He later re-married to Sarah Guy. George was a fisherman and plied his trade until 1939. He, along with a young companion, Gordon Peach, disappeared while hauling their fishing nets. No trace of either of them was ever found. His closest living descendant in Arnold's Cove is Effie (Guy) Wareham
