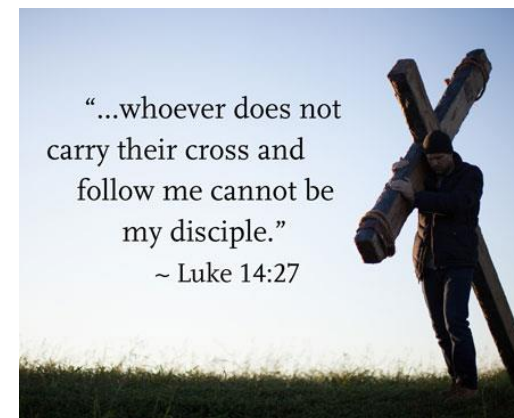
Special Collection for the Retired Religious. The official collection is on Sept 25, but Father Michael would like to begin the collection this weekend and carry forward until Oct 2nd.
