole one on the course from before as Gabriel arrives riding his Moped - (the one he uses for deliveries). Katy walks out to meet Gabriel away from the others

KATY

Big Bob is a huge sponsor of the company I work for, Bat City Discs. He's not the nicest person you'll meet, but he does a lot for the sport and the disc golf community. He's also a really good player.

GABE

So, disc golf is like... Your job?

KATY

Yes, it's an up-and-coming sport still, but if you have the talent - Like you definitely have - there's a lot you can do. Now let's not keep them waiting.

Gabe opens the hatch and retrieves his Grocery bag full of discs.

BIG BOB

What is this Amateur hour? Who is this kid that you've brought to our match Katy?

KATY

This is Gabe. Gabe this is Big Bob Becker, CEO and owner of Big Bob's Burritos and this is Eric Stein who also is sponsored by Bat City Discs.

ERIC

Nice to meet you
(Shakes Gabe's Hand)

BIG BOB

What do you have here boy, a Grocery bag full of old beat-up discs?

GABE

(Embarrassed)
These are mostly discs that no one claimed from our lost and found here.

KATY

Is that your only disc bag kid?

Gabe nods

KATY (CONT'D)

Do you have a good driver like this one in there.

GABE

(pulling out the old beat-up disc - from the beginning)
I have my trusty Old Greenie driver here.

BIG BOB

(to Katy)
What are we doing charity work today? I wasn't told about this.

KATY

I know how this looks, and that his disc selection has a bit to be desired, but I've seen him throw and he's good. In fact, I bet he and I could give you and Eric a run for your money in a doubles match.

BIG BOB

(Scoffs)

You think you, a woman, and this Hand-Me-Down-Dandy here can beat me and Eric Fucking Stein in a round of doubles?

KATY

(Annoyed by Bob's Blind Sexism and arrogance))

Yes... Yes, I do.

There is an awkward silence with Katy Matching Bob's Stare that is broken by Randy's Voice as Randy seems to appear from out of the nearby brush.

RANDY

Welcome to Rolftown Disc Golf Course. I'm Randy, the head of maintenance around here, and it's a great honor to have so many talented players out on my course today.

Randy walks over to Gabe and (after a brief struggle) takes the grocery bag from him.

RANDY (CONT'D)

I'll be caddying for Gabriel today.

(Turns to Eric Stein)

Oh man, it's so cool to meet you Mr. Stein. Sorry about that rough finish in Vegas, but I think you'll make up for it by taking the Cap City Open Next month!

ERIC

Uh... Thanks

BIG BOB

Okay let's get this round started. Best Disc Doubles with Me and Eric vs Katy and the kid here. Fifty dollars per hole...

(Dramatic Pause)

And we're playing from the long tees!

GABE

(Eyes Wide)

I don't have that kind of Money!

RANDY

Don't worry buddy, just play the best you can, and I got you covered.

KATY

Just get me close to the pin, and we'll end up winning anyway.

They start the match. Big Bob and Eric each throw. Big Bob can throw pretty far but Eric throws past him by about 15 or 20 feet.

RANDY

Here you go buddy,

Randy hands Gabe the green disc from the beginning

RANDY (CONT'D)

don't be nervous, just play the game that you know you're awesome at!

Gabe steps up and throws his old disc and it lands about 10 feet past Eric's.

ERIC

Nice throw kid

KATY

I think we'll just take that one.

Montage of throws and putts showing that Gabe can throw just as far as Bob and Eric, and that Katy is on top of the putting game.

At one point Eric Aces a short hole (Hole in one) and everyone celebrates.

KATY (CONT'D)

(Joking with Bob)

Looks like you guys do best when you don't get a chance to throw there Bob!

More montage of throws and putts from all four players. Shot of Randy with a stick starting to perform his announcer character and then Gabe pushing the stick "mic" to stop him.

GABE

We talked about this Randy.

The group is now walking up to hole 18. Big Bob is fuming and Katy and Gabe are all smiles.

RANDY

(Whispering into his
"mic")

Well folks we've made it to hole
eighteen, and boy are Gabe and Katy
bringing the thunder. They've won
thirteen of the seventeen holes
played so far, which puts them at
four hundred and fifty dollars in
winnings! Can they make it an even
\$500?

BIG BOB

What the hell is wrong with you?

GABE

He does that... Sorry.

ERIC

I don't know, I kind of like it.
He's got this Country Jim Nance
kind of vibe.

RANDY

(nodding at Eric, then
doing his best Jim Nance)
Hi friends, and welcome to the
eighteenth hole at Rolftown Disc
Golf course...

KATY

You guys are up.

GABE

(Looking at Randy)
So if we win this hole, it's five
hundred dollars?
(and to Katy)
And we can split that?

KATY

That's my count kid.

RANDY

Unless Big Bob wants to make this
one interesting...

BIG BOB

What are you talking about there
fella?

RANDY

We'd need everyone to agree, but what if we went double or nothing on the whole round for this last hole? So, an even thousand if Gabe and Katy win, and if y'all win the debt is cleared.

BIG BOB

Now why would you give up a guaranteed four hundred dollars this late in the game?

ERIC

(Shrugs)

I'm game if you are sir.

RANDY

I'd honestly recommend against taking that bet though. This is Gabe's home course and he and Katy have been taking it to y'all pretty hard so far.

BIG BOB

You have a deal. I'm going to enjoy not giving you money.

RANDY

(back into his stick Mic)

This one just got interesting folks! It's an eight hundred and thirty foot Par five with lots of tree cover, so it'll need long straight shots that go down the lane and don't get too high!

Big Bob lines up for his shot and it's a great one that glides easily half-way down to the basket.

BIG BOB

Oh Boy, Ol' Big Bob got all of that one. You think you can beat that?

ERIC

That was a great shot... I'm not sure that I'll be able to do better!

Eric's shot is also a good shot, but lands about 10 feet short Bob's.

Gabe steps up and launches a clean shot, but it carries a little to the right and hits a tree.

GABE
Oh no... Oops.

RANDY
And our home town maintenance team
hero cracks under the pressure. Can
Katy bail him out?

KATY
(placing her hand on
Randy's shoulder)
Not a good time, Randy.

Katy has a clean throw but her distance is about 80 feet short of where the other shots have landed.

KATY (CONT'D)
Next shot has to be you. Get me as
close as you can, okay.

GABE
I've got this!

Gabe takes the disc that Katy gave him the day before and launches his next shot, which is just under 500 feet to the basket. The disc goes right over the top of the basket (causing Randy to throw his arms up in victory as he thought it would go in)

RANDY
Albatross!!! Oh...

The disc glides about 65 feet past the basket and lands in some grass.

ERIC
That distance is incredible Gabe.

Big Bob and Eric take their throws and their shots both end up short of the basket but much closer than Gabe's, around 40 feet.

BIG BOB
Cat got your tongue there Randy? No
words of wisdom for your weird
stick there?

Randy puts the stick down, suddenly self-conscious of his announcing (and for perhaps the first time ever).

KATY

I'll keep us in this one.

Katy picks up the disc, spins it in her hand one time and fires it into the basket.

KATY (CONT'D)

This one is yours to lose now,
fellas.

Big Bob takes his shot and it hits the basket below the rim and falls to the ground.

BIG BOB

Dammit! Eric, I need you to drain
this one!

ERIC

Yes Sir!

Eric Shoots and the shot glides through the air and hits the chains of the basket, rolls around the rim and then pops out to fall on the ground.

RANDY

And there you have it! Katy Brooks
with the big putt, and the victory,
in a real nail-biter this evening!

GABE

Mr. Becker, Mr. Stein. Thank you so
much for the round today. This has
been a ton of fun and would have
been no matter the outcome.

BIG BOB

A deal is a deal...

Big Bob pulls out his wallet and starts counting out \$100 bills.

RANDY

You had over a thousand dollars
just on you for this whole round?

BIG BOB

Yeah, you can't make the bets if
you can't pay out son! Are you
saying you didn't?

RANDY

I'd have had to go to the ATM or
send you like a Venmo.

BIG BOB

Eric, we need to get going, and it looks like both of us need to work on our putting!

(Turns and pats Gabe on the shoulder)

BIG BOB (CONT'D)

You've got a hell of an arm there, newbie. I'll see you again.

RANDY

Bye Bob! By Eric! It was so cool to meet you!

KATY

Here's your half of the winnings Gabe. It sure felt good to beat that guy.

GABE

Holy Crap, I've pulled a lot of bets out here, but this one got too big for my blood very quickly! I never thought I could make money like this from Disc Golf!

RANDY

Bro as much as we play and as much as I talk about disc golf, how can you still not know more about it? The Cap City Open Tournament taking place next month has a Grand prize pot of FIFTY THOUSAND dollars, and Eric Stein, the guy you just sent home sad, will probably win it.

GABE

(Fans out the money)

I can't wait to show my papa how much I won today. He'll forget about my missed shift for sure!

Big Bob's truck pulls off and we zoom into see him and Eric talking

ERIC

Dang that kid can throw.

BIG BOB

Imagine if he had more than one new disk in that grocery bag of his.

ERIC

Right.

BIG BOB

I'm not sure about the other guy.

ERIC

I don't know man, I like Randy. You think he'd be my caddy for the tournament?

BIG BOB

Are you messing with me Eric? That guy is weird.

ACT 2, SCENE 1: THE FIRE

EXT REYES TORTILLAS Y'MAS (BURNED) - NIGHT

Gabe arrives home on his moped to see a fire truck in the parking lot of his home. The restaurant has clearly endured a fire. Next to the fire truck is a young woman sitting on the hood of her car in obvious distress. This is Juliet Villarreal Gabriel's love interest.

GABE

Juliet! Are you okay? What the hell happened?

JULIET

There was a grease fire in the kitchen. Nobody realized that it was happening until it was already out of control.

GABE

And Dad? And Vi? And Abuelita?

JULIET

It's okay. They're safe. Abuelita is getting checked out for some smoke inhalation. Vi and your dad had stepped out of the kitchen so they're fine physically.

She leans in and hugs him.

JULIET (CONT'D)

I was worried about you because your dad didn't know where you were. Be warned. He is super pissed.

Gabe hugs Juliet back and starts to walk away. She holds his hand until he's almost out of reach. Gabe stops, looks back and kisses her hand.

GABE
I'll go talk to him

As Gabe walks over to the scene, he finds Violet sitting with Abuelita on the back of a fire truck. Abuelita has a blanket around her and is getting some oxygen. Gilberto is pacing and muttering curses in Spanish.

GABE (CONT'D)
Papa, what happened?

GILBERTO
(quiet and very cold and calm)
You abandoned your post is what happened Mijo.

GABE
I didn't think that-

GILBERTO
(now heated)
That is exactly correct! You didn't think. And you left us alone on a busy Friday night. You're lucky your Abuelita is still alive!

GABE
(Turning to Abuelita)
I'm so sorry Abuelita! I never would have thought this would happen!

ABUELITA
Fue aterrador mijo. It was so scary, like the fire had a mind of its own!

One of the firemen comes over to the group.

FIREMAN
Is your breathing feeling more natural ma'am?

ABUELITA
It is, thank you!
(then to Gabe)
These nice young men took wonderful care of me.

FIREMAN

Mr. Reyes, we have the fire out now and we're getting everything ventilated. Structurally the house is going to be okay, but the kitchen and the patio will likely be a complete loss.

Big Bob's large truck drives by the parking lot stuck in traffic and the camera switches to their point of view. Bob and Eric can see the fire trucks, the gutted kitchen, and the scorched ordering window, and patio. In front of all that is a Hispanic man berating a younger man.

BIG BOB

Rubber necker's on this fire been holding up traffic. There's not even anything in the road.

ERIC

Is that the kid that we just met?

BIG BOB

Oh... Sure is. And I'm betting that's his Daddy. Whoa boy, does he look pissed!

In the parking lot Gabe sees the truck and locks eyes with Big Bob.

BIG BOB (CONT'D)

R-I-P Reyes' Tortillas Y'Mas

ACT 2, SCENE 2 (Bob's Offer)

INT. REYES KITCHEN/DINING ROOM - DAY

Its morning now and Gabe and his family are in a small kitchen/dining room in the apartment above the restaurant. Abuelita sets a taco in front of each of the others and then joins them at the table

GABE

Papa I know you're still mad, but I wanted to give you this.

Gabe hands over the five \$100 bills he won the day before.

GABE (CONT'D)

I know it's not much, and it doesn't make up for not being there last night.

(MORE)

GABE (CONT'D)

But I won this yesterday in my round and it's all I have.

VIOLET

You won FIVE HUNDRED dollars playing disc golf yesterday!?!?

ABUELITA

How did you make so much money out there Mijo?

VIOLET

Yeah, that's sure more than you'd have made in tips!

GABE

I met with a pro player and we played doubles. Randy fronted Fifty dollars per -

GILBERTO

(cutting him off and taking the money)

Five hundred dollars is but a drop in the bucket. The insurance adjuster is coming later today, but there's got to be at least quardenta mil in damage down there. I hope we're covered too, because we don't have that in the bank!

Abuelita places a hand on Gilberto's arm giving him a look that silently pleads for him to go easy on the boy.

ABUELITA

It was an accident yerno

GILBERTO

An accident that could have killed you! We already lost Isabella to some stupid Gringo Virus... This family just can't handle more tragedy!

ABUELITA

(Sternly)

Para Gilberto... that wasn't his fault either.

GILBERTO

(softening his tone)

Mijo, I understand that you have a hobby that you enjoy, but you can't let a kid's game get in the way of your responsibilities.

GABE

But Dad, I'm telling you, it's not just a kid's -

There's a knock at the door.

GILBERTO

Get the door boy.

Gabe goes to the door, and when he answers, it's Big Bob.

GABE

What are you doing here?

BIG BOB

Hey Kid, we saw what happened on our way home last night and Eric pointed out that you were out front. I just wanted to offer my condolences and see if I could maybe speak with your father for a moment.

GABE

(narrowing his eyes)

Um... yeah, I guess.

(Then calling out towards the kitchen)

Hey Dad, this is one of the people I played disc golf with yesterday. He's here to see you though.

Gilberto comes to the door mumbling more curses in Spanish

GILBERTO

How can I help you sir?

BIG BOB

Hello Sir, I'm Bob Becker.

GILBERTO

Mucho Gusto Senior Becker.

BIG BOB

I met your son yesterday out at the course with his weird friend Randy

GILBERTO

Yes, his crazy gringo friend that keeps putting irresponsible and stupid ideas in his head. You're not here to do more of that are you?

BIG BOB

No sir, your son can really throw, but I'm not here to talk about games, I'm here to talk business. We saw the tragedy that hit this place on our way home last night and while I don't know your situation, I have an idea that could work out for both of us.

GILBERTO

I'm listening

BIG BOB

I'm the owner of Big Bob's Burritos and this here is would be a great spot for one of my restaurants.

GILBERTO

What are you saying exactly?

BIG BOB

I'd like to buy your property here. I'd renovate everything, and then rent this upper apartment out to you at a fair price, so you don't have to move. And once this place is a Big Bob's Burritos, You could possibly manage the franchise. You'd have to train at one of your current locations first of course.

GILBERTO

You can't be serious.

BIG BOB

I'm as serious as a heart attack right now. I know that you have some things to deal with here first, but if you'd like, you and your boy are welcome to start at Big Bob's Burritos any time.

GILBERTO

This is a lot to process Mister Becker.

(MORE)

GILBERTO (CONT'D)

We have insurance agents coming later today and I'd like to discuss this with my Family.

BIG BOB

I understand completely. Here's my card and if you want a number to have in mind for when you're thinking it over, Lotvalue.com had the value of this property listed at three hundred and fifty-four thousand dollars. That was before the fire though. I'm willing to offer three hundred even.

GILBERTO

Thank you for stopping by Mr. Becker. I'll hang on to this.

BIG BOB

Thank you for your time, Mr. Reyes. My sincerest apologies again for your loss.

As Bob leaves, the camera follows him down the stairs and shows just how damaged the restaurant and patio areas are. When he gets back to his big truck, Eric is sitting there looking at his phone.

ERIC

So, the kid beats you out of a thousand dollars, and the next day you offer to buy his house from his dad... Savage.

BIG BOB

It's just business. I've had my eye on that lot for a while now, and I'd have made the same offer regardless of who lived there. Though, I guess I admit that seeing his face just now did make me feel a little better about the thousand I lost yesterday.

ERIC

Savage.

BIG BOB

I don't pay you to judge my business decisions. I'm doing them a favor. No one else will buy that wreck of a restaurant now.

(MORE)

BIG BOB (CONT'D)

But enough of that, let's go get another practice round in. The qualifier for the Cap City open is a week from tomorrow and I'd like a shot at playing with the pros!

Back in the house the Reyes family is discussing the offer and things are starting to get heated.

GABE

Lotvalue.com is an old site that doesn't have prices updated. Everything shot up during the pandemic and I bet we could get twice that for the restaurant!

GILBERTO

It's a generous offer. It's enough for us to pay off our loan, help send your sister to college, and make it so that your abuelita doesn't have to work every day!

GABE

But at what cost? We just have to work for Big Bob's Burritos forever? That's not even real Mexican Food! Have you even ever eaten there?

VIOLET

I like Big Bob's Burritos.

ABUELITA

There the big giant ones with the commercial with the guy on the motorcycle, right?

(Singing)

"Big Bob's the freshest and the best Burritos in town!"

GABE

You guys are killing me!

GILBERTO

We have bills to pay son. And he's offered us an immediate solution to that problem. What do you suggest we do instead?

GABE

I don't know papa, I just don't know.

(MORE)

GABE (CONT'D)

I have my other job to go to though, and what I think doesn't matter because you're going to just do whatever you want anyway.

Gabriel leaves, slamming the door behind him. The rest of the family kind of looks at each other in silence then Abuelita breaks the tension.

ABUELITA

I like the part where Abuelita doesn't have to work every day anymore.

ACT 2, SCENE 3 (RANDY'S PLAN)

EXT TOOL SHED AREA - DAY

Gabe and Randy are back at the Tool shed, gassing up the mowers and loading up the branch Trimmers, weed eaters, and other various tools.

RANDY

So, the whole restaurant is just gone?

GABE

Not quite, but the fireman said it was likely a total loss.

RANDY

But Vi and Abuelita and your dad are okay at least?

GABE

Yeah. Dad blames me for the accident though.

RANDY

Woof. I'm so sorry, brother!

GABE

The worst part is, that ass-hat Big Bob, from yesterday shows up at my front door this morning, and offers to buy the property and give my dad and me jobs working at his restaurant.

RANDY

That's actually pretty nice of him, right?

GABE

No! I don't want to work at a Big Bob's freaking Burritos! It was bad enough when I was helping keep Mom's dream alive working at our restaurant, but I could justify that because it was MY family's restaurant.

RANDY

And Big Bob's is...

GABE

Not where I want to spend my days okay. Do you think I can pick up extra shifts here.

RANDY

Hell man, I'd love to have you here all day every day, but there's just not that much more work to be done on the course right now.

GABE

Well, let's just get to it then

RANDY

So... Uh, Gabe.

GABE

Yes Randy.

RANDY

I got really excited after we beat Eric Stein and Big Bob in that match yesterday...

GABE

We?

RANDY

Well, you and Katy, but I was there too.

GABE

Okay.

RANDY

So... I went ahead and signed you up for the Cap City qualifier tournament next weekend. It's at Bobcat Ridge, which is a bomber course that I know you can smoke.

GABE

Are you kidding me?

RANDY

The top three in that tournament will get qualified to play in the Cap City Open!

GABE

You can't just sign me up for stuff and live your disc golf dreams through me!

RANDY

Think about it Gabe. You can get top three easy. And then the Cap City Open. National coverage, a chance to meet and play on the same card as real pros... And a FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLAR grand prize!

Randy starts his mower and starts driving away knowing full well that Gabe wasn't finished protesting.

GABE

You're worse than my father! You know that?

RANDY

(yelling over his shoulder)

It's going to be Awesome!

GABE

Dammit Randy...

ACT 2, SCENE 4 (more bad news)

INT. GABE'S BEDROOM - DAY

Sunday morning and gabe is in bed. Gilberto is shaking him to wake him up.

GILBERTO

Get up Mijo. We have work today.

GABE

(Sleepily)

What work, why are you in my room at Seven AM on a Sunday?

GILBERTO

Well son, I have bad news, and then I have more bad news, and then I have some other news that is neither good nor bad. I'd have talked to you about this last night, but it looks like somebody stayed out drinking with his gringo friend.

GABE

Daaaaad! What is it?

GILBERTO

I'll start with the news that is neither good nor bad, but I think you'll think it is good. I'm not going to sell the restaurant. Not yet anyway.

GABE

That is good news. I don't think Mom would have wanted you to sell it, especially to stupid Big Bob.

GILBERTO

I agree Mijo. Are you ready for the bad news now?

Gabe sits up in bed

GABE

No... But tell me anyway.

GILBERTO

The insurance people came yesterday. There is about sixty thousand dollars worth of damage to the kitchen and the patio, but they won't cover it because they say that the stove and the cover of the patio were "out of code"

GABE

Seriously?

GILBERTO

Yes Seriously Mijo. I did not take this news well, and we also may have to look for a new insurance company after I chased the adjuster for that one off of our property.

GABE

Is that the other bad news?

GILBERTO

No Mijo, that is just more of the first thing of bad news.

GABE

Okay hit me with the other thing.

GILBERTO

I got us and your sister jobs at Big Bob's and we all start today.

Gilberto sets a uniform and a Big Bob's hat at the foot of Gabe's bed

GABE

Are you freaking kidding me?

GILBERTO

Why would I joke about a thing like this? This family has overcome worse things than a stupid fire. We need to work together though, and Bob has given us an opportunity that we can use to save our restaurant. Don't turn your nose up at this Mijo!

GABE

So Papa, there is a disc golf tournament coming up. The Cap City Open. This tournament has a fifty thousand dollar prize for the winner.

GILBERTO

Gabriel...

GABE

Randy signed me up for the qualifier next weekend and the top three in that tournament will get an invite to the Cap City Open!

GILBERTO

Gabriel. Mijo... it's time to let go of esos cocitas. I know that you have fun with Randy, but this is serious. We could lose the restaurant and the family needs you... I need you... to put in real work right now.

GABE

I hear you, Papa. Let me see that stupid Big Bob's Shirt.

GILBERTO

That's my boy. I'm sorry it came to this.

(Hugging Gabe's head)

Thank you Mijo. I Looove you sooo much!

GABE

Dad, No! Get out of here!

ACT 2, SCENE 5 (Training at Big bob's)

INT. BIG BOB'S BURRITOS KITCHEN/DINING AREA - DAY

Gilberto, Gabe and Violet are at big bobs with Their Trainer Joshua who is a nice guy, but takes the job a little too seriously.

JOSHUA

Hello Reyes...es. Welcome to Big Bob's Burrito's North loop location.

GILBERTO

Nice to meet you Josh

JOSHUA

Please. It's Joshua.

GILBERTO

Nice to meet you Joshua

VIOLET

(Quietly to Gabe)
Nerd!

JOSHUA

What was that?

GABE

(Coughs uncomfortably)

GABE (CONT'D)

Sorry, just a tickle in my throat there. Please continue.

JOSHUA

Gabriel, we have you in the back. You'll be bringing in the delivery items, sorting everything and helping Aaron with the grill. I heard there was a fire at your old restaurant, and that's not something we'd tolerate here at Big Bob's.

GABE

It was clearly an accident, and I wasn't even there at the time. Why would you bring that up right n-

JOSHUA

(Cutting Gabe off)

During Rush at lunch and if there are any other flurries of customers, one or both of you will help out on the assembly line, which brings us to Violet

VIOLET

(Saluting)

Sir yes sir!

JOSHUA

Assembly is easy, you press the tortilla's here, you add the ingredients as requested - Be SURE to weigh your proteins here then Wrap the Burrito in tin foil here.

VIOLET

So you just mash the tortillas in that big masher there and load up the ingredients. I think I can handle it.

JOSHUA

It's called a Tortilla Press Ms. Reyes

VIOLET

But the Tortillas are already pre-made. I see the big bag of them there.

JOSHUA

It heats them up evenly and makes them more durable to hold the ingredients. Aaron and/or I will help you if you have questions.

Joshua stops at the registers and turns to Gilberto

JOSHUA (CONT'D)

Now for the most important job. Gilberto, you being the eldest, and I assume, the most responsible out of this new crew, will be working with me at the register cluster. Here is where you take the funds and make sure that the customer had an excellent Big Bob's Experience.

GILBERTO

Happy to help in any way that I can Josh... ua

JOSHUA

We open in an hour, and it's Sunday, so the church crowd will arrive hungry shortly thereafter. Let's get everything ready so we can get people their burritos ASAP. To your stations! Let's move people!

GILBERTO

We won't let you down Joshua. Thank you for this opportunity.

Back By the grill Aaron is getting it fired up and cutting the meat. Aaron is in his thirties and clearly hung over.

AARON

Alright brother. Sunday is a tough day to start, but stick with me and it'll be over before you know it.

He lays out some meat and begins cutting it in strips and then cubes

AARON (CONT'D)

Everything is already seasoned and ready, so all we really need to do is cut and cook.

(MORE)

AARON (CONT'D)

The chicken is actually way easier to mess up than the steak, but if you remember to hit everything with the thermometer before taking it out, we'll be fine.

GABE

Sounds good, I'll get to cutting now, if that's what you want.

AARON

Yeah man, I'll keep the grill going and as long as we keep the meat coming, freaking Josh won't come back here and bother us.

GABE

This is very different than how our restaurant worked. From the amounts of food we're preparing, it looks like it'll be much busier too!

AARON

Bro, so many people get they're burrito on. Especially on Sundays. The day'll go by super quick though. You'll see.

ACT 3, SCENE 1 (Dire Straights)

EXT TOOL SHED AREA - DAY

Gabe shows up at the tool shed on his Moped To Meet Randy for the Monday Morning Mow. He's gassing up the Mowers

RANDY

Happy Monday Morning there Pookie. Why do you look like... (gestures to all of Gabe) Like that?

GABE

I had my first day working at Big Bob's Burritos yesterday. Dad has both me and Vi pulling as many shifts as they'll let us over there right now.

RANDY

Oh man, that's got to be a whole different animal compared to the restaurant.

GABE

You have no idea.

RANDY

Really?

GABE

I know now why Big Bob is loaded. They have so many people come through there in a day. They literally call where you make the burritos "the assembly line".

RANDY

Woof. Well, if you want, I can handle mowing today brother.

GABE

Nah we need Sixty Kay to get the restaurant opened back up and I need all the hours I can get. I can still hit the mow with you on Monday and Thursday if we get them knocked out early.

RANDY

Alright little brother.

GABE

Also, the mower and being out on the course helps clear my head.

RANDY

You think you can get a round in after we mow?

GABE

No, I'm booked up from nine AM until seven PM at Bob's every day this week. I'm sorry buddy.

RANDY

So what about the tournament?

GABE

Bro, I got smoked in a three-hole match with a retired player. I don't have a shot at that, and right now I need to focus on bringing in money for the restaurant.

RANDY

Gabe. You know... The fire... It wasn't your fault, and if you were there, maybe you could have been injured or something. Sometimes things happen for a reason. I mean look at us. You where what, fourteen when we met? And now we're best friends! You ever think about how weird it is that a thirty-eight-year-old man would have someone just out of high school as his best friend?

GABE

Are you saying the restaurant burned down so I could have more time for disc golf? Come on man! And for the record, I may let it go, but a lot of people think it's weird that we're best friends!

RANDY

My point is that with my knowledge and your skill, I can help you become a pro player. Since our first round together when you caught up to me on hole three, (Points) Right over there, I believed that you could be the best there ever was. Now forget Bob's and let's get you ready for the qualifier.

GABE

Randy, I love you brother, I really do. But it's a childish dream and it's not going pay to fix my family's restaurant. I think I just need to step away from disc golf for a while.

RANDY

That's what I'm saying though. You win the Cap City Open and that saves restaurant!

GABE

Lets be real Randy. What are the odds? I looked at the sign up for the qualifier. Three invites out of a hundred and forty-four contestants just to get the into the Cap City Open.

(MORE)

GABE (CONT'D)

It's a pipe dream. Now I need to get to mowing if I'm going to get done before my shift at Bob's

Gabe drives off on the mower and, Randy hangs his head in the back ground -- Que music (Rent I Pay by Spoon)

ACT 3, SCENE 2 (WORK) EXT. REYES TORTILLAS Y'MAS (BURNED) - DAY AND NIGHT- SMASH CUT OF GABRIEL WORKING. ALARM GOING OFF, WALKING THROUGH THE BURNED REMAINS OF REYES TORTILLAS Y'MAS, CUTTING MEAT (AND VEGETABLES) GRILLING MEAT, WALKING BACK THROUGH THE BURNED REMAINS IN THE DARK - REPEAT TWICE WITH MUSIC PLAYING. THEN KATY SHOWS UP AT THE RESTAURANT MUSIC FADES

INT. BIG BOB'S BURRITOS KITCHEN/DINING AREA - DAY

KATY

Is Gabriel working today

JOSHUA

Yeah, Gabriel is in the back. Is there something I can help you with?

KATY

I just wanted to talk to him, and give him something.

JOSHUA

I guess he can take his break a little early. Let me get him.

Joshua leaves and Gabe comes out from the back

KATY

Hi Gabe, I just wanted to talk to you a little, if you have a second.

GABE

Hi Katy. Nice to see you. I can talk for a second, but it'll need to be quick. It's so busy here all the time.

KATY

I actually talked to Randy, and he told me that you were giving up on disc golf for a while?

GABE

After we played doubles, I came home to find my family's restaurant burned down. I had ducked out to go play when I should have been working, and I could have prevented it if I had just stayed and done my job like I was supposed to. It was my fault and Big Bob was generous enough to offer me and my family jobs here - See that's my sister Vi, and my dad is over there.

KATY

Randy told me about the restaurant and that you were working here. I'm so sorry that happened Gabriel.

GABE

This whole situation is my fault, and look at them over there.

Gabe points to his father and sister, who are both busy with customers

GABE (CONT'D)

How can I think about disc golf when my own family is working so hard to pay for my mistake?

KATY

I understand. I just wanted to talk to you myself. Randy believes in you, and really, I do too. With just a few adjustments to your game and your putting, you could have a legitimate shot at a career in playing disc golf.

JOSHUA

(coming up to put a hand on Gabe's shoulder)
Break's over Gabriel.

GABE

Sorry Josh, I'll get back to the grill in just a second.

JOSHUA

That's "Joshua", and make it quick.

KATY

Okay we can wrap it up. I also wanted to give you this:

Katy pulls a disc out of her bag - It's a brand-new version of the one they played for previously

KATY (CONT'D)

I thought you deserved a brand new one after that awesome doubles round the other day. My number is on it this time... Call me if you ever need someone to help you tighten up your game.

Gabe takes the disc and turns it over a couple of times in his hands

GABE

I really appreciate this, Katy. But I also really have to get back to work.

Music fades back in and we go Back to the smash cut of Gabe cutting meat, hauling produce, grilling the meat, loading burritos, walking through the burned remains of the patio of Reyes' Tortillas Y'Mas, alarm, wake up walk back through the burned remains, Cut, haul, grill, walk home, alarm, walk to, cut, haul, grill walk home. repeat three to five more times.

ACT 3, SCENE 3 (Juliet)

INT. BIG BOB'S BURRITOS KITCHEN/DINING AREA- NIGHT

Gabe is cleaning up and Closing the store. The Reyes family are the only ones there.

GILBERTO

Okay you two, lets get this all cleaned up and get out of here for the night. I'm proud of you both for the good week of hard work you put in here.

VIOLET

Uh Oh, it looks like Gabe has a visitor!

GABE

Is that Juliet?!?

VIOLET

You know it is.

GILBERTO

Go see her Mijo. We can finish up here.

Gabe runs out of the restaurant to find Juliet leaning against her car waiting for him. They embrace.

GABE

Juliet! I missed you so much this week. It feels like it's been forever!

JULIET

Yeah, I know a lot has gone down since I saw you last. I'm sorry I wasn't here for you more, but I had to get back to my classes.

GABE

I know, and you can't work because the restaurant is closed. We could probably get you on here if you wanted.

JULIET

Are you kidding? You know the only reason I ever worked at Reyes' Tortillas Y'Mas was because it was an excuse to see you.

GABE

I don't deserve someone as amazing as you, you know that?

JULIET

No, you don't. But here we are. Get in the car.

Gabe gets in the car and they start driving.

JULIET (CONT'D)

So, I was planning a special date for us tonight. But if you want to just hang out, that's cool too.

GABE

It has been a rough week for sure, so maybe less going and more hanging is better.

JULIET

What's on your mind Mi' Amor?

GABE

Do you remember when we were in school and I had actual plans and dreams?

JULIET

Had? You don't have plans or dreams anymore?

GABE

I had been accepted to Texas State. I was going to be the first Reyes in my family to go to college. That will probably have to be Vi now.

JULIET

I thought you were going to take over the restaurant and maybe make franchises out of it.

GABE

That was my back-up plan before Mom passed. Originally, I wanted to be a teacher you know. But after she died, Dad needed help running the restaurant and looking after Vi and Abuelita. I figured that I could still teach people, just teach them how to run the restaurant instead of like... in the classroom.

JULIET

You know you're not *stuck* with anything. I have an uncle who started a construction business, and then decided he wanted to be a veterinarian in his forties. Also, there are adults in most of my classes, you know.

GABE

I know that you're right. I'm just feeling a little trapped right now. We don't have to talk about my problems all night though. Where are we going?

JULIET

Where we're going is a surprise. Get your head up Gabriel Reyes. You're a good man with a good heart. I know you've had a terrible week. But this week isn't your whole life. I think that you should do what makes you happy.

GABE

I guess I just need to figure out what that is then, right?

Juliet turns off of the road and into a parking lot (Starke Park)

JULIET

Well, I always thought you seemed the happiest when you were playing disc golf.

GABE

You too? Now you sound like Randy. I thought we were pulling over to make out, but you've ruined it because now I'm thinking about Randy.

JULIET

Well, it's about to get more ruined because he's right out there!

Randy is out in front of the car doing a goofy dance around a lantern and showing off some Glow Discs.

GABE

This is the surprise date?

JULIET

I also invited Violet, and she should be here in a few minutes. We can still leave if you want though...

GABE

No, No, I love it!

JULIET

I knew you haven't been able to play all week, and the sleeveless wonder out there has a UV light, Glow discs for all of us, and he said that he'll be the one that runs ahead and sets the lantern on the baskets.

GABE

You. Are. Amazing.

JULIET

I know you feel responsible for the restaurant, but that was an accident. Everyone in your family cares about you, and wants you to be happy. Even your dad.

Juliet leans in and kisses Gabe deeply

GABE

(Joking)

It's so hot when you kiss me after talking about my Dad.

JULIET

(laughing)

Stop that. Now let's get outside before Randy hurts himself.

ACT 3, SCENE 5 (the night round)

EXT. STARKE PARK - NIGHT

Outside of the car at the Entrance to the course, Randy has a lantern and a bag filled with Glow-Discs. He's standing in front of the parking lot waiving them around like he's a marshaller directing an airplane

RANDY

Over here, we have glow discs, we have two bomb ass lanterns, and we have snacks!

Gabe and Juliet approach and in the back ground, you can see Violet arrive in the Reyes family vehicle.

JULIET

I told him that he could come along, but he had to bring all the discs and some snacks for all of us. I think he's been missing hanging out with you too.

GABE

I was kind of mean to him the other day.

RANDY

(holding a stick like a mic)

Ladies and Gentlemen! Welcome to the Saturday Night Glow Disc Special. Tonight, we'll be enjoying the talents of the Reyes siblings, Violet and Gabe, the lovely Juliet Villarreal, and me, your favorite player slash announcer, Randy!

VIOLET

Hey I know it's your date night and all, but you owe me a round mister! And if Randy is here, I know that nothing too romantic is going down!

GABE

Vi! Did you help set this up?

VIOLET

You know I did. The Burrito restaurant has been brutal this week, and I thought we could both use a break. I'd have invited Dad too if he wasn't so... Dad.

GABE

I thought the deal was that we had to play a round with no Randy though - Sorry bro.

RANDY

Whaaaaaat?

VIOLET

You and your announcing make me nervous sometimes. BUT, I've never played a night round before and I thought maybe the announcer could help teach me...

RANDY

(covering the stick like it's a hot mic)

I don't have to narrate if you don't want me to.

VIOLET

(patting Randy on the shoulder)

It's okay big guy. You can do "The Announcer" tonight.

JULIET

(checking out the pack with the remaining discs and the snacks)
Yeah Randy, that was the deal. You did all the real leg work getting us set up, and you brought snacks.

GABE

Y'all are crazy. "The announcer" is great!

RANDY
 (Covering the "mic" still)
 Awww, thanks Buddy!

VIOLET
 Lead the way, Randy.

RANDY
 (Back into his "Mic")
 Well folks, we're all here and
 ready to play. I have three discs
 for each of us in the bag --
 Fairway Driver, Mid-Range and
 Putter. I also brought my handy UV
 light here and my lantern for the
 baskets.

Randy lays out everything and everyone pics up a few discs
 and holds them out for Randy to shine the UV light on.

GABE
 (removing a second small
 lantern from the bag)
 You even remembered a second
 lantern this time!

RANDY
 Remember folks, always bring a
 second lantern! Otherwise, everyone
 has to throw in total darkness. It
 also helps with seeing where you
 walk.

GABE
 My hero!

RANDY
 So how this works: First, be sure
 to hit your disc with the UV before
 you throw. This makes sure that you
 have full glow for when you go look
 for it. I'll be taking this lantern
 here and placing it on top of the
 baskets before we throw. Please
 watch your step as we don't want
 anyone falling and/or hurting
 themselves out here in the dark.

Randy continues speaking into his stick/mic and heads off
 towards the first basket

RANDY (CONT'D)

Off of the first tee box we'll have about three-hundred and forty feet to the basket, you'll be able to see it once I get the lantern out there. We have guardian trees on both the left and right, so a straight shot is encouraged, but there is room to hyzer on either side of the lane as long as you don't get the disc too high...

Randy's voice fades as he walks off into the distance

JULIET

Do you think he knows we can't hear him anymore?

VIOLET

I'm thinking he's still doing a full breakdown of the hole:

GABE

I'm not sure if he knows whether we can hear him anymore, but he's for sure still talking into that stick.

VIOLET

Your friends are weird.

JULIET

I think Randy's sweet! He is a bit of a strange one though.

GABE

Randy's got a big heart and he loves disc golf with all of it.

Que Music (Spoon - Wild) begin a montage of the group throwing discs and having fun, sinking putts and cheering for each other. At one point there are some reflective eyes in the brush off to the side of one of the baskets. Music Dies down.

GABE (CONT'D)

Is that a kitty? Hey there little guy.

JULIET

I don't know if I'd mess with anything out here right now Gabe, even if it is a cat.

RANDY

(into the mic)

And Gabriel approaches what he thinks is a small cat but is most likely a skunk, let's see what happens folks.

GABE

(Running away)

Skunk confirmed! It's a skunk!
Let's get out of here!

As Gabe runs away, the skunk sprays and the spray is reflected in the light with a myriad of colors.

VIOLET

Do you see that? The lights reflecting off of the spray?

RANDY

Now there's a sight you don't see every day. Just beautiful, but be thankful those of you watching at home can't smell it.

(Gags)

Whoa it's bad...

Music picks back up and the montage continues for another 30 seconds or so. Back in the parking lot Violet and Juliet are walking together while Randy and Gabe are messing with the lanterns and putting stuff in Randy's truck.

JULIET

Thanks for helping me get this all set up.

VIOLET

Hey, thanks for getting Randy to do all the actual work out here. Gabe has been taking the whole "you burned down our restaurant" thing pretty hard.

JULIET

Do you think there is a future for y'all at Big Bob's?

VIOLET

I sure hope not. It's different than our restaurant. I miss taking orders and having time to chat with people. The assembly line is too fast paced for me.

JULIET

So... I was talking to my little brother Pacito - You know how he worships Gabe right?

VIOLET

Yeah, the big brother he never had!

JULIET

Well, he had a crazy idea, and after tonight, I think maybe it's actually brilliant.

Act 4, Scene 1 (The Heist)

EXT BIG BOB'S BURRITOS BACK ALLEY - DAY

At the back doors of Big Bob's Burritos gabe is unloading a truck with flats of produce - Queue Music "I turn my camera on" by Spoon. Gabe is struggling with the back door and Violet opens it and takes the cart of tomatoes he's carrying.

VIOLET

Hey Brother! I'll take these. Looks like you have visitors.

GABE

Who would show up this early to see me here?

Gabe turns to see Juliet's car with her, Randy and Pacito (Juliet's 12-year-old brother) who is wearing a Big Bob's staff shirt and hat (both of which are much too big).

GABE (CONT'D)

Morning y'all! Hey are those my clothes?

PACITO

Orale' Gabriel! I've come to fill in for you while you win the Cap City Qualifier today!

GABE

Are you kidding?

JULIET

He is not kidding. We were talking about the qualifier and he said that "the future best disc golfer in the world can't be missing his shot no matter how good the burritos he's making are"

PACITO

That's true, I said that.

GABE

And what, I'm supposed to just leave? I'll get fired for sure.

VIOLET

(coming out from the
building again)

I'll show Pacito the ropes and keep Dad from finding out that you're not here.

GABE

This is crazy.

JULIET

The tournament starts in forty-five minutes. We all think that this is your shot. What do you want to do?

Gabe looks from Juliet to Randy then back to Violet and Pacito. Then puts on his sunglasses.

GABE

Let's do this!

Everyone cheers but Violet Shushes them

VIOLET

Keep it down nerds!

PACITO

I promise I won't let you down. Go win today, Gabriel!

RANDY

(holding up a new disc
bag)

As your official tournament caddy, I thought it'd be cool if I upgraded your disc bag.

GABE

Awesome. Thanks man, and thank you for covering Pacito. I owe you one.

RANDY

So, clock's ticking brother. Let's roll!

As the car drives away Gabe looks out the back window to see Pacito struggling with a crate of lettuce.

GABE

Is he really going to be able to do my job all day?

JULIET

The kid can work, don't worry about that.

RANDY

Probably more likely that your dad will notice that he's not you.

JULIET

Randy!

GABE

This all going to end horribly, isn't it?

Act 4, Scene 2 (The qualifier Round one)

EXT ROY G GUERRERO PARK - DAY

The trio arrive at the course with just minutes to spare before the tournament starts. Juliet drops the boys off near the parking lot, which is full.

JULIET

Got to love that Austin Traffic! You guys go, and I'll catch up with you after I've found a parking spot.

GABE

Thanks Love, Randy, do you know where we need to go?

RANDY

You know I do brother! This is a shotgun start and we're on hole eleven.

GABE

Hole eleven? Like on the far side of the course?

RANDY

That's the one. Don't worry, we have just over seven minutes. Lots of time!

GABE

We should still run though, right?

RANDY

As your official caddy, I'd first like to tell you that I'm honored to be here with you. You're my best friend, and I have complete faith that you'll make the top three, and get the invite to the Cap City Open... Even if you don't really get time to warm up.

GABE

This whole thing is crazy. Thank you for signing me up and pushing me to play.

RANDY

Aww man, I've always known that you were destined for disc golf greatness. Also, we should definitely be running right now!

Both men take off running and Randy bends down to scoop up a nice "microphone" stick. They arrive at Tee box for hole Eleven to find three other players there warming up and stretching: Gary, Matt and Brett.

GARY

Hey there, you must be Gabriel.

RANDY

Actually, I'm Randy, Gabe's Caddy. Sorry we're running late!

GABE

Sup Fellas?

MATT

Dig this guy. Brand new PDGA number and he's already got a caddy. My name's Matt. The esteemed gentleman here is Gary, and the one with the ear buddies over there is Brett.

GARY

We thought that we were going to be running with a short card for a second there.

MATT

did you get a chance to warm up yet?

GABE

Not yet. It's been a crazy morning.

RANDY

You can throw and putt up until two minutes before the round starts, which is... (Looks at his phone) Now.

Air horn sounds in the back ground

GABE

Whelp, I'm last on the box, right? I guess I better stretch at least.

Gabe starts stretching, triangle pose on each side and then moving his arms in circles.

RANDY

Y'all cool if I keep one of the score cards? I have the site up.

GARY

That'd be awesome. I don't want to be tempted to check the scores.

BRETT

(pulling an earbud out of one ear)

Howdy, I'm Brett. Y'all ready to get started?

The players all bump knuckles.

BRETT (CONT'D)

Let's do this, have a good round guys!

MATT

Good round y'all.

GARY

Three spots fellas! Good luck!

GABE

Thanks, and same.

The other three players throw and we see each of their discs fly out varying distances with all of them short of the basket. As Gabe steps up to the tee, Randy breaks the fourth wall setting the disc bag down and using his stick as a microphone.

RANDY

Well folks, what we have here is a five hundred and forty foot par four with a wide open start and a light curve to the left, perfect for a right-handed bomber like Reyes.

GABE

What do you think Randy?

RANDY

(Handing Gabe a disc from the bag, but never taking his eyes off of the camera)

For a long shot like this, Gabriel is going to need a high-speed driver with just a bit of fade so that he can set himself up for a possible Birdie or, hopefully he can get close enough to take a shot at an Eagle.

BRETT

(pulling an earbud out of his ear)

Are you talking to me?

RANDY

(covering the "Mic")

Sir, I'm talking to everyone, now please keep it down while Mr. Reyes lines up his drive.

Randy turns his attention to Gabriel and Brett leans in to look in the direction that Randy was. He doesn't see anything and shrugs, shaking his head in confusion.

Gabe blasts a long shot that glides all the way down the fairway curving left at the end to sit right next to the basket.

RANDY (CONT'D)

And Reyes with his monster arm put a huge drive right down there next to the basket. Who needs warm-ups?

MATT

Well now I understand now why the new guy has a caddy. Hell of a drive son!

GABE

Thank you sir, hopefully I can keep that going.

MATT

So, your buddy Randy over there, what's his deal with the stick?

GABE

Oh, he likes to announce during the rounds. Let me know if you want me to tell him to stop.

MATT

Eh, I actually appreciate the hole breakdown, and as long as he's only "announcing" for you, I don't have any issues with it.

GARY

You drop that one in, and you'll have the box after this. Great throw kid!

GABE

Thanks man!

The music picks back up ("Turn My Camera On" by Spoon) and there is a montage of throws and the discs hitting the baskets with the guys congratulating each other, and giving high fives and fist bumps. The music fades and we go to Randy again breaking the fourth wall with Gabriel lining up a putt behind him.

RANDY

And behind me now, we have Gabriel Reyes, currently leading the tournament by four strokes and looking to make it five with a long putt here on hole nine...

Gabe putts and misses badly sending the disc way past the basket and setting up another long putt.

RANDY (CONT'D)

And I forgot that Mr. Reyes is not the strongest putter.

(MORE)

RANDY (CONT'D)
 He'll probably need to lay this
 next one up to take a bogey in
 order hang on to his three-stroke
 lead.

ACT 4, SCENE 3 (THE QUALIFIER Break)

EXT ROY G GUERRERO PARK (PICNIC AREA)- DAY

Gabe and Randy are now sitting around a picnic table with the
 guys from the card and Juliet. They're all eating sandwiches
 and going over the first round.

MATT
 We started from the bottom now
 we're here! Can y'all believe that
 our humble starting card is sending
 two players to the lead card?

BRETT
 (playfully punching Randy
 in the arm)
 That was the best round of my life,
 I give all the credit to this
 weirdo. I wish I would have taken
 out the ear buds earlier and caught
 more of his hole breakdowns.

GARY
 (leaning into Gabe)
 Or it could have been the golden
 boy here showing you all the
 throwing lanes.

BRETT
 That helped too!

GABE
 I can't believe I'm in the lead
 right now. That whole round was
 surreal.

RANDY
 And with just one bogey! I'm not
 sure why you didn't just lay that
 one up...

GABE
 Yeah, my caddy encouraged me to run
 the birdie putt. Maybe you should
 talk to that guy.

RANDY

Er... Um. Let's all give a big thank you to the lovely Ms. Juliet Villarreal for bringing us sandwiches and keeping us nourished during this break.

JULIET

You're very welcome, but don't get used to it! I couldn't find a parking spot, and then I didn't want to wander the course looking for you, so I thought it would be nice to bring a bunch of sandwiches for lunch... Also, don't change the subject!

ALL

Thanks Juliet!

MATT

I don't know, I think I would have run that putt too, if I had the chance for a birdie on nine.

GARY AND BRETT

Oooooohhhhhh!

MATT

That's not what I meant!

GABE

No, no, that checks out. My short game still needs work.

JULIET

(Looking at her phone)
Holy shit Baby, did you see who's in second place and on your card next round?

GABE

I did...

BRETT

Robert, "Big Bob" Becker. I'm excited to play with him. Big Bob's Burritos are great.

GABE

Yeah, we have a weird history. Katy Brooks and I beat him and Eric Stein in a doubles match, then he tried to buy my family's restaurant, which is also our house.

MATT

That for sure qualifies as a weird history.

BRETT

Wait you and a retired female player beat Big Bob and ERIC STEIN? That's really impressive.

RANDY

Right? I've been telling him that!

GARY

That's super cool, I would love to meet Eric Stein, and I actually have one of Katy Brooks' signature series discs bagged.

GABE

It was a pretty cool round!

GARY

Wait, Gabriel Reyes... like Reyes Tortilla's Y'Mas, Reyes?

GABE

The one and only. My family has been running that restaurant for like forty years.

MATT

I knew I recognized you from somewhere. My dad swears that y'all have the best tacos in town - Breakfast or otherwise!

GARY

Y'all Austin folks are serious about your tacos too. I know where I'm going after this next round.

GABE

It burned down last week. We're having issues with the insurance and that's why Big Bob tried to buy it.

MATT

So, like you said, weird history.

GABE

Oh, there's more.

RANDY

A lot more.

GABE

Big Bob offered my family jobs at his Burrito restaurant. My dad, my sister and I have been working there since like right after our restaurant burned down.

JULIET

And this morning we basically kidnapped Gabe from his shift there and convinced him to play in this tournament, so that he can go after the prize money from the Cap City Open, and then use it to save his family's restaurant.

MATT

Oh Man...

BRETT

Okay. So, "weird history" is accurate for sure, but it might be a bit of an understatement.

GARY

Robert "Big Bob" Becker. How can that guy be the CEO of Big Bob's Burritos? He's younger than me, and I remember getting burritos from there in high school up in Dallas.

MATT

"Big Bob" is actually Robert Junior. His Dad, Robert Becker Senior started a bunch of restaurant chains back in the day. Big Bob's Burritos is just one of like ten.

(MORE)

MATT (CONT'D)

I don't know them all off the top of my head, but I know RB's Steak House is one of them.

RANDY

(Reading from his phone)

Wow, this list: RB's Steak House, Big Bobs Burritos, Colosseum Gyros, Beck's Crab Shack, BB's Burgers and Shakes, BB's Bakery, and Bayou Cajun Grub. He also owns a third of the Triple R Bourbon company.

MATT

Feels like he missed an opportunity there.

RANDY

Lil' Robert Junior was gifted Big Bob's Burritos on his twentieth Birthday. Robert Senior didn't use the title "Big Bob" so Robert Junior assumed it when he took over operations of the franchise!

GABE

Wait, seriously?

RANDY

Oh my God, he's not even the eldest son! His two older brothers, Ryan and Randall run the other six companies. Baby brother only gets to run one, so he can pursue his dreams of becoming a professional disc golfer.

JULIET

Wow

RANDY

How did I not look this up until now? Big Bob is just Little Brother Bob...

JULIET

Speaking of little brothers, I wonder how Pacito is doing right now.

GABE

Oh yeah, and right now Juliet's twelve-year-old brother is covering my shift at the restaurant.

INT. BIG BOB'S BURRITOS KITCHEN - DAY

Cut to the kitchen at Big Bob's Burritos and Pacito is crushing it.

VIOLET

We need more chicken up front.

PACITO

Chicken is cut cooked and thermomometered at an even one-seventy. It's in that container there.

VIOLET

Awesome, you know, you're really good at this kid.

PACITO

Good enough to go on a date with the lovely Violet Reyes?

VIOLET

Um, no - But I do need onions and tomatoes cut for the assembly line. Also, I wanted to tell you that Gabe is in the lead at the tournament right now.

PACITO

Hell yeah! I knew he'd kick ass out there!

Pacito pulls over a couple of onions and tomatoes and begins chopping them like an old pro.

AARON

(to Vi)

Dude, this kid is a freaking prodigy in the kitchen. I've never seen someone work the knives like he does!

PACITO

two minutes on the onions, four on the tomatoes. We got the steak on now. Let me know if you need anything else.

VIOLET

Pacito, if we pull this off today, I'll re-think that date buddy.

ACT 4, SCENE 4 (THE QUALIFIER Round Two)

EXT ROY G GUERRERO PARK - DAY

Juliet and Randy are with gabe and Brett at their starting Tee. Big Bob is walking up with his Caddy (the intern Curtis) in tow, and the fourth player following along is David Rodgers, who is wearing a droopy fishing Hat.

JULIET
Is that Big Bob?

RANDY
It is indeed.

JULIET
He's not very big for having a name like "Big Bob"

RANDY
I think I'm gonna call him Lil' Robert today.

GABE
Y'all knock it off. We here to play disc golf and not hassle the rich guy.

RANDY
You want to warm up this round, or you running cold again? Skipping warm-ups last round seemed to work out for us.

BRETT
Hello there, you must be Mr. Becker. Name's Brett. I'm a huge fan of your restaurants.

BIG BOB
Thanks, nice to meet you, Brett.

The two men shake hands.

BRETT
And who's that in the floppy hat over there? Mister Rodgers coming to the neighborhood! Sup Dave? I had to have the best round of my life just to tie with you in that last round.

BIG BOB

Howdy there Dave.

DAVE

Howdy Bob, great round this morning sir. Good to see you Brett, that was a nice round you put up this morning too.

BRETT

Thanks Man. I had the bonus of having this guy (gestures toward Gabe) showing me all the lanes, and his sleeveless caddy there gave great breakdowns of all the holes. This is Gabe Reyes and his Caddy, Randy.

BIG BOB

I'm acquainted with Mr. Reyes and his... Friend.

GABE

Hi Big Bob.

BIG BOB

I thought you'd be busy working today.

RANDY

He got his shift covered, so that he can come out and win the qualifier today.

DAVE

I heard at the break about the round leader and his big bomber throws. I'm excited to see you in action Gabe.

GABE

Thanks man, pleasure to meet you. My caddy Randy here, tells me that you're the only player in this tournament that's played in the Cap City Open before.

DAVE

Yeah man, I made the full pro circuit a few years ago, and I then I had a skiing accident and messed up my knee and my shoulder. Now I'm just working my way back up.

(MORE)

DAVE (CONT'D)

Hopefully I can secure one of the three spots today!

RANDY

I'm a huge fan Dave! I remember that roller you threw on hole sixteen at the Beast in Waco a couple of years ago. What was that, like five ninety-five to park it?

DAVE

Officially six eleven.

RANDY

Hell yeah!

GABE

Guys this is my girlfriend, Juliet. She'll be walking with us today, as well as helping keep my caddy in line.

BRETT

Aww Man, I was hoping for more hole break downs. He can still do that for us right?

RANDY

(Covering his stick as if it was a hot mic)

Well, this commentor would like to see her try to stop me.

Juliet punches him in the arm.

JULIET

You sure about that old man?

RANDY

Ow! Correction. This commentor would NOT like to see her try to stop me.

GABE

I'm sorry fellas, I promise this won't be too much of a distraction.

BIG BOB

Alright the air horn should be sounding any second now. Curtis!

CURTIS

Yes sir!

BIG BOB

Get me my orange number eleven.

Curtis retrieves the disc from an extra-large disc golf bag and the air horn for the two-minute warning sounds in the background.

CURTIS

Here you go sir. Good luck sir!

BIG BOB

Looks like you're up first Mister Reyes.

RANDY

(Breaking the fourth wall)
Hole one is a three hundred and thirty-three foot par three with a light curve to the left, and the basket backed up into some trees. Gabriel will need a fairway driver like this one here (pulls out a Mint Grackle or equivalent). For Gabe it'll be not quite a full send throw with a light hyzer and it should glide down there right where it needs to go.

BIG BOB

What, no grocery bag for this round?

RANDY

Our home town hero received a new bag - and some new discs from his best friend and hetero life-mate, Randy, earlier today. So far it has brought nothing but good luck. Let's see how he does on the first hole here.

Randy turns towards Gabe. Meanwhile Dave leans in to look at where Randy was talking. Brett walks up next to him and they both look in the camera.

DAVE

Who is he talking to?

BRETT

Nobody. But when I asked him earlier, he said "everybody..." So, I'm not entirely sure.

DAVE
Interesting...

BRETT
It took me a second to get used to,
but he ended up really helping me
out with that shit last round.

DAVE
Well, that was a pretty good
breakdown of the hole and a solid
disc recommendation... Does he do
Lefty breakdowns too?

In the back ground we see Gabe throw and hear chains rattle
and everyone cheers

RANDY
Ring it up baby!!

GABE
ACE!! Hell Yeah!!

BRETT
Run it down Reyes. Great shot!

JULIET
Yeah Baby! That's my boyfriend
y'all!

Camera zooms out and then follows Gabe as he runs down the
fairway to get his disc. Dave stays in the spot where Randy
was breaking the fourth wall and the camera zooms back to
him.

DAVE
That is certainly an awesome way to
kick off the second round of the
tournament here.

Randy steps up next to Dave and eyes him suspiciously

DAVE (CONT'D)
(Turning and yelling in
the direction of Gabe)
Nice work kid! That's the way to
start this out!!

RANDY
Did you see that, folks? Our
hometown hero ringing up an Ace on
the first hole of the round.
(MORE)

RANDY (CONT'D)

This should extend his lead by at least one more stro... what you missed it? Aww dammit! Well, it was freaking awesome! Let's see how the rest of the card responds.

Quick shots of the rest of the players throwing and their discs landing various distances from the basket, and then all of them putt for birdies.

RANDY (CONT'D)

Well, we can consider hole one conquered! We certainly have a talented pool of players on this card today. How will they do on hole two?

While the group is walking Randy gives his breakdown.

RANDY (CONT'D)

Hole two is three-hundred-and-forty-one foot par three. Now this one is slightly off to the right and down a fairly tight tunnel. We'll need something a little under-stable that will pull to the right, but not too far, and then fade just a little at the end. For me this would be my fastest under-stable driver. For Gabe, he'll need to use this here mid-range disc.

Randy hands Gabe a disc

GABE

Thank you sir, let's see what we can do!

This throw glides down the ally and drops right next to the basket. Gabe high fives Brett and Dave while Bob comes up with a half-hearted fist bump. Gabe then kisses Juliet.

RANDY

He never thanks me like that when I bring him good luck.

GABE

Aww come here big fella.

RANDY

Eww no, I was kidding!

Music picks back up ("Turn my Camera On" By Spoon) Quick shots of the rest of the people on the card throwing with various success. Brett and Dave land close, but Big Bob hits a tree and his disc bounces off into some brush. Follow this with a Montage of throws and the guys on the card celebrating with high fives and fist bumps with Big Bob's participation decreasing in enthusiasm. Music fades and Randy is now walking behind the rest of the crew and giving us an update.

RANDY (CONT'D)

(whispering)

We're headed to hole five and Gabe now has a SEVEN stroke lead on second place, which is now a three-way tie between Big Bob, Brett, and Dave.

BIG BOB

Will you shut up Randy? We don't all need you reminding us where we're at in the standings before each hole.

RANDY

Easy there, Lil' Robert. I'm happy to move further away from you, but I was whispering. And there are no rules against a caddie talking before the player he's with throws.

BIG BOB

What did you just call me?

RANDY

I said "Easy there Lil' Robert" and can you please keep it down? Gabe still has the box and he's about to throw.

Big Bob Huffs and walks over to Curtis.

BIG BOB

(Quietly)

Curtis, get me Josh, from the North Loop location, on the phone.

CURTIS

Right away sir.

Curtis finds a phone in the bag and quickly places a call.

Hello, yes this is Curtis.

(MORE)

CURTIS (CONT'D)

I have Big Bob with me and he wants to talk to Joshua... Yes, that Big Bob, and he's not going to want to wait.

Curtis hands the phone to Big Bob. Who walks further out of earshot from the rest of the players.

BIG BOB

Hi Josh, don't correct me. I need you to fire Gilberto, Violet, and Gabriel Reyes effective immediately... Yes, right now.... Well, I'm sure it's not Gabe doing a great job in the kitchen, because he's here with me right now... So, send him a text and kick whoever IS there, out... I don't know, call in one or two people from one of the other locations.

BRETT

Bob, you're up buddy!

BIG BOB

(on the phone)

Just get it done, I have to go!

(then to Brett)

On my way, sorry about that. Just taking care of some business right quick.

Big Bob steps up to the Tee-box on hole 5 and fires off a beautiful shot down the fairway and his disc lands right next to the basket - closer than anyone else's.

BIG BOB (CONT'D)

Oh shit, fellas! Looks like Big Bob is going to get off of the back of the box!

Bob and Dave end up getting birdies and Gabe and Brett both have to two-putt for Par. On the way to the next hole Gabe checks his phone and pulls Juliet and Randy off to the side.

GABE

So, my dad is blowing up my cell phone right now. I'm assuming that means the jig is up.

JULIET

I really thought we were in the clear.

(MORE)

JULIET (CONT'D)

Pacito's been there for like 6 hours by now, and he texted me earlier saying that he was so on top of it, that Joshua and your dad weren't bothering to check the kitchen. He also said that he was doing so well that Vi was going to have to take him on a date.

RANDY

Oh crap.

GABE

Well, Dad just texted me that I got everyone fired and he's on his way to "discuss." What do I do?

RANDY

This is my fault for calling Bob "Lil' Robert" earlier, isn't it?

JULIET

(taking Gabe's face in her hands)

Babe, we knew this might happen, and you still need to qualify. Just keep playing your game. You can do this. I love you.

Juliet kisses Gabe and turns and punches Randy in the arm again.

JULIET (CONT'D)

Randy. That was dumb, but it's not your fault that Bob is a douche bag. Keep our boy on the level. I'm going to go try to meet Violet and Mr. Reyes in the parking lot to run damage control.

RANDY

Okay Gabe. My man. We've still got a lot of disc-golf ahead of us. So focus, take this disc, and go throw it as far and as flat as you can, because this is an eight hundred and sixty foot par four.

Gabe takes the disc and steps up to the tee (Hole 5 at Roy G)

DAVE

Is everything okay?

GABE

My dad, my sister and I all just lost our jobs... I'm going to need just a second.

DAVE

Yuck, I'm sorry bro, that sucks.

BRETT

Wow. Is that what you were on the phone about earlier Bob?

RANDY

Yeah, dick move there Lil' Robert.

BRETT

I'm with Randy on that one. Not cool.

BIG BOB

I don't know what y'all are talking about. Can we just get back to playing disc golf?

Gabe throws and he grip-locks his disc a little and it hits a tree about 30 feet in front of the short tee. He looks at Big Bob and Randy and takes a deep breath.

The camera follows Juliet as she makes her way through the course, music kicks up ("The Hardest Cut" by Spoon) She's running backwards though the course to get back to the parking lot while trying to reach Violet on her phone. We'll need shots of her waving and apologizing to other players as she cuts through their fairways.

JULIET

Violet! I've heard the news, and I'm headed to the parking lot to meet y'all. On a scale of one to murder, how pissed is he? (Short pause) Okay... I guess that could be worse. I'll see you in a minute.

Juliet gets to the parking lot and paces for a moment before Gilberto, Violet, and Pacito arrive in the Reyes' family car. Gilberto double parks and gets out immediately, as soon as the car stops.

GILBERTO

Where is my irresponsible, uncaring, childish son?

JULIET

He's in the middle of his round,
and as you can see, there are a ton
of people here. You can't have the
conversation you're looking to have
with him right now.

GILBERTO

You can't tell me when I can or
cannot talk to my son!

VIOLET

Papa!

JULIET

I'm sorry Mr. Reyes. I know this
was a crazy and probably very
irresponsible idea, but it wasn't
Gabe's idea.

GILBERTO

You put my son up to this nonsense?

VIOLET

It was all of us Dad. And I think
we all got fired today because Gabe
has been kicking Big Bob's ass out
here. Somebody that would do that
kind of thing is a jerk that we
shouldn't be working for anyway.

JULIET

Mr. Reyes, I know you're angry with
Gabe right now, but last I checked
he was in first place, with a huge
lead, and he's got a real shot at
qualifying for the Cap City Open
today.

Gilberto looks around at all the people and the booths and
takes in the size of the tournament and the number of people
there for the first time and he calms down a bit.

GILBERTO

My little Gabriel is beating all of
these people at Frisbee golf?

PACITO

I knew it! Gabe can throw twice as
far as any of these chumps out
here!

GILBERTO

Is he really that good?

PACITO

Gabe is the freaking best man.
Don't you know that?

VIOLET

Dad, he's really good. And with some support from us he might have a real shot at doing something special. But we... You have to stop blaming him for the fire. It was an accident.

GILBERTO

So, we can walk along with him as he plays?

JULIET

I ran back through the course to get here. I'm not sure where he is now.

PACITO

Hold on fam, I'm getting the live scoring up now. Looks like he just finished on twelve and... Shit, he's had a rough couple of holes. I wonder what happened?

All three look at Pacito.

PACITO (CONT'D)

Oh yeah, the job thing. Dad coming in all scary... Got it.

JULIET

I'm going to see if I can catch up to him for the last few holes.

PACITO

I'm coming with you!

VIOLET

We'll find an actual parking spot and head around to the back side. Meet y'all on seventeen?

The group splits up with Juliet and Pacito rushing off through the main part of the course, and Violet and Gilberto getting back in their car. Gilberto looks around and takes in all the sights. He's amazed by how big Disc Golf actually is.

For the next shot, we go back to follow Randy who is walking with the card and quietly announcing what's going on.

RANDY

The vibe on the lead card has gone from fun-loving to awkward and terrible. Gabriel has lost his lead by way of three bogeys and one double bogey back on eleven. He's trying to hold it together, but he keeps looking around like his dad is going to jump out of the brush and slap him. He's now tied for third with Brett, who has put his headphones back on to try and maintain focus. Dave is quietly playing an excellent game and has moved into second place. And as for Lil' Robert Becker, it's like he's gaining power from everyone else's misery. He's taken over the lead with solid play and a big birdie on hole twelve.

GABE

I just got a text from Juliet. Says she talked to Dad and it's going to be okay.

RANDY

Yeah buddy, I know you have the weight of guilt on you, but there's nothing you can do to fix it now.

GABE

I'm melting down Randy. My form feels off, the discs feel weird in my hand. I don't know how to fix it.

RANDY

Gabriel. Look at me. Why do you play disc golf?

GABE

Usually because it's fun and I get to hang out with you.

RANDY

Exactly. Because it's a fun thing that you can do with your friends. Let's block out the drama and the bullshit, and let's just have some fun. Now hole thirteen is about three hundred and fifty feet straight down a tunnel.

(MORE)

RANDY (CONT'D)

Don't worry about the other players, just take this disk and throw it straight at that basket.

The other players have all thrown at this point and their discs are at various distances from the basket (all in putting range) Gabe takes a deep breath and throws the disc right down the ally to land next to the basket

RANDY (CONT'D)

There you go. Let's stop the bleeding and go get some birdies.

Everyone on the card birdies

RANDY (CONT'D)

Nice Star-Frame fellas! Except you Lil' Robert. You're the worst.

BIG BOB

Now don't be a sore loser there Randy. Great shot Gabe! You're going to need to do better to make up strokes on Big Bobby B. though!

The group makes their way to the next hole (hole 14). Gabe and Randy lag behind. Gabe is looking at his phone.

RANDY

Gabe, look at me, brother. Stop looking at your phone and stop worrying about your dad. Everything that he could be mad about is done. There's nothing you can do now to change that. The only thing you have control over right here and right now is this game. Block out the noise brother.

GABE

I just don't get it. Why would my family all get fired right now? And it's freaking me out how all of the sudden Bob's being all happy and joking around!

RANDY

Don't worry about Bob. He'll get his in due time. Right now, you have a six hundred and forty foot Par four down an ally with trees on either side.

(MORE)

RANDY (CONT'D)

You're the only one here with the arm to set yourself up for an eagle here. Take this disc and go do that.

Gabe still has the back of the box and everyone else threw while he and Randy were having their side bar. He steps up, takes a deep breath and rips one for over just over 600 feet. The disc skips up and lands just outside of circle one (31 or 32 feet from the basket)

RANDY (CONT'D)

that's my boy!

BRETT

(Taking his ear bud out)
What a freaking rip!

DAVE

Nice shot Gabe.

BIG BOB

That one never got more than four or five feet of the ground. Hell of a shot there Reyes!

As they're walking up Brett's shot was the shortest, while he's lining up his shot, Dave comes over Gabe and puts a hand on his shoulder.

DAVE

Hey man. I know that this round got a little weird earlier. I want you to know, that whatever happens, I'm in your corner. I wish I had half your talent at your age, and I went pro at Twenty-three.

GABE

Twenty-three isn't that far away for me.

DAVE

I know. That's my point. Granted there's more talent on the field now than when I started, but I'm telling you, you've got something special kid.

Brett's second shot was a solid lay-up and is about 15 feet from the basket Dave parks his right under the basket and Big Bob's shot hits some brush and lands just outside circle one and right next to Gabe's drive. Bob is out so he's the first to putt.

BIG BOB

Holy smokes that was a huge drive Gabe, it took me two shots to get to this one... But you know what they say: Distance is for show...

Bob smiles, winks at Gabe and confidently fires his putt into the basket.

BIG BOB (CONT'D)

But putts are for dough, son! Oh Yeah!

RANDY

I hate to say this, but do what he did. Take a deep breath, line it up and gain a stroke on everyone on the card.

GABE

Fine, I'm not doing the creepy wink though

Gabe lines up his shot, takes a deep breath and shoots. The disc hits chains but flops out of the basket. Gabe curses under his breath and then the rest of the players take their shots and make them. Gabe drops in his birdie shot from right next to the basket.

BIG BOB

that's the second star frame in a row. Nice work fellas!

As they head off to the next hole Gabe is kind of walking with his head down. Randy walks up next to Gabe and pushes his chin up.

RANDY

Get your head up brother, your second and third biggest fans just got here.

GABE

Second and third? Who's the first?

Randy gives a sarcastic imitation of the wink that Big Bob did moments ago.

GABE (CONT'D)

Awww Gross... But thanks.

PACITO
 (from a ways behind the
 group)
 Little Gabe!

GABE
 Orale' Pacito! I heard that you
 were rocking the kitchen for a
 while there this afternoon.

PACITO
 Yeah, I'm sorry we all got fired
 today. I was doing my best!

GABE
 It was out of your control buddy,
 thanks for giving up your Saturday
 so I could play the tournament.

PACITO
 I heard you were rocking this
 tournament earlier. I've come to
 bring you luck. Let's show these
 chumps how the Vatos Locos get
 down.

GABE
 My man. Give me three.

Gabe leans down and Pacito low fives him three times.

JULIET
 We didn't get to see that last one,
 but I heard Bob say "star frame,"
 so that means birdies, right?

GABE
 Yeah, I had a shot at an eagle that
 sure would have been nice to have
 made. Also I'd have loved to get
 off the back of the box...

JULIET
 Well I think we got your Dad cooled
 down. He and Vi should be in the
 crowd on seventeen.

PACITO
 There's been some chatter on the
 course...
 (coughs)
 (MORE)

PACITO (CONT'D)

And online, about the drama on your card and how probably all three qualifier spots will be determined on the last couple of holes.

RANDY

(back to speaking into his "Mic")

Which brings us to hole fifteen. Another super long six-hundred-and-seventy-foot par four. The alley is wider than the last hole, but the ceiling is lower. Take this disc and do what you did last time.

The other players on the card all throw, and their shots land around halfway down the fairway. Gabe steps up last and throws another laser of a shot down the alley to drop about 150 feet from the basket. When they go to take their next shots, Brett sends his down just short of circle one. Dave has an excellent approach that lands right under the basket, and Bob ends up getting in some branches and his second shot falls about 90 feet from the basket.

RANDY (CONT'D)

Take the lay up here. Something not too crazy with just a little height so it spikes and doesn't get too much ground action.

Randy hands Gabe a disc.

GABE

Got it, thanks.

Gabe lays up and puts the disc about 10 feet from the basket. Brett and Bob both take lay-ups for par and Dave and Gabe get Birdies.

GABE (CONT'D)

Looks like you did bring me some luck Pacito. Thanks, Buddy!

RANDY

(Breaking the fourth wall again)

This one is coming down to the wire folks! Three Holes left with Bob and Dave Rogers tied for first. Our round one leader, Gabe Reyes, is trailing by a single shot, and Brett is just two shots behind him!

GABE

What do you think for this one,
Mid-Range?

RANDY

Hole sixteen is a three-hundred-
and-fifty-foot par three with a
stiff curve to the left. Our pros
can get this distance with a mid-
range or even a putter, but I'm
recommending a smooth release with
a low-speed fairway driver for Mr.
Reyes.

Randy hands Gabe another disc. David throws and his disc drifts down fairly close to the basket. Gabe steps up and his shot curves down and hits chains but bounces out to lay just next to the basket. This draws some "oohs and ahhs" from the crowd gathering and then a collective groan when it bounces out.

GABE

Bah! So close!

Bob and Brett make their shots both within putting range of the basket and everyone makes their putts for another star frame with all of them getting Birdies.

BIG BOB

Another Star Frame! Well done,
Fellas!

Brett and Dave exchange looks of incredulity.

DAVE

Yeah, Well done everyone...

A crowd that includes Gilberto and Violet has gathered around the Tee for hole 17. Gilberto is hanging back a bit, but Violet pushes her way through to join Juliet, Pacito, Randy and Gabe, who are following the rest of the players on the card just a few yards back.

VIOLET

Hi Big Brother!

GABE

Hi Vi, I'm sorry we all got fired.

VIOLET

Don't worry about that, just know
that we support you and we would
love to see you kick that smug
bastard's ass!

GABE

Working on it! Where is Dad?

VIOLET

He's over there watching. I think he's having a little trouble processing everything that's going on.

RANDY

We have an opportunity here. Hole Seventeen is a four-hundred-foot par three with a ton of trees and narrow throwing lanes on the left and right. Just do the same throw as last time but with just a little more juice. Don't worry about the trees and trust the disc to hold the line.

Dave has the box so he steps up and throws. He's left-handed so he takes the left lane and has a clean shot, but it gets just a little high, hitting some tree branches, and the disc drops about 90 feet short of the basket.

Gabe steps up to take his throw and there is a pause as he looks down the lane and begins to block out the chatter of the crowd around him, but then a familiar voice cuts through everything.

GILBERTO

(to some other bystander)

That's my Mijo Gabriel about to throw there. Did you see the last hole? His disc was the closest.

Gabe smiles and looks over towards his dad, who makes eye contact but just nods. Gabe throws and it's an awesome shot that glides smoothly down the right lane and curves down to skip just short of the basket, skipping off of the ground to hit the pole drawing more "oohs and ahhs" from the crowd.

RANDY

That's all we can ask for. Little higher skip and that could have been an Ace!

DAVE

Damn son, that's parked two times in a row!

BIG BOB

I'm about to try and follow that line Gabe, thanks for showing me the way.

Bob throws and his disc follows almost the same path, but his throw doesn't fade back towards the basket as much and ends up just inside Circle two (about 55 feet) short and to the right of the basket

BIG BOB (CONT'D)

That'll Putt.

Brett throws and hits the same line, dropping his shot just inside of Bob's.

BRETT

That too, will putt.

The group moves up and putts, Dave runs his putt and chains out. Bob takes a long shot and hits the outside of the basket dropping the disc just short. Brett makes his putt for birdie. Gabe's is just a drop-in birdie. Bob and Dave take Pars.

BRETT (CONT'D)

Nice work Reyes, half a star frame and you got the box for eighteen!

DAVE

Whoa this one is getting tight. I know eighteen is tough one though, so this is still anybody's game right now.

The group travels to the last hole. The crowd following has gotten pretty big and there are people lining either side of the last fairway. Randy turns to break the fourth wall again, but now there are people in the direction he turns to talk. They are completely captivated.

RANDY

It all comes down to this one, folks. We're in a three-way tie with David, Bob, and Gabriel. Brett is hot on their heels by just one stroke. And this final hole will NOT be easy. Hole eighteen... What we have here is an eight-hundred-and-thirty foot par four. It is possible to Birdie with two great shots, but par on this is certainly respectable.

(MORE)

RANDY (CONT'D)

Really our players will just need to go out there and throw as far as they can from the Tee box. Let's see if our home town hero, Gabriel Reyes can take this disc and show us some of that Reyes Magic!

Gabe takes the disc from Randy, noticing the crowd he's talking too and shaking his head.

PACITO

You got this Gabe!

As Gabe walks past Pacito and Juliet he messes up Pacito's hair and takes Juliet's hand. He looks her in the eyes.

GABE

I do got this. I know it got weird for a minute there, but thank you for pushing me to play today.

Gabe steps up and launches a beautiful long shot that goes nearly 600 ft and lands in the middle of the fairway. This draws more ooooohs and aaaahhs from the crowd.

RANDY

(To Juliet)

He knows I'm the one that signed him up for this one and got his PDGA number, right?

JULIET

Stop it.

GABE

Randy, you're the best caddy anyone could ask for.

BRETT

How the hell am I supposed to follow that Gabe? That's two throws for me!

Brett throws a clean shot down the fairway that goes about 350-400 feet and lands in the middle

DAVE

Good clean shot Brett, that's exactly what I'm trying to do here, but the lefty version.

Dave throws and his disc glides just past where Brett's landed.

BIG BOB

Thanks for showing me the lanes boys, Ol' Big Bobby Bee is about to come from the back of the box to the top of the podium. Give me my green Phantom disc Curtis.

Curtis sorts through Bob's bag, and pulls out a green disc, which he hands over to Big Bob.

CURTIS

Here you go sir, good luck sir.

Big Bob throws the disc and it's another great throw, gliding down the line with a full flex to pass both Brett and Dave's shots, but still well short of Gabe's drive.

BIG BOB

That'll do for now.

CURTIS

Great throw sir!

The group walks up to their discs and Brett's second throw has good distance but drifts a little and lands to the side of the fairway just passed Gabe's drive. Dave has another good shot as well that lands in the middle of the fairway about 100 feet short of the basket.

RANDY

Another couple of great shots but both Brett and Dave will be hard-pressed to get birdies on this tough hole.

DAVE

I was hoping to get closer, but I'm still going to try and drain that!

Bob picks up his disc and sets down a mini. He looks around and meets eyes with Gilberto, who's emotionless face is quietly terrifying. Big Bob looks away and shakes off the discomfort that look brought him and then throws. It's a great, long shot that comes to rest not quite pin high but just outside circle one (35-40 feet away).

CURTIS

Excellent shot! You can drain that sir.

BIG BOB

You're damn right I can.

It's now Gabe's turn. He sets down his mini and stares down the basket.

GABE

What do you think Randy?

RANDY

I don't have the range finder, but I'd put it between two-twenty-five and two-fifty. If you can hit this, you win the tournament.

GABE

I'd love to do just that, my friend

RANDY

Well, you could go with a mid-range here and send something down there that will land close if you don't hit it.

Randy looks at Gabe, who is starting to nod. Music starts up (Eye of the Tiger by Survivor)

RANDY (CONT'D)

Or...

GABE

Or I can take my most trusted and reliable disc and fire it in basket and get this "W" right here, right now.

RANDY

I know the one.

Randy pulls out "Ol' Greeny," the disc from the beginning. It's a beat-up old disc, but Gabe takes it and holds it reverently.

GABE

(whispering to the disk)
You've been with me since my very first round. You think you can hit this one for me?

RANDY

You got this brother.

Gabe stands and takes a couple of practice swings and then a deep breath, and then throws the disc with a smooth standstill motion (no run up). As it glides through the air the music stops.

The camera pans to across the crowd and stops on Randy who is holding his hands out in preparation for a celebratory jump. Then the shot goes back to the disc gliding in slow motion right towards the basket.

Then everything goes back to normal speed and the disc deflects off the head band of the basket and glides over to rest right next to Big Bob's. There is an audible groan from the crowd.

RANDY (CONT'D)
 (Dropping to his knees)
 Noooooo!

BIG BOB
 (Breathing a sigh of relief)
 Oh man, that was a great shot Reyes

DAVE
 That was so close!

BRETT
 Damn Kid. Tough break there, but you can still birdie this one.

GABE
 As soon as I let that one go, I just knew it was going in. Crap!

RANDY
 So, you didn't eagle the toughest hole on the course. Shake it off and let's go get that birdie.

Brett takes his shot which he tries to run for a long way out and it drops in circle one.

BRETT
 Well, that was my chance. It's been a fun day fellas.

DAVE
 It ain't over just yet. Let me see if I can start off the chain train for us.

Dave tries to run a long putt, but it's high and left and drops just outside of circle one opposite Gabe and Bob's discs.

BIG BOB
 looks like you're up Reyes.

Gabe sets down his marker and sizes up the basket.

RANDY
 (quietly to Juliet)
 Normally he would lay this up.
 Ahhhh... I can't watch.

Gabe takes his shot and it goes just a little wide right and drops about 15 feet behind the basket. There is another groan from the crowd and Gabe crouches down, head in hands. Bob groans along with the crowd, but he can't hide his smile.

RANDY (CONT'D)
 (still to Juliet)
 Crap. Lil' Robert ain't going to miss his...

Bob lines up his shot.

BIG BOB
 For the win!

Big Bob shoots and there is never any doubt. The shot hits the center of the basket and a cheer goes up from the crowd.

BIG BOB (CONT'D)
 That's a big win for Big Bob! I think I'll celebrate with a Burrito!

Bob walks off into the crowd with Curtis in tow, seemingly uninterested in how the rest of the card finishes.

DAVE
 Well, it looks like two spots are still open.

He sets down his marker and quickly fires a laser right into the basket.

DAVE (CONT'D)
 Well Fellas, one spot left. This has been a really fun round.

Brett heads over to his disc and lines up his shot. He also nails his confidently.

BRETT
 Well Gabe, I just can't root against you, even if it means I don't qualify. Go put that putt away will ya?

Gabe looks at his disc and sets down a marker. The 15-foot shot is well within his range but with the pressure of what's going on, it seems so far away. He steps back and takes a breath. Randy comes to his side.

RANDY

You've played a hell of a round today brother. Send this one home and you'll get to play in the Cap City Open. But know that it's not the end of the world if you miss it. That scenario would put you in a play-off with Brett.

GABE

Okay, I got this.

Gabe lines up the shot and shoots, it's wobbly and low, but it just makes it over the rim of the basket and sits.

DAVE

My man!

BRETT

What an amazing round guys. Hit me up if you need a partner to practice with for the Cap City Open.

GABE

Do you think we'll need to do a play-off for second place?

DAVE

Let's see what the T.D. says.

The players and the crowd make their way to a nearby pavilion where the tournament director brings up Bob, Dave and Gabe and makes an announcement.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR

Thank you everyone for coming out today. As you all know, this was a qualifier tournament, so there are no trophies and just the top three get the invite to the Cap City open. Our winners today are: Robert Becker with an amazing minus fifteen through two rounds. In second, we have a tie at minus fourteen between Dave Rogers, and newcomer Gabriel Reyes!

Each player waves as their names are called.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR (CONT'D)

If you have questions, email me at the address on the website. Everyone should have received a player's pack. If you have not picked yours up yet, you can pick out two discs and a ball cap from the booth on the east side of the parking lot over there.

Gabe, Dave and Bob come down from the pavilion. Bob sees Gabe's family and pointedly goes in the other direction. The other two find Randy running around in excitement.

RANDY

Cap City Open baby!! You qualified!

He jumps around bumping into Dave and Randy and then he picks up Pacito.

RANDY (CONT'D)

Cap City Open Pacito!!

PACITO

Yay! Now put me down.

JULIET

You did it, babe.
(She hugs him)

GABE

Just barely.

DAVE

You just put up two thousand plus rated rounds. That's pro level right there, brother. And if you could make just a couple of those long putts, you'd have put this one away early. I hate to quote your buddy Lil' Robert, but putts are for dough.

GABE

Yeah, I know. Thanks man.

DAVE

See you next week kid.

Dave leaves.

Gilberto comes up to the group and stands quietly next to Randy, who notices him and immediately stops jumping around. Gabe sees Gilberto and sets his bag down and sits down on the curb.

GABE

Sup Papa.

GILBERTO

(Sitting down next to him)

Oh Mijo.

GABE

I'm sorry Dad, I know that it was irresponsible to leave my shift and I should have just told you, and I'm sorry that I got us all fired from Big Bob's by sneaking out and if...

GILBERTO

Mijo Stop. I think I get it now. Okay. I always thought that Frisbee golf was just a way for you to get out of work so that you could hang out with Gringo No-Sleeves over there... But I see that it's bigger than that, and that you do have... Real talent.

GABE

I don't know dad, I just barely qualified today, and this is one of my home courses with no active pro's playing against me. I don't know how I'm going to beat ninety actual pros in two weeks at The Open...

GILBERTO

Well, we all got fired today... so we're going to need you to go win the Cap City Open, and save our restaurant!

RANDY

That's what I'm talking bout!

VIOLET

Without having to work at Big Bobs, we can all focus on getting you ready.

JULIET

Yeah, we really just need to figure out a way to get you to put more of your putts away.

Gilberto reaches into Gabe's bag and pulls out the disc that Katy gave him earlier and points at her name and number on the disc.

GILBERTO

Maybe it's time to call this lady.

ACT 5, SCENE 1 (THE Teacher and the Montage)

EXT KATY'S RANCH - DAY

Gabe, Randy, Gilberto, Violet, Juliet and Pacito are at a ranch with Katy. behind them is a wooden split rail fence.

Katy is walking back and forth like a drill sergeant.

KATY

I'm glad that your father reached out to me, and Gabe, I believe we can make a decent putter out of you yet. I will teach you how play like a champion and how to drain putts from outside the circle but I'll need each of you to do exactly as I say.

Gabe looks around at the others who are all nodding.

GABE

We're ready!

Katy points at Randy, Violet and then Gilberto.

KATY

You, you and you. We're going to need a ton of discs, and to build Gabe a fan base. Here is a list of all the water hazards where people lose discs in the area. Your mission is to retrieve as many discs as possible from those water hazards.

VIOLET

How do we go about that?

KATY

(gesturing towards Randy)
I expect you'll be sending that one
out in some waders.

RANDY

Don't sweat this, I know a guy.

KATY

(pointing at Juliet and
Pacito)
You and you. I need you to gather
up every soda, soup or beer can
that you can find and set them over
there by that fence post.

PACITO

We're on it! C'mon sis.

Juliet and Pacito head away.

KATY

And that leaves just us Gabriel,
let's go over to my practice basket
and see what putt works for you
best.

Katy and Gabe walk up to a basket and stand about 25 feet
away from it. Katy has a stack of 4 putters.

KATY (CONT'D)

There are four main types of putts.
Push Putt, Straddle Putt, Spin
Putt, and the unconventional, but
effective Turbo Putt.

She adjusts her form for each type and drives a putter into
the basket as she says its name.

KATY (CONT'D)

So, let's see what you have.

Katy retrieves the discs and give them to Gabe who tries each
and misses them all.

KATY (CONT'D)

Okay I think we have something to
work with here. What you've been
doing is more of a spin putt, so
let's focus on that.

Katy Gathers the putters.

GABE

Show me the way sensei!

KATY

Okay first we need to adjust this stance. Move your back foot further back. You're going to need to shift your weight from back to front. Keep your arm straight, not like a drive where you follow through, but end basically pointing at the basket. Bend your wrist in and bring your arm down. Pick a single link in the chains there, weight shift back, and then forward, fire the disc into the basket.

Gabe tries and he hits chains but, he's off center and the putt falls to the ground.

KATY (CONT'D)

Okay maybe try this. Imagine you have a board going from your front leg into the basket, and then slide the disc down that board.

GABE

I like that.

Gabe leans back and drives one into the basket with authority.

KATY

Now you just need to keep working on that to gain consistency.

GABE

Got it.

Katy points out Bricks in the ground all over the yard.

KATY

Now I want a hundred putts from you today. Take these four putters and the one from your bag and set them each at a different brick. Then move to each spot and take the shot thinking about the form we worked on.

Music starts ("Wild" by Spoon) The montage begins.

First shot is Pacito and Juliet Dragging a giant trash bag full of cans to the fence. Katy takes a few out and lines them up on the about 3 feet apart on the fence.

KATY (CONT'D)

Pacito, your job is dodging shots and putting the cans he hits back on the fence. Juliet, you're on disc return duty

Katy takes Gabe's five discs and knocks down five cans in a row.

KATY (CONT'D)

start from fifteen feet, when you can get ten in a row, move back to twenty, then twenty-five, then thirty. You can't be missing anything under thirty feet!

Next shot is Randy pulling up to a house in his truck and honking the horn. There is a man sitting in a lawn chair out front drinking beer.

RANDY

Yo Brody! My Man! We have a water hazard disc retrieval mission. Care to join?

BRODY

Awww Randy! You had me at "Yo Brody!" Let me get my snorkel.

Shot of Gabe taking putts and the practice basket, this time they're all close, and one of five goes in.

Shot of Randy, and Brody splashing around in a pond.

BRODY (CONT'D)

Got one

He throws it to Violet on the shore. She dries it off with a towel and throws it into a pile with 5 other discs.

GILBERTO

Players on the box! Look alive gueros!

Back to Gabe throwing at the cans this time. He misses all five shots, camera turns and shows maybe 50 cans stacked and Pacito lining more up way down the fence line. Juliet throws the discs back.

JULIET

Don't get discouraged babe, I'm
sure nobody starts out good at this
one.

Next shot is back to Randy and Brody in the pond, the stack
of discs by Violet is now up to 40 or 50 discs.

GILBERTO

Incoming!

A disc splashes in the water behind Randy.

RANDY

Got it! Here you go fella.

He tosses the disc to the shore where the player that threw
it is walking by.

RANDOM PLAYER

Hey thanks!

To Gabe at the practice basket. Two of the five throws go in
and one hits chains but falls out.

To Randy and Brody, now in a different pond tossing more
discs to Violet.

BRODY

what are y'all going to do with all
these discs anyway?

RANDY

No idea!

To Gabe at the fence. This time he hits three cans in a row.

PACITO

You're like an old timey cowboy. If
this was a western, they'd have got
you a shotgun by now though.

JULIET

Ha! Roasted!

To Brody and Randy at a different pond tossing discs to
Violet.

VIOLET

So, you guys are just not at all
worried about snakes?

BRODY

it is the snakes who should be worried about me! But seriously they don't want any part of us and as long as if there is one, we don't chase it, or mess with it, then no, I'm not too worried.

RANDY

There are snakes in here?

To Gabe at the practice Tee show 3 shots going in a row

To Randy and Brody in a third pond Violet is off to the side with another big pile of discs that she's drying off.

BRODY

I think I feel one with my toes.

RANDY

Gross

A disc splashes between them scaring them both.

GILBERTO

(in the back ground)
Got a thrower!

RANDY

You were a little late on that one papa G! We'd like the call-out BEFORE one of us gets brained.

To Gabe at the fence knocking down cans with all five of his discs.

JULIET

That's ten in a row. Nice work Gabe!

PACITO

Now move it back mister!

Music fades and we see a shot of the sun rising and a Truck pulling up to Katy's drive way where Katy and her husband standing outside waiting to greet them. Randy is driving with Brody in the passenger seat and Gabe in the back.

RANDY

Good Morning Mr. and Mrs. Brooks!
You should see the haul we got yesterday!

BRODY

And Randy only got hit by one disc
all day.

Randy drops the tail gate and He and Brody pull out three,
five-gallon buckets that are filled to the brim with discs.
Randy and Brody dump them all out on the lawn.

KATY

this is great!

Behind them Gilberto pulls up in the Reyes family car with
Violet, Juliet, Pacito and Abuelita.

GILBERTO

Sorry we're late, I can't drive as
fast as Gringo-No-Sleeves because I
love my family.

Gilberto pops the trunk and has two more buckets full of
discs.

KATY

This is quite the haul!

GABE

Katy, this is my abuelita.

KATY

Pleasure to meet you!

ABUELITA

Mucho Gusto Katy. I love seeing you
getting Gabriel whipped into shape.
I was left out of the first day of
boot camp here, but today I'm here
to help!

KATY

Glad to have you Mrs. Reyes. This
is my Husband Steve. He, too, is
here to help today.

EVERYONE

Hi Steve!

STEVE

Hello Everyone. Katy tells me we're
all on Team Reyes today, and I'm
ready to rock!

KATY

I have new missions for everyone.
Randy, New Guy...

BRODY

Name's Brody! I'm a huge fan Ms. Brooks.

KATY

Thanks Brody, you can call me Katy. You and Randy are on "helping Gabe" duty from here on out. He's working on his form and putting at the basket, and I've challenged him with the fencepost can-exercise.

RANDY

On it!

KATY

The rest of you, we need to sort these discs. The ones with phone numbers, we're going to call and try to get back to their owners. You can deliver them or meet the people at the park. Just be sure to mention that Gabe is playing in the Cap City open and that they should come check it out. The ones without numbers, we can put back in the buckets and we'll donate them to our youth outreach program.

JULIET

That's a really cool thing to do for the community.

STEVE

Yeah, it works out great, because the people that we call are appreciative, and sometimes they just donate their discs instead of coming to pick them up.

ABUELITA

What if we tell all the people to come pick their discs at The Pavilion this evening and I will make special tacos for everyone. We can call it a celebration for my Mijo qualifying for the Cap City Open.

KATY

That is a great idea!

STEVE

I'm happy to help with that Mrs. Reyes. I have my BBQ pit ready if you'd like help with grilling up some Carnitas and Chicken fajitas!

GILBERTO

I love a good cook out. Would you mind if I helped out on the grill?

STEVE

Hey, I've been a fan of Reyes' Tortillas Y'mas since I was in college. I'd love to learn a little from a master chef!

GILBERTO

(putting an arm around
abuelita)

Well, you have two of them right here.

Katy starts going through the discs and tossing them into two piles.

KATY

Number, No Number.

Violet and Juliet sit around the "Number" pile and begin making calls.

KATY (CONT'D)

If, or when they don't pick up, text a picture and let them know that it will be available at The Pavilion this evening.

Katy looks at Steve who is holding a disc from the "No Number" pile and smiling from ear to ear.

KATY (CONT'D)

Tell them to come hungry.

Abuelita goes over to Pacito and messes up his hair.

ABUELITA

Orale' Pacito. You've gotten so big! Should we start calling you just Paco now.

PACITO

I actually prefer Paco Loco, but mostly just my school friends call me that.

ABUELITA

Well Paco Loco, you want to help me with some shopping. I need some things to make the best tacos ever.

PACITO

(Putting on his sunglasses)

I got you Abuelita. Let's go!

ABUELITA

(To Gilberto)

Me voy de compras. Volvere' con el coche in un rato.

(Translation: I'm going shopping, I'll be back with the car in a little while.)

GILBERTO

I'm coming with you Mama. I haven't cooked in a while and I'm getting the itch.

STEVE

You mind if I join y'all?

ABUELITA

The more the merrier. But I'm going to need your word that you won't share any of our secret family recipes.

STEVE

(Crossing his heart)

You have my word Mrs. Reyes.

GILBERTO

Violet, text me with your best guess on how many people will show up tonight.

VIOLET

You got it Papa!

The four load up into the Reyes family car and head out. The music starts back up and the montage continues!

Katy continues splitting up discs while Violet and Juliet are making calls and taking pictures with their phones. The shot then pans over to Gabe, Randy and Brody over by the practice basket where Gabe was practicing his putts, The discs are laid out at separate stakes and Gabe goes to each one and drives it into the basket.

RANDY

Whoa, look at that improvement!

GABE

Yeah, Katy showed me some tricks yesterday. I practiced all day, and I've been thinking about them all night.

RANDY

Did she tell you the Weiner Trick?

BRODY

The Weiner Trick is Money!

GABE

I hate that I'm curious here...
What's the weiner trick?

RANDY

You tie your weiner to the center of the pole here on the basket and slide the disc down your weiner and into the basket.

GABE

She told me to imagine a board...

RANDY

I use the weiner trick when I putt, and I do putt better than you.

GABE

Not for long! I've been getting better already.

BRODY

That's because you know the Weiner Trick now!

GABE

Lets focus fellas. Help me out with the fence exercise.

RANDY

You think that will help you as much as the Weiner Trick.

GABE

Both of you stop saying Weiner Trick!

Camera goes back to Juliet who's on the phone with one of the people who lost a disc.

JULIET

Hello I'm Juliet, my friends found a disc with the name Matt Stockton and this number on it.

(Pause)

Yeah it was in the water hazard. Not sure which one as they checked basically every pond in the greater Austin area yesterday.

(Pause)

Cool, well it'll be available to pick up at the Pavilion tonight. We're having a little celebration for my boyfriend Gabe Reyes who qualified for the

(Pause)

Oh, you're that Matt?!?! Well nice to talk to you again too...

We then catch up with Gilberto, Pacito, Abuelita and Steve. Abuelita is pushing the grocery cart and the others are adding items - Flour, salt, chicken breast, Chuck Roast, garlic cloves, various spices.

Camera goes back to Gabe doing the fence drill. He hits three cans in a row. Randy and Brody cheer and then boo him when he misses. Brody puts the cans back and Randy tosses the discs back to Gabe.

Cut back to Juliet and Violet going through discs, the "No Name" pile is gone now and Katy has her phone out and is helping them reach out to everyone.

Next shot goes to a kitchen with Abuelita showing the boys how to make tortillas. She's kneading the flower.

ABUELITA

Homemade tortillas, made with Abuelita's love make for the best tacos. Abuelita's love and just a little butter.

Back to Gabe throwing doing the Fence post drill. He hits five in a row and Randy and Brody cheer. Brody is now drinking beer.

RANDY

There we go! Time to move it back!

Camera goes back to Katy, Juliet and Violet. The pile of discs is gone, and are all three have a disc in their hand and are talking on the phone.

KATY

Yup, I'll be there too, and of course if you bring your signature series disc, I'll be happy to sign it for you. Thanks!

We go back to the kitchen and you see all four, Gilberto, Pacito, Abuelita and Steve manning skillets at the stove making tortillas. Then a shot of a plate of freshly made tortillas stacking higher and higher.

Cut back to Gabe, now standing pretty far away from the fence (30 feet) and drilling cans. He hits four and one falls down on its own. Brody chugs his beer and sets it down to get immediately hit by a disc. All three men cheer!

Next shot is Steve uncovering a really awesome Grill. Gilberto looks at it like a long-lost love.

STEVE

And this here is my pride and joy.

GILBERTO

She's muy bonita!

Cut back outside to Gabe, Randy and Brody. Gabe is putting from 45 to 50 feet back and sinking two out of five, but the misses are all very close.

RANDY

Who even are you? My boy is going to be UNSTOPPABLE!

BRODY

And it's all because of the Weiner Trick!

GABE

Dammit Brody!

Katy walks up with some trash bags.

KATY

Okay boys, that's enough practice for Gabe for today and enough weiner talk from the lot of you. Help me get these cans picked up to recycle.

RANDY

(embarrassed)

I'm so sorry Miss Katy! We'll get these all picked up right away.

Randy takes a bag from Katy and Brody walks with him picking up the cans on the fence line.

KATY

Looks like you're improving kid

GABE

I never thought that I'd be able to get it dialed in like this.

He leans back, checks his stance and fires a shot into the basket.

GABE (CONT'D)

To be totally honest. I only really ever play with Randy, or people that he and I hustle on the course. I never really had to putt well to be able to win.

KATY

So, you're saying that you've never just practiced putting...

GABE

Not really.

KATY

Well, it's the easiest thing to practice and the fastest way to shave some strokes off of you final score!

GABE

I think I'm proof of that now!

Gabe fires another disc at the basket and it hits the center of the chains.

GABE (CONT'D)

Randy has been telling me that for a long time too.

KATY

Randy might be a little rough around the edges, but he knows disc golf. Now let's go get cleaned up. I'm ready for some Bar-B-Que!

GABE

Will do. Thanks again Katy. You've been an inspiration since the moment I met you.

KATY
Of course, kid. Just... Pay it
forward someday.

ACT 5, SCENE 2 (THE Bar-B-Que) -

EXT - PAVILION (NORTHTOWN OR STARKE) - EVENING

Gilberto and Steve are manning a huge grill at The Pavilion. There are about 25 people milling about. Abuelita has a table set up where she's adding ingredients and wrapping tacos in Tin foil. Violet and Katy are at a table with discs on it and there are people checking them out to find theirs. Randy, Gabe, Juliet, Pacito and Brody, along with Dave and Matt (from the qualifier) are standing in a big circle eating and laughing.

We have an aerial shot that shows everyone hanging out and talking. Then get some close-up shots of delicious tacos.

At the table near Violet and Katy, there is a woman, Erin getting her disc signed by Katy.

ERIN
This is so cool; can I give you
some money for getting this out of
the lake for me?

KATY
Oh, no thanks. This whole thing is
really just for the Reyes family
celebrating Gabe qualifying for the
Cap City Open. We also donate the
discs that go unclaimed.

VIOLET
We haven't had much to celebrate
since our restaurant burned down,
we're hoping Gabe can win enough
for us to pay for the repairs.

ERIN
Y'all are the Reyes... es from
Reyes Tortilla's Y'Mas?

VIOLET
Yup, that's us.

ERIN
Do you know when y'all will be able
to open back up?

VIOLET

Well... To be determined. Our insurance isn't covering it and it'll cost around sixty thousand dollars to get it re-built.

ERIN

And yet your whole family is out here helping out the disc golf community and giving away these delicious tacos for free?

VIOLET

That's about the size of it, I guess.

ERIN

Have you thought about starting a web page to see if the community would be willing to donate in order to help get those repairs paid for?

VIOLET

We haven't. I don't think Papa would be on board with asking for hand-outs though.

ERIN

Well, I'm sure that everyone here and probably a lot of other people would be happy to pitch in to help out your restaurant!

KATY

And it wouldn't be a hand-out. Look at what your family is doing for the community right now. All in spite of the adversity that y'all have had to endure. Maybe people will think that your restaurant is an essential part of the community.

VIOLET

Hey, it's not me that you'd have to convince! It's Papa.

ERIN

My husband, Matt, over there and I actually own a business that helps companies design websites, so I'd be happy to work with you on that.

VIOLET

We have a website, but it's very basic. Mostly just to place orders for pick up.

ERIN

In that case all you'd need is a link and a paragraph or two about what happened. The real challenge then would just be getting the word out and directing people to the site.

KATY

So, I noticed a social media post that is starting to go a little viral. It's got like eleven thousand views in the past few days. You think we can use that.

VIOLET

Is it the video from the kitchen that Aaron took?

KATY

It is. When Gilberto told me about how you were all fired, I may have gone down a bit of a rabbit hole on the internet trying to figure out why that would happen. Check it out.

The three women all watch the video on Katy's phone and Erin is nodding and Violet's eyes go wide.

ERIN

Do you know the person that posted this?

VIOLET

I do, and he was a big fan of Pacito.

ERIN

So, all you'd really need to do is get him to link your site in his post, or anything that will direct people to the site will help. And then on your site, add a bit about what happened with the fire, and then link to an online account that people can donate to.

VIOLET

This has been super informative
ladies. Let me see what I can do!

The music picks up ("Don't you Eva" Instrumental By Spoon) and then the camera follows Violet to Pacito who checks his phone and starts texting. The camera then follows Violet to Gabriel and then the two of them to Abuelita and then the three of them to the Gilberto. There is a bit of an animated discussion, and then Steve puts a hand on Gilberto's shoulder. He nods and gestures at the Grill. They all smile, Gabe hugs Violet and then runs across the pavilion to find Juliet and he hugs her lifting her up and spinning around.

The next shot is of Pacito and Violet handing out tacos to everyone and then people eating them and smiling.

Matt and Gabe cheers with Tacos and nod in appreciation to where Gilberto and Abuelita are eating, and they wave back.

It starts to get dark, and most of the crowd thins out. Katy is helping Gabe, Violet and Juliet clean up.

VIOLET (CONT'D)

(To Katy)

When you had us go look for discs
in the water, I couldn't figure out
how that helped Gabe. I thought you
were just trying to get Randy and
Papa out of there for a while.

KATY

We'll that was definitely part of
it.

VIOLET

But getting the community together
out here to help our restaurant was
your plan the whole time, wasn't
it?

KATY

Well, mine and Steve's. We weren't
sure exactly how, but helping other
people is usually the best way to
find help when you need it. Also,
Steve had a disc in the pond out at
Met that he was hoping y'all would
find.

VIOLET

Did we?

KATY
You sure did!

Act 5, SCENE 3 (THE Cap City Open)

EXT THE RANCH IN WAELDER - DAY

- It's the Morning of the big Tournament! Randy and Gabe are out at A field with a stack of discs. Gabe is warming up and launching some discs out across an open field.

RANDY
How's that golden elbow feeling
little brother?

GABE
Feeling good. Little nervous
though.

RANDY
It would be crazy if you weren't
feeling nervous. It's the freaking
Cap City Open Baby!

The shot zooms out and we see the scope of the event with tents set up and tons of people. Ideally here we could get an open with the Jomezpro guys talking about the tournament and then as many cameos with pro players as possible. This would be 100% adlibbed as we'd ask the pro players what they thought of the big tournament in Austin, and use their answers.

Que inspirational music.

ANNOUNCER #1
(Big Jerm?)
Hello and Welcome to Round one
coverage of the Cap City Open in
Austin Texas. Austin is known for
its music scene, for keeping it
weird, and for being the eighth
ranked city in the nation for disc
golf. Here they have twenty-six
local area courses and more than
forty disc golf leagues!

ANNOUNCER #2

(Uli?)

For this tournament our pros will be playing at (Course TBD the Ranch or Turkey Creek?) This place has some long holes, lots of wooded areas and the forecast is shows that the players will be likely be dealing with some wind out there this weekend.

ANNOUNCER #1

That is correct. We played a practice round out there earlier and just getting the direction of the wind can be challenging. At one point my partner here told me the direction was "clockwise," and he wasn't wrong!

ANNOUNCER #2

This is the largest tournament in Texas, and one of, if not the biggest tournaments in the country.

ANNOUNCER #1

This one gets a huge draw because of the official Pro Purse, right?

ANNOUNCER #2

Lets talk about the prize money for a second. A half million dollars' worth of winnings will be awarded at the end of the weekend with the winner of MPO walking away with a cool fifty thousand!

ANNOUNCER #1

That's just unprecedented. I remember my mind being blown a few years ago when the winner of this one got ten thousand dollars.

ANNOUNCER #2

So MPO is about to kick off. The first card is pretty cool for this one. They hold an open qualifier here in Austin and allow three local players to join the event.

ANNOUNCER #1

And if they do well enough, they can earn a spot on the official pro tour, right?

ANNOUNCER #2

That is correct.

ANNOUNCER #1

On that card, we have a former pro player in Dave Rogers, who has placed in this tournament before, Jon Rojas, who will be the only one that's already actually on the tour. Then there's Gabriel Reyes, a kid with a brand new PDGA number, but who has already generated some buzz because he apparently has just incredible distance. And rounding out that card is the winner of the qualifier round and CEO of Big Bob's Burritos, Big Bob Becker.

ANNOUNCER #2

You know with a name like "Big Bob" I thought he'd be a larger dude.

ANNOUNCER #1

He's got that Big Burrito Power though.

ANNOUNCER #2

I wouldn't be surprised if that really is a thing down here in Texas!

The shot goes down to the start of the tournament with Gabe, Randy, David, and another pro player getting ready to tee off.

DAVE

Hey Randy, I thought about this after the Bar-B-Que the other day and I brought you another shirt just in case... A-Tier tournaments have a rule where you actually can't have a shirt with the sleeves cut off.

RANDY

No that's not a real thing! For Caddy's too?

DAVE
Yeah man, here

Dave tosses him a shirt. Randy immediately takes his shirt off to change them out. He struggles a little and bumps into Jon.

JON
Whoa there, big fella.

RANDY
Oh, sorry.

Randy gets the shirt on.

GABE
Hi there, I'm Gabe. The guy over there struggling with his shirt is my caddy, Randy. And this here is Dave Rogers. We all played in the qualifier together last week.

JON
Nice to meet you I'm Jon Rojas

DAVE
Sup Jon.

RANDY
Howdy! Looks like all we're missing now is Lil' Robert.

GABE
We talked about this Randy. We're better than that, remember?

RANDY
Yes, we did, and I do. Apologies!

GABE
You look so different in just a normal shirt. It's kind of freaking me out.

DAVE
Me too!

JON
(shrugging)
I just met you, so it looks pretty normal to me.

Big Bob arrives with Curtis in tow.

BIG BOB
Hello men, sorry I'm late.

JON
Hi there, Bob.

DAVE
Howdy.

GABE
Good to see you again Mr. Becker

Gabe shakes Big Bob's hand and nods toward Randy.

BIG BOB
Did you send this one to obedience
classes over the past week. Looking
good with the uncut shirt there
Randy.

RANDY:
It's horrible! It's all sticky and
tight. I can't breathe!

BIG BOB
This is Curtis, he'll be my caddy
today. And he can keep one of the
score cards if y'all are okay with
that.

CURTIS
I'm also here to keep an eye out
and help find any discs that may
end up in the brush.

DAVE
an extra set of eyes for stuff like
that is always appreciated!

RANDY
I'll keep the other score card, if
that's okay.

JON
Works for me. Let's have a good
round fellas.

Everyone Fist Bumps and the Tournament begins!

CURTIS
I have, Dave, Jon, Bob, then Gabe
for the order on this one.

The hole is a long par 4 with a gap of trees about half-way down and then the basket behind a cluster of trees in the center with a split fairway. Dave steps up and throws and his disc gets about halfway down and leaves him a long shot down the left fairway.

JON

Thanks for showing me a line there lefty!

Jon forehands his shot to the same general area.

DAVE

Oh, I see we'll be able to help each other some today.

Big Bob steps up and throws his first shot and it lands right in the middle just short of the split.

BIG BOB

No commentary today there Randy?

RANDY

I feel all stifled with these sleeves, and I haven't found a good mic yet... Gabe, this one is six hundred and forty feet with a gap to hit and a split fair way just past said gap. Throw this one hard and high over the gap and try to get it to spike on the right side of the split.

Gabe takes the disc and does exactly that. Cut to the second throws with Dave and Jon following each other on the left and then Bob taking the right side around the trees. Gabe had the longest drive, but his mid-range shot gets into some branches and drops near Bob's second shot. All three players are mid to back Circle 2 (around 50ft)

Dave is the furthest out and clanks his putt off of the lower basket cage. Jon sinks his putt, and then Bob lines his up and sinks his too.

BIG BOB

Looking like Big Bobby Bee is going to gain a stroke on you right of the top there Gabe.

Without saying a word, Gabe drops his mini to mark his spot. He takes his putter from Randy, lines up the shot and fires it right into the basket.

RANDY

(who now has a stick for a
mic)

Well folks with that rail gun shot,
it looks like our hometown
maintenance team hero has tightened
up his putting game. Big Bob is
left speechless by the display!

BIG BOB

Nice sh-

RANDY

Absolutely speechless!

DAVE

Wow, what a laser Gabe! Sorry I
messed up the star frame guys.

Music starts up ("The Underdog" by Spoon) The group walks to
hole 2 and Randy, carrying the disc bag and holding the mic
gives his commentary to just Gabe.

RANDY

Hole two is a six hundred and fifty
foot shot down an alley with a left
turn. It'll be easy to lose this
one in some trees, but if you take
ol' Mean green here and keep it low
and in the fairway, I think you can
set us up for another birdie.

GABE

I think I can do that.

Jon steps up and takes his throw. He tries to go high over
the ally and gets good distance, but his disc drops in a more
wooded area. Gabe lines up and shoots an incredible, low
flying shot stays about 5 feet of the ground and goes
straight down the alley about 500 ft.

JON

Daaamn! What a Rip!

DAVE

Yeah, He does that.

Dave and Big Bob follow up with their throws which are in the
fairway, but short of where Gabe's disc landed. We skip
forward and see Gabe lay up the next shot and then hit an
easy putt for another Birdie.

RANDY

Hole three is one of the few shortish ones out here, but don't let the short distance fool you, the lane is pretty narrow and there are thick trees on either side. For you this would be a stable Mid-Range and get it to curve to the left.

Each of the players throw and you see each of them end in the trees. Gabe is actually the furthest out, but he makes a long putt for another Birdie.

RANDY (CONT'D)

(Dances and Gobbles like a Turkey)

Gobble Gobble Gobble, Gobble Gobble Gobble! That's a Turkey to start it out son!

GABE

Hell yeah!

DAVE

(To Big Bob)

Looks like the kid figured out his putting issues.

BIG BOB

He sure is off to a good start out here. I could certainly live without Randy's goofy turkey dance though.

You see Dave and Bob make their putts and Jon's chains out. From here it moves to more of a montage of throws and discs gliding through the air. There are some shots of discs hitting trees and all four players doing a little scrambling, as nobody gets through the Ranch without hitting some trees. We'll need several shots of Gabe getting long drives and then some of him confidentially sinking a couple more putts from outside of circle one. (30ft).

We get to hole eighteen and the music stops and we go back to the players.

JON

This has been a really fun round y'all. This is a tough course and it's been really cool seeing how y'all break it down.

DAVE

Absolutely brother. This was a fun card. We'll see how the rest of the players do, but I think we all held our own for the first day. Especially the kid with the golden elbow over here.

BIG BOB

You could already throw further than anyone I've ever seen, and now you're hitting your putts. It's going to be tough to catch you at this point kid.

GABE

Thanks fellas. A wise person once told me that putts were the easiest thing to practice and the fastest way to improve your score. Turns out she was right!

RANDY

Also, the weiner trick!

JON

The what now?

GABE

Imagine a board is going from your hip to the basket and you're sliding the disc down that board and into the basket.

CURTIS

Why is called the weiner trick?

RANDY

because instead of a board you tie your -

GABE

(cutting Randy off)

What disc should I use here buddy?

CURTIS

Oooh. I get it!

Big Bob looks down and shakes his head.

RANDY

This one is a tricky one. For the first day we're throwing at the "A" pin so it's a six-hundred-and-ninety-foot par four. But wait, there's more! You'll have a dip about four hundred feet in that's out of bounds with some water on the left, and once you get out in the field there will for sure be a head wind. I recommend a stable driver that you can drop about three fifty to four hundred, and then laying up from there. The wind is for sure a factor if you go high. Gabe, take this disc and laser it low.

GABE

On it.

Gabe throws and it goes right at 350 feet and sits in the grass. The other players have learned to trust Randy's breakdowns by now and all follow that route without question.

RANDY

(to Bob)

Admit it Robert, you're going to miss me next round.

BIG BOB

Randy, this has been, by far, my best round of disc golf. I honestly can't believe how much Gabe is still beating me by!

RANDY

He's not out here just trying to beat you, Bob. He's out here trying to win this whole thing. He still blames himself for his family's restaurant burning down. He wants to make things right, and in his mind, winning here is his only option.

Randy smiles and pats Big Bob on the back. Big Bob takes a step back and looks at Gabe.

BIG BOB

I... I didn't realize.

RANDY

It's okay brother. For this next throw, try something over-stable or heavy so that the wind doesn't blow it out of bounds.

BIG BOB

Curtis, hand me my Red Fire Eagle.

CURTIS

(handing Big Bob the disc)
Here you go sir!

The players all take their next shot for lay-ups and all of their discs drop close to the basket.

DAVE

Star frame Boys! That's the way to close round one!

JON

I'm really happy with the tie with Ol' Bob at minus six! It looks like we'll have a chance of being on the same card next round.

DAVE

Beating me by one stroke... Again! I'll get it back tomorrow! It looks like the Golden boy here will be moving up though... I'm going to miss you and Randy next round but good luck on that lead card!

BIG BOB

You think we did good enough to get the chase card tomorrow? My best out here before today was an even, so this minus six should be well above my rating!

GABE

Curtis, Big Bob, thanks for a fun round today y'all. Good luck tomorrow.

The group high fives and fist bumps, then splits with Jon and Big Bob headed to one side of the parking lot and Gabe, Randy and Dave headed to the other.

GABE (CONT'D)

You think my score will hold?

RANDY

I think a ten under will for sure hold today. I'm not sure if that's a course record, but I am sure that it should put you in the top four!

GABE

It was weird how nice Big Bob was today. It was like playing a normal fun round.

DAVE

Probably part of what Big Bob likes about disc golf is that he's completely in charge of, and responsible for how good or bad he plays.

RANDY

He's the CEO of a giant restaurant chain. He's in charge of, and responsible for the careers of hundreds of people.

DAVE

I'm guessing there hasn't been much in Bob's life that wasn't handed to him. It probably felt really good for him to earn something entirely himself.

GABE

Well, I sure hope this version of him sticks.

RANDY

If we're hoping for things, I hope that Abuelita and Gilberto made tacos!

DAVE

That's my hope as well. I wish more people were allowed to walk with the card through our round here, but I understand why it's limited.

The trio rounds a corner to see the Reyes family car with a pop-up tent and a grill going, a table set up to assemble tacos, and a couple of coolers. Gilberto is grilling, Violet, Juliet, and Pacito are all watching scores on Juliet's phone.

PACITO

There's my boy! You freaking crushed it today!

(MORE)

PACITO (CONT'D)

A lot of the big pros are still playing, but you have a solid lead.

JULIET

Hi Baby.

Gabe hugs Juliet and they kiss.

VIOLET

Gross y'all, not in my space!

ABUELITA

Hi Mijo! Pacito is keeping me up to date on how you are doing. First place right now! I'm so proud of you. Me and your Papa are making tacos.

GILBERTO

You think some of your little friends would like some tacos?

GABE

I'm sure they would, how many did you make?

Gabe opens the cooler

GABE (CONT'D)

Holy crap that's a lot of tacos.

RANDY

Shouldn't you be trying to sell them or something?

GILBERTO

That's not what we're about today...

He takes a taco out of the cooler and shows Gabe and Randy a taco that has "ReyesTortillasYMas.com" written on the wrapper in sharpie.

JULIET

We didn't have time to get stickers made, but we thought this could be a start. Reyes' tacos do their talking with the taste though, right?

GILBERTO

Give this taco away and it'll be so good that people will want to look at our website.

(MORE)

GILBERTO (CONT'D)

There we have an updated page
telling our story and how we'd like
to stay open.

ABUELITA

Your sister and I, and Katy and
Steve, convinced him to set up an
account to take donations. Look, we
already have almost a thousand
dollars in there!

GABE

(Somewhat Defeated)
Just fifty-nine more to go...

RANDY

(with his mouth full of a
taco)
That's brilliant!

GILBERTO

Nobody likes solicitations... But
everyone likes free tacos!

GABE

I'll be right back y'all.

Gabe grabs four tacos and jogs off down the parking lot to
find Bob and Curtis watching the live coverage of the last
card on a big TV Screen in the back of Bob's Truck.

GABE (CONT'D)

Hey Bob, Hey Curtis. My papa and my
abuelita made a ton of tacos, and I
thought you might like a couple.
Trust me, they're really good.

BIG BOB

Thanks Gabe.

GABE

Of course. Sorry about the sharpie
on the wrapper, that's my dad's way
of trying to get some donations to
help save the restaurant.

Gabe jogs off and the camera stays with Bob and Curtis. A
couple of people walking by look at them, shake their heads,
and then keep walking.

BIG BOB

That kid is sure being cool, but a lot of people have been giving me dirty looks out here today. What gives?

CURTIS

Well, it could be the video sir.

BIG BOB

Video?

CURTIS

Yeah, the one that's going kind of viral.

BIG BOB

(Sighs)

Put it on the screen.

CURTIS

I'd advise against that sir.

BIG BOB

Advice noted, now put it on the screen.

Curtis types on his phone for a second and then the screen goes black for a beat and a video pops up. The title screen says: "Why I Quit My Job at Big Bob's Burritos" An Aaron Berg production.

AARON

Okay y'all, you have to see this kid. He's filling in for his big brother or something, but never mind that! Check out his skills with the knives!

The video pans over and Pacito is there with onions, tomatoes, and green peppers and he's dicing them at rocket speed.

AARON (CONT'D)

Hey bro, the steak is ready to be cut now too.

PACITO

Drop that shit right here old man!

Aaron drops a big skirt steak and Pacito cuts it up super quickly too.

AARON

He can't work here permanently because he's like twelve, but having him here today has been great! I haven't done shit all day!

Joshua comes in and put his hands up.

JOSHUA

Hey... Kid, I'm sorry but you're fired. You need to get with Gilberto and Violet, and get out immediately. Who even are you?

PACITO

Um... Okay.

AARON

Whoa bro why are you firing everyone? You know we get a late rush in like an hour. And this kid is killing it! If anything, he should have your job!

JOSHUA

Not now Aaron. I just got word straight from the Big Bob's mouth that the Reyes...es need to go, that includes your little friend there. I'm sorry. Now can you turn that off?

AARON

That's bunk, man what the hell? The Reyes...es have been busting their asses since they got here.

JOSHUA

Not my call. Now, I said turn it off!

Joshua reaches for the phone and you see his hand cover the screen, then it cuts to Aaron walking away from the restaurant.

AARON

So, if you try to get your burrito on at the North Loop location, and it takes forever, now you know why. Big Bob and Josh can both eat my fat hairy-

The screen goes to black. A random stranger is now standing next to Big Bob and Curtis watching the video.

CURTIS

The rest is just a profanity filled rant.

RANDOM STRANGER

I saw that one yesterday. Totally not where I thought it was going when it started! You should have kept playing it though, the rant is the best part.

CURTIS

It's getting buzz online, and people are blaming you sir.

The random stranger looks at Big Bob and then Curtis and then back to the screen and slowly puts together who he's standing with.

RANDOM STRANGER

Oh... You're the... Um... Y'all have a good day.

The Stranger wanders off.

BIG BOB

What exactly are they saying?

CURTIS

None of it is nice, sir.

BIG BOB

Give me some examples.

CURTIS

Are you sure sir?

BIG BOB

Just tell me.

CURTIS

There are hashtags on here that say... Ahem... Bad Bob, Boycott Big Bob's, Bob the Boss-zilla, Becker the Pecker, Becker no Pecker, Big Bob Boss from Hell, Big Baby Bob, Lil' Bobby Bottle Baby...

BIG BOB

Okay, Okay, I got it!

CURTIS
Worst Boss Bob, Small Knob Bob, Big
Bobby the Bitch...

BIG BOB
I said I got it!

CURTIS
Sorry sir.

BIG BOB
You think Gabe had anything to do
with this?

CURTIS
I doubt it. Does Gabe even know
that it was you who made the call?

BIG BOB
I didn't make that call, did I?

CURTIS
Well technically, I placed the call
sir.

BIG BOB
Oh, that's right. From when I got
mad at freaking Randy... There's a
chance that was an overreaction.

Big Bob sits on the tailgate of his truck and opens the taco
that Gabe brought him.

BIG BOB (CONT'D)
What's protocol on fixing something
like this?

CURTIS
A response legitimizes the video,
and could add more views, so I'd
recommend we just let it blow over.

BIG BOB
Dad's going to be pissed at me if
he sees that.

He takes a bite of the taco and closes his eyes for a second.

BIG BOB (CONT'D)
Holy shit that's a good taco!

Act 5, SCENE 4 (The big Finish)

EXT THE RANCH IN WAELDER - DAY

its morning again and we'll need some Aerials of downtown Austin and then the course. We can have some talking head shots with the announcers, and then Voice Over with footage of the players doing field work. (If we can get actual pros to Play in this round, that'd be awesome).

ANNOUNCER #1

It's another beautiful morning in Austin Texas Folks. Welcome to round two of the Cap City Open!

ANNOUNCER #2

Got to love Austin, the place where the people are nice, the tacos are delicious, and of course, everyone wants to keep it weird.

ANNOUNCER #1

Speaking of tacos did you get in on some of the Free Tacos from Reyes Tortillas Y'mas? I was skeptical at first. A big hairy guy in a T-shirt with the sleeves cut off brought them up to the booth for us. But I'm telling you, that taco was heaven in a tortilla.

ANNOUNCER #2

If you had done your homework, like I have, you'd know that those tacos were made by one of our lead card player's father and grand Mother, who have quite the tailgate party set up for their boy right now.

ANNOUNCER #1

Are you talking about Gabriel Reyes? Well now I'm thinking that eating those tacos his whole life has given that kid special powers. Have you seen him throw?

ANNOUNCER #2

I have and he is a bomber! Pretty rare case and quite the Cinderella story here.

(MORE)

ANNOUNCER #2 (CONT'D)

This kid gets his PDGA number just over a month ago, signs up for a qualifier for one of the biggest tournaments in Texas, ties for second and gets in the tournament, and today he'll be on the live stream playing with some of the best players in the world.

ANNOUNCER #1

Lets "Taco" about some of those other players for a second.

ANNOUNCER #2

You really just said that didn't you?

ANNOUNCER #1

In first place right now, we have Eric Stein. He's one of the best players in the world and this is his home town. I think a lot of people came into this tournament with him penciled in as the one to beat and so far, he has delivered with a course record ELEVEN under yesterday.

ANNOUNCER #2

What an incredible round. I know he lives around here and has probably played this course more than most of the other contestants, but eleven under is just unheard of.

ANNOUNCER #1

In second place with ten under is the aforementioned Gabriel Reyes, and tied for third at minus eight we have Shawn Hall and Trey Locke. Shawn is fresh off a win at the Beast a couple of weeks ago up in Waco, and he's looking to continue his success here.

ANNOUNCER #2

After our practice round, I'd say this course is a bit of a Beast as well!

ANNOUNCER #1

Let's not forget the ageless Trey Locke.

(MORE)

ANNOUNCER #1 (CONT'D)

He's an older player that has been on the circuit for a while and he's always kind of a dark horse, isn't he?

ANNOUNCER #2

I haven't seen Trey have a bad game, but you never know when he's just going to break out and blow everyone away.

ANNOUNCER #1

It sure is fun to watch him when he gets... Locked in though.

ANNOUNCER #2

Oh boo.

The shot pans down and zooms out from the booth and goes down to hole one where the four players are stretching and warming up. All of the players have Caddies this round. Randy is pacing around Gabe fidgeting with the sleeves on his shirt.

RANDY

I just don't know how you people do it.

GABE

You really shouldn't be saying "you people" right now buddy. We're probably being live-streamed.

RANDY

The freaking sleeves man! I can't breathe.

GABE

Will you pull it together? This is it. Lead card at the Cap City Open... Now we have a tournament to win.

RANDY

You're right! What am I doing? Pull yourself together Randy!

Randy slaps himself in the face. Eric approaches with his caddie in tow along with Shawn, Trey, and their respective caddies following behind.

ERIC

Hey there Gabe. What's going on with Randy. He going to be okay?

GABE

Hi Eric! You know this is a really big stage and quite an exciting time... For him.

They both laugh.

RANDY

I really am so excited to be here right now. You're Eric Stein, and Trey Locke and Shawn Hall are behind you!

ERIC

I am, and they are!

GABE

Don't worry buddy, your antics are actually helping me not freak-out myself.

ERIC

Hey man, do whatever it was you did yesterday. Because that round was incredible!

GABE

Thanks Eric, it was good, but it wasn't new course record good!

ERIC

Bro, I had to beat my personal best by THREE strokes to beat you.

GABE

Really?

ERIC

Yeah, this course is tough, and I'm not sure I can repeat that effort. I'm sure going to try though!

GABE

Are you telling me you have some of the jitters today too? But you're Eric Freaking Stein!

TREY

You boys talking about jitters now?

SHAWN

I'm glad I'm not the only one. Lead card, live coverage, knowing that if you screw up it could become a meme or a GIF...

TREY

What's the saying, it's not about not having the jitters, it's about having them and still playing at the top of your game anyway.

GABE

I... I think that's bravery... Hi I'm Gabe!

TREY

Good to meet ya, kid. Trey Locke. And yeah, I'm nervous too. Course like this with the trees and the wind. There's plenty of opportunity for problems!

SHAWN

That's exactly the point. Let's forget that for now. Y'all ready to have a good round.

ERIC

Hell yeah!

The players fist bump. Gabe turns to Randy and sees that he's completely star struck.

GABE

You lock up for a second there, Buddy? We're about to start and I need a disc.

Randy brings a hand up to reveal he has his stick mic. He pulls out a disc, hands it to Gabe and calmly begins to break down the hole.

RANDY

We've been here before, Little Brother. Par four. Six hundred and forty feet down an alley to a split fair way. Throw this one over the gap and to get it to spike on the right side of the split. A skip could get you in the trees, so extra stable to make sure it sticks where it hits.

ERIC

(to his caddy)

My boy Randy over there had a solid breakdown and I think that's the right call. What do you think? What gets the most distance with an accurate spike?

Eric's caddy (Caddy #1) hands him a disc.

CADDY #1

He's right. If you can spike on the right side, it's a little further shot, but it's a wider lane and an easier approach. Here you go.

ERIC

(turning to the rest of the players)

Alright Fellas, good luck out there today!

Eric Throws a high spiking disc clears the first gap and spikes into the ground in the center of the right-side fairway. Gabe follows suit and drops his disc right next to Eric's. Both Trey and Shawn follow along and all four discs fall in about a six-foot circle. Gabe is out (the furthest back) but only by inches.

GABE

So, it looks like your game plan here is working for everyone.

RANDY

This next shot should be pretty easy for you from here, stable mid, curve it around the corner and hopefully lay up for an easy Birdie.

Gabe takes the disk from Randy and drops the disc about 15 feet from the basket.

RANDY (CONT'D)

Perfection!

All three other players follow Gabe's line and as they walk up to the basket, it's effectively surrounded by discs. They all make their putts for Birdies. The group cheers.

SHAWN

Star frame! Guess the order for number two stays the same.

The next camera shot goes inside a dark room with the producer, the director and audio board operator.

PRODUCER

Did you catch that?

DIRECTOR

The weird guy with the stick giving a perfect breakdown and then everyone on the card doing exactly what he said to star frame hole one? Yeah, I saw that.

PRODUCER

What's weirder for a viewer? All the players listening to a guy talking into a stick that we can't hear, or if they're listening to a mic'd up caddy?

DIRECTOR

You're saying we should give him a mic?

PRODUCER

If it doesn't work, we can just mute him and try to avoid shots of him.

AUDIO OPERATOR

I'm game as long as you tell him no profanity. I can't be bleeping him all day.

DIRECTOR

This is crazy, but I like it.

The director talks into his head phones

DIRECTOR (CONT'D)

Yeah, Jason Right? How quickly can you get a mic to Gabriel's Caddy? Yes, the big guy with the stick.

The shot goes back outside to where the players on the card are taking their shots on hole two. All four players have thrown in the same area again, but this time Gabe's throw is the furthest. They all follow the same lane for layups and it ends up being another star frame.

JASON (THE AP)

Hello sir, my name is Jason, and I'm an associate producer for the Network and I have something from the director.

RANDY

But I'm wearing a shirt with sleeves! Don't punish Gabe for a mistake that I made.

JASON

No, nothing like that. They think that you talking into a stick might be... Unsettling for the live viewers.

RANDY

Okay I can stop. Sorry again.

JASON

Hold on. They actually want to hear what you're saying. I need you to promise no profanity and, well, then you can take this.

He holds out a wireless microphone. But Randy just locks up.

GABE

(whispering)

Is everything okay?

JASON

The director said he wants to get the audio from your caddy here, but he won't take the mic.

GABE

One sec.

Gabe turns to Randy and puts his hand on the stick.

GABE (CONT'D)

You don't need this anymore buddy.

He pulls it away slowly with Randy finally letting it go, and Randy takes the microphone. He stands there motionlessly with a huge grin for a second.

GABE (CONT'D)
 (Talking into the mic)
 Okay... I can do this one on my own. We have a three-hundred-footer down a narrow alley with a curve to the left. Hand me the Red Stable Mid-Range.

Randy hands Gabe the same disc he used the day before.

GABE (CONT'D)
 I've got this, but I still need you today. Breath, and you need to fix
 (Waves his hands at all of Randy)
 this.

Randy Breaths in and calmly speaks into the microphone.

RANDY
 Statistically this one is going to get birdied today by about half the players on the field. So, it's imperative that you stay out of the trees. I know that another high spike is tempting, but you have the skill to hit this line and maybe get a skip shot at an ace.

The shot now goes to the live feed with the Announcers for the live broadcast.

ANNOUNCER #1
 Looks like our lead card has a shot at starting out with a Twerky Turkey.

ANNOUNCER #2
 Twerky Turkey? I don't think that's a thing.

ANNOUNCER #1
 Yeah, a Turkey is when you get three birdies in a row, a Twerky Turkey is when all the players on the card get a Turkey!

ANNOUNCER #2
 Still not a thing but it does make for an exciting round.

Announcer #1
 (MORE)

ANNOUNCER #2 (CONT'D)

Looks like Eric dropped his shot about twenty feet from the basket. Let's see what Gabriel can do...

Gabe's shot arcs down the lane and skips just short of the basket and flares up just enough to hit the bottom of the basket and fall right next to it.

ANNOUNCER #2 (CONT'D)

And Mr. Reyes almost puts in the first Ace of the tournament right there.

ANNOUNCER #1

Wow what a great shot! Let's see now what Trey does.

ANNOUNCER #2

Tell me, what happens to your Twerky Turkey if one of them makes an Ace?

ANNOUNCER #1

We have a beautiful shot from Trey Locke here. Looks like he was following Gabe's line, but it just didn't have the ground action. And it's still a Twerky Turkey. Just as long as they're all under par for three holes in a row.

ANNOUNCER #2

I'm impressed how you can make stuff up like this just on the fly.

ANNOUNCER #1

Shawn takes his throw, and he is also following that same low curving route, he clipped a tree on the outside of that one, but a good bounce and a putt he should still be able to make.

ANNOUNCER #2

I'm getting word that we have something special for everyone today. Apparently, we have mic'd up Mr. Reyes...es caddy, Randy, and he'll be helping out with some hole breakdowns today.

ANNOUNCER #1

Cool. Do we have a last name for Randy the Caddy?

ANNOUNCER #2

We do not. I'm not sure if he just hasn't told us or if he's like the Texas Version of Flea or Drake.

ANNOUNCER #1

He's a pretty big dude. More like the Texas Version of Sasquatch. Let's hear what he has to say.

RANDY

Hole four is a five-hundred-and-sixty-foot par four. There's a lane here that goes to about three seventy-five and then another split fair way. You can throw down either, but I'd recommend taking the right side. That way if you do get one that comes back too hard you just end up in the left gap. If you get too far left, the brush there is super thick and will make saving a birdie or even a par much more difficult.

ANNOUNCER #2

Couldn't have broken down that one better myself, and you can see Eric Stein taking his advice and driving that one straight down the right side of the alley.

ANNOUNCER #1

Our boy Randy down there pulling double duty. Full breakdowns, and he carries your pack. I'm going to invite him to our next practice round.

ANNOUNCER #2

Let's see what Gabe does. Oh man what rip! That thing just sailed right past Eric Stein's great shot.

ANNOUNCER #1

I can't believe this is only Gabe's second tournament. Can you imagine just showing up and out driving Eric Stein like it's no big deal.

ANNOUNCER #2

I absolutely cannot. That guy can throw is putter further than I can throw anything in my bag.

Music Starts up (Wild by Spoon). We see shots of the all the players throwing and discs gliding and the putters hitting the baskets. Add a few shots of Randy explaining holes and pointing while talking into the mic and all four players listening and nodding. Again at least one shot of each player shanking on into a tree (or throwing from deep in the brush)

ANNOUNCER #1

Well, we are down to the wire here at hole eighteen and it could still be anybody's win at this point. Everyone on the card has put up one bogey and either nine or ten birdies.

ANNOUNCER #2

Gabriel Reyes and Eric Stein have swapped places on the top of the box twice, but they're having almost shot for shot the same game out there today. We have the long lay out set up for last hole and that could even things out a bit, especially as the afternoon wind is starting to pick up.

ANNOUNCER #1

Let's see what our boy Randy has to say about this one.

RANDY

Well fellas, it's been such a fun round that I've forgotten how much is riding on this win for my boy Gabe. It's more than just fifty thousand dollars. It's a chance to save his family's restaurant... And a chance for redemption! The long layout on this one is a nine-hundred-and-forty-foot par five. Its a beast with an OB spot about four hundred and fifty or five hundred feet up with a water hazard on the left and then thick brush surrounding the left and right of the pin. Gabriel, I'm worried about the wind blowing a high shot over into the pond, so take this disc and do like you did yesterday with a low laser down the alley at about three-seventy-five to sit in front of the out of bounds.

GABE

You got it!

Gabe steps up to throw and it ends up being a laser that appears to be headed to exactly the right spot, but as it's going there is a head wind that lifts the disc a little and it glides into the out of bounds area by just a few inches.

ANNOUNCER #1

Unlucky. That shot looked perfect and then the wind gave it a little lift there and it went just about, what a foot past the O.B.?

ANNOUNCER #2

Brutal! That penalty shot really hurts his chances to gain a stroke on Eric. And now check out Eric and the others going just a little short to avoid the same mistake.

ANNOUNCER #1

The play here is to basically drop the next throw next to where the A pin was yesterday. That will need to be about another three-hundred-and-fifty-foot shot that doesn't drift in the wind, and then a third, not quite three hundred foot shot curving right to lay up to the basket for a shot at a birdie.

ANNOUNCER #2

That's the route for mere mortals! It looks like Eric Stein is looking to put this one away right now with a huge shot over everything that puts him just outside of circle two.

ANNOUNCER #1

Wow what a shot! Almost five hundred feet in the air and a clean spike with a shot at eagle! A long shot for sure, but a shot none the less!

ANNOUNCER #2

It looks like Trey and Shawn have accepted that the win is out of reach for them at this point and they're just trying not to make mistakes.

(MORE)

ANNOUNCER #2 (CONT'D)

They're both going to take the safe route and do like you said, dropping their second shots next to where basket A was yesterday.

ANNOUNCER #1

Yeah, with Gabe getting the O. B. stroke, they can both get into striking distance of that second place spot with smart play here.

ANNOUNCER #2

You can see Randy and Gabriel having a little conference down there now. Let's listen in.

RANDY

I forget how good your distance is sometimes brother. Sorry that this happened.

GABE

I was having such a good round, and just one throw ends up costing me a chance to get the restaurant repairs covered.

RANDY

It's not over yet brother. We can still Birdie this one, you just have to have a really awesome shot.

GABE

I need like what, five hundred feet? I don't think I have a high shot to do what Eric did.

RANDY

And you need it to curve right and not get hung up in any trees. We do have a bit of a headwind so if you get something that is just a little stable and yoke it... Maybe we can still win this thing.

Gabe throws an incredible shot. It's in the air forever and it curves to the right out of his sight.

ANNOUNCER #1

Wow what a shot! For a second there I thought it was going in!

ANNOUNCER #2

that's the type of shot you only see on the pro tour! Incredible. Five hundred and twenty feet on that one into a head wind and curving perfectly towards the basket. Gabriel isn't out of this one yet!

ANNOUNCER #1

You can see the shock on both Shawn and Trey's faces, as that throw probably just put both of them out of contention for even second place.

ANNOUNCER #2

Yeah, that mixture of disappointment and admiration. Sure, you got beat, but somebody had to have one of the best throws you've ever seen to do it.

ANNOUNCER #1

And they'll both lay up here and both of them look to be sitting just on the outside of circle one.

ANNOUNCER #2

So, what do you think Eric does here. An eagle wins the tournament if he can sink it. Its a long shot though. Just over seventy feet with a left to right wind.

ANNOUNCER #1

Well, I think we all know that Gabe is going to make his putt right, so a birdie would send us into a tie breaker. And those two have been playing so close that I think you'd have to seize the opportunity here, right?

ANNOUNCER #2

And Eric agrees with you! Wow what a rail gun! He didn't even size it up, just dropped his mini and fired that putter right into the basket! Dow we have the replay up yet.

ANNOUNCER #1

We do! That's a fifty thousand dollar shot right there!

The shot moves out of the booth and goes down to the field. Everyone is celebrating and Eric is jumping around in excitement. The other players each make their putts to finish off another great round.

TREY

Well, I was able to hang with you kids for one more round. Gabe I really thought you were going to take that one to a sudden death tie-breaker. Second place at your first pro tournament and twenty-five thousand dollars is still a really good day though!

SHAWN

Yeah, tied for third is still a good days work, and this is the most fun I've had in a pro round... Maybe ever! Thanks fellas!

Randy hands his mic back to Jason the AP. Then Randy and Gabe make their way back to the parking lot. Gilberto, Abuelita, Violet, Juliet and Pacito are tailgating again. A small crowd has gathered around and everyone is laughing, and eating tacos. A cheer goes up as the Gabe and Randy approach.

JULIET

There they are!

She runs to embrace Gabe and she looks up at him.

JULIET (CONT'D)

Why the long face? Mi amor? You played so well today! Also, look at your dad.

Gabe looks and Gilberto is smiling and talking to everyone.

GILBERTO

There's my boy! Did you guys see that? My Mijo, making the best disc golfer in the world sweat it out for eighteen holes!

At this point Randy has taken off his shirt (which was a collared polo) and is cutting off the sleeves. Gilberto comes over and hugs him on a bear hug.

GILBERTO (CONT'D)

And this gringo grande out there breaking down holes and talking about our restaurant. Look at this Randy.

Gilberto pulls out his phone and shows Randy

GILBERTO (CONT'D)

Do you see that? Over half way to our goal already! The people of Austin and the disc golf community don't want to see Reyes' Tortillas Y'Mas shut down! Our tacos are just too good!

RANDY

Oh, hell yeah!

GABE

Dad, are you serious? I was so worried that because I didn't win today that we wouldn't be able to remodel the restaurant.

Gilberto takes Gabe to the side of the car and puts a hand on each of his shoulders.

GILBERTO

Come here Mijo. I want you to understand something because I know I don't always communicate clearly. The fire at the restaurant was not your fault. The patio and the kitchen equipment being out of code was not your fault, and I should not have made you feel like it was your responsibility to fix everything. We are a family, and we all work together. I'm proud of you Mijo. Thank you for always being here for all of us.

GABE

Thanks for saying that, Dad.

GILBERTO

And I was wrong about disc golf. It's so much more than a just kid's game!

GABE

What about Randy?

GILBERTO

That gringo is still weird. But he's family now too, and I love him! Now let's get back to the party!

As the two go back into the small crowd you can see Big Bob approaching with another man who's wearing a Bat City Discs Hat. It's an older version of the man from the very beginning.

BIG BOB

Hey Gabe, I want to introduce you to a friend of mine.

CHAD

I'm Chad Gordon with Bat City Discs.

GABE

Nice to meet you.

CHAD

Like most everyone here, I watched you play that amazing round. The talent along with the great sportsmanship that you've exhibited today is exactly what we're looking for in our sponsored players.

GABE

Thanks, I've met a few of your sponsored players, and they've all been really supportive of me and just super cool in general.

CHAD

Well in short, we can iron out the details later, but I'd love to have you join or team, and I can offer a substantial signing bonus if you're willing to sign a one-year contract.

GABE

That sounds amazing. And honestly, I think it was meant to be.

Gabe goes to the back of the car and pulls the old green disc out of his bag.

GABE (CONT'D)

It's been a long time, but I think it was you who gave me my first disc.

Chad takes the disc and turns it over in his hands

CHAD

A first run White Wolf... I do remember you kid. Took all of two tries to start throwing solid distance. I can't believe that was you!

Chad hands the disk back to Gabe.

GABE

I would absolutely love to play for Bat City Disc Golf.

Gabe smiles and holds the disc up and shakes it a little.

GABE (CONT'D)

And thanks again for the disc!

Freeze Frame and roll credits.

Over the credits we get pictures of each character with a breakdown of how their story continues.

Gabe continues to tour the country (and abroad) as an ambassador of the sport of Disc Golf. He also works with Katy and Steve with their disc golf based youth outreach program.

Juliet took up the sport and within a couple of years began competing professionally. Her putt is more accurate than Gabe's.

Randy was eventually hired as an announcer by a network that covers disc golf. He can still be found mowing out at his disc golf course at least once a week, in his spare time he live-streams practice rounds with Gabe. He still never wears sleeves.

Violet got a degree in Social Services and works to help people that have dealt with accidents or tragedy. She still plays disc golf with Gabe and Randy whenever Gabe is in town.

Katy retired from disc golf, but she and Steve continue to work at their outreach program for troubled youths, and run amateure tournaments all over central Texas.

Pacito hit a growth spurt and no one questions calling him Paco Loco anymore. His kitchen skills earned him some internet fame and people come from all over the country to try Paco Loco's Taco Loco, which is served at Reyes Tortillas Y'Mas as he eventually partnered with Gilberto and Abuelita to help run the restaurant and open two other franchise locations.

Big Bob continued to chase a disc golf career and eventually succeeded and got a couple of wins. He matured as a business man and Big Bobs Burritos is still doing well. However, some of his employees still describe him as "Kind of a Douche."
