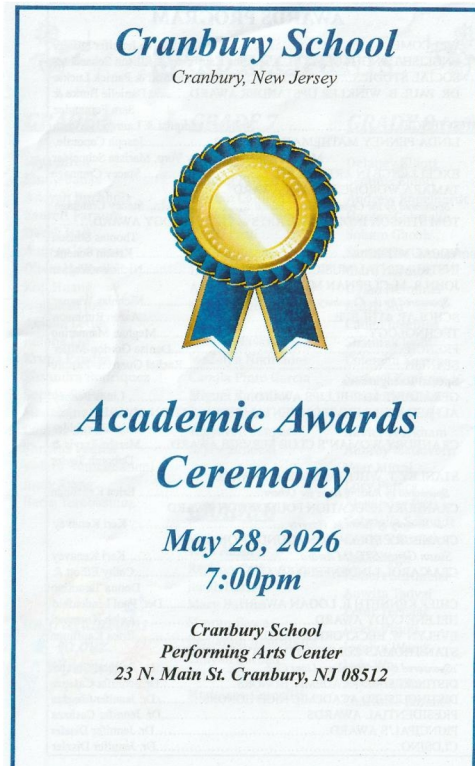


Cranbury Township Events
