The Applicant agrees to the following:

- 1. DEADLINE FOR SIGN-UP IS May 5th. Applications received after May 5th will be added to the list for second treatment only.
- 2. To place and maintain markers identifying the outer limits of the area to be treated. Markers must be in place be May 8th and kept visible until October 1st. Markers not only identify for our drivers specifically where the treatment should be applied, they also serve to visually remind the blade operator as to the location of the treated area. Failure to identify the treated area may result in your dust suppression being bladed through. Neither the county nor Jerico Services/Husker Chem assumes any liability if your markers are not visible. If markers are not visible, our drivers will use their best judgment, or center on your house.
- 3. Mills County reserves the right to scarify, blade or shape the treated area if it is deemed necessary to maintain public safety. Mills County does not warrant, nor pay to place dust suppression. All roads are subject to blading and rocking after **October 1**st.
- 4. Jerico Services/Husker Chem does not guarantee the performance of the product due to factors such as weather, surface preparation or heavy traffic patterns.
