

Our annual meeting takes place on Wednesday, March 20, at the Chelwood Christian Reformed Church near the corner of Chelwood Park and Menaul. Joining us will be City



Councilor Renee Grout, District 9, and her Policy Analyst, Rachel Miller. They will share information on District 9 updates and projects, and efforts to improve our Brentwood Hills Park. Representatives or officers from the APD Foothills Area Command Center may join us to discuss ongoing safety and security. This will be an excellent time to meet safety and city staff and ask questions about improving our community. Primary concerns continue to be auto thefts, auto burglaries, residential trespassing, drug and narcotic violations, and speeding.

ONA's mission is to keep our neighborhood safe. Safety and security will be of paramount importance as neighborhoods evolve and we adjust to unforeseen changes. Our community comprises youngsters, oldsters, and everyone in between; active and disabled, independent and dependent, and we rely on each other for support in many ways.
