We provide a variety of counseling and support services to individuals living in South Jersey. We work with individuals who need help with traditional substance use disorders and co-occurring mental health in outpatient care.

Partial Care (PHC – Substance Abuse Primary with Co-occurring services)
Services are designed for adults needing a daily structured treatment program to address his or her substance abuse and/or mental health concerns. A total of 20-25 hours of treatment services will be provided weekly about 5 hours a day Monday - Friday.

Intensive Outpatient (IOP)

Services are designed for an adult who can benefit from professional treatment more than once per week to address his or her substance abuse or co-occurring mental health concerns. A total of 9 hours of treatment services will be provided weekly.

General Outpatient (GOP)
