I, the undersigned, hereby request Jerico Services/Husker Chem to make **two applications** of dust suppression in the described location with the permission of the Harrison County Road Department.

The applicant agrees to the following:

- 1. **DEADLINE FOR SIGN-UP IS APRIL 18th.** Application **MUST** be received by this date in order to be on the list for the first application. **Late applications will be added to the list for second treatment only**.
- 2. To measure area and maintain flags identifying the outer limits of the area to be treated. Flags must be in place by April 18th and kept visible until October 1st. Flags not only identify for our drivers specifically where the treatment should be applied, they also serve as a visual reminder for the blade operator of treated area. Failure to identify the treated area may result in your dust control being bladed through. Neither the county nor Jerico Services/Husker Chem assumes any liability if your flags are not in place and visible. Our trucks are equipped to allow us to spray the exact amount of footage ordered. Flags set longer/shorter than paid, will result in treatment short of, or longer than the flagged area.
- 3. The county reserves the right to blade the treated area if it is deemed necessary for the safety of the public.
- 4. Jerico Services/Husker Chem does not guarantee the performance of the product due to factors such as weather, surface preparation or heavy traffic patterns.
