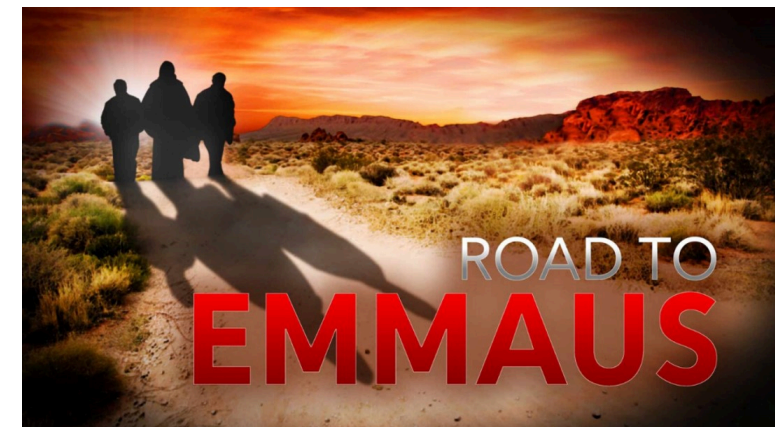
Saturday Mass Added - Mass is offered on the first and third Saturdays of the month at 5:00 pm.
