SAFETY AND OTHER INFORMATION

- APBA Membership. To be permitted on the water or in the hot pits, you must be a member of the American Power Boat Association and minimum age of 16. You are responsible for showing that you are an APBA member. The Registrar cannot accept outdated cards. Please contact APBA if you have not received a current card. Single event memberships at \$25 will be available at registration.
- **SBRBC Membership.** Drivers and riders must be members of the SBRBC or another APBA associated club to be on the water. SBRBC membership is \$60.
- Waiver of Liability. All participants must sign an APBA approved waiver of liability and release form. Parents or guardians of minors must sign waiver and release form. If a minor will not be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian to a race, the Minor Release may be completed by the parent or legal guardian off-site. The original must be brought to the race site, printed in color, notarized and should not be folded.
- Boat Registration. All boats must be pre-registered and inspected PRIOR to the start of on water events. NO
 inspections will be allowed after the on water events and the drivers meeting has happened. Every on the
 water boat MUST have a functional Liteceiver installed.
- Physical Exam. All drivers "at the age of 60 years or older" must have a physical examination dated within the last 2 years. Use the APBA or other approved physical form. Please bring the completed medical form with you to registration. This includes any and all RIDERS as well.
- Safety Inspection. All boats must be inspected prior to entering the course. Inspections will take place on Friday from 10:00 AM to 4:30 PM. It is the responsibility of the Owner/Driver to contact an inspector. Have all safety equipment available. Must sign the APBA safety inspection sheet with APBA number or APBA single event membership number. Kill switches are mandatory. Secondary throttle return springs must be present. Turnbuckles must be safety wired. Fire extinguishers, minimum 5 lbs., must be readily accessible in the hot pit area. ALL props must be covered in the hot pit area. Boat numbers MUST be displayed on the trailer as well as on both sides of the boat
- **Driving Safety.** Only owners of boats will be allowed to drive unless they have prior approval from the Event Referee at the event. All drivers must sign the APBA Entry Form for the boat in which they are riding. Any unsafe operation of boats will be addressed.
- Consumption of Alcohol. No one shall participate on the water, nor shall any official serve in an official capacity, after having consumed alcohol or controlled substances or while intoxicated. Consumed shall mean from midnight before the day of the event. The Referee will have an approved portable breathalyzer onsite. Crew members are not exempt. Direct any driving safety concerns to the Drivers' Representative at the event.
- Personal Safety Gear. Helmets and jackets must be consistent with APBA approved guidelines. Goggles, face shields or V&H approved eyewear required. Drivers must wear appropriate driving gear with long sleeves, long pants and closed toe shoes. All crew must wear closed toe shoes in the pits.

Regatta Pit Rules and Requirements

- 1. ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING AT ANY TIME Hot or Cold Pits
- 2. All crew members who enter the pits and drivers must be an APBA member, sign the waiver at registration table and obtain a wristband to enter the pits when HOT.
- 3. All visitors during the lunch break must sign the waiver at the registration table and obtain a wristband before entering the COLD pits.
- 4. DO NOT ABUSE the Judges, Officials or Volunteers.
- 5. Do not communicate with the Crane or tractor operators. The Pit Bosses will handle all communication with them.
- 6. EVERYONE IN THE PITS AT ALL TIMES MUST WEAR CLOSED TOED SHOES.
- 7. No pets allowed in the pits at any time HOT or COLD!
- 8. No vehicles inside the pits EXCEPT Tractors and regatta vehicles.
- 9. NO ENGINES TO BE STARTED BEFORE 8:30 AM BOTH DAYS !!!!!!!!!!
