



Ages: 5–adult

Players: 2 or more

Contents: Game instructions and score sheet.

You will need: One coin of the same size and denomination for every player.

Object of the game: To have the highest amount of points after 16 rounds.

Setup: Players must use same size and denomination coin to flip.

When a coin is flipped it must flip at least 3 times in the air and land on the playing surface or the floor (not in or on a player's hand). The results must be seen by all players.

After each flip players record the point(s) for getting the side of coin indicated for that round in his/her column.

If player does not get the side of the coin indicated for a round, place a big fat zero in that space.

How to play: Heads/Tails—Each player flips their coin and records the point if they get the side of coin indicated for that round in his/her column.

The “Together Flip”—Players flip coins at the same time and when coins are in the air one of the players call heads or tails. The player(s) that have the side called enter the points in his/her column. (Players decide who calls the side.)

The “Double Flip”—Each player flips their coin twice and records the total points in his/her column.

Winning: The player with the highest score at the end of the game gets all the other players game coin(s).

In the event of a tie for the win the players that are tied must flip their coins and the player with heads is the winner.

Please return all coins back to the rightful owner when finishing playing, or not.
