The purpose of the Southridge High School Music Booster Scholarship is to recognize and support the future educational endeavors of music students who are focused on achieving career goals through higher education.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Be a graduating senior from Southridge High School.
- Have earned a Letter in Music at Southridge High School.
- Plan to be enrolled full-time in an accredited college, university, technical institute, or trade school.
- Have achieved a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher in High School.
- Complete a 300-500 word Essay (double space; 12 point font) titled: ***What role has music played in my life?***
- Have participated in the Southridge Music Program during your senior year (e.g., enrolled in a music class; volunteer for stage hand at concerts, or sponsored festivals.)
- Volunteered for one (minimum) music supported event during your senior year [credit is given for parent participation.] Opportunities include Music Booster fundraisers, back stage support, music equipment transport/maintenance, clothing fitting/maintenance, etc.)
- Turn in a completed application form and all paperwork to the Southridge High School Music Boosters box located in the Choir and Instrumental Music Rooms, or by contacting the Music Boosters President at (509) 521-2247 by **May 10, 2019**. Any incomplete or late forms will be rejected and the student deemed ineligible.

MUSIC BOOSTER ACTIONS

The Southridge High School Music Boosters Scholarship Committee will review the applications and determine the recipient.

RECEIPT OF FUNDS

Prior to the release of funds, the recipient must show proof of enrollment in a qualified educational program. Funds are to be requested through the SHS Music Booster Treasurer. The scholarship check will be made payable for the benefit of the student, to the school they will be attending, but not the student themselves.

UNALLOCATED FUNDS

Any scholarship funds not redeemed by March 1 (unless other arrangements have been made with the SHS Music Treasurer) will be rescinded and the funds will be retained in the SHS Music Booster general account.
