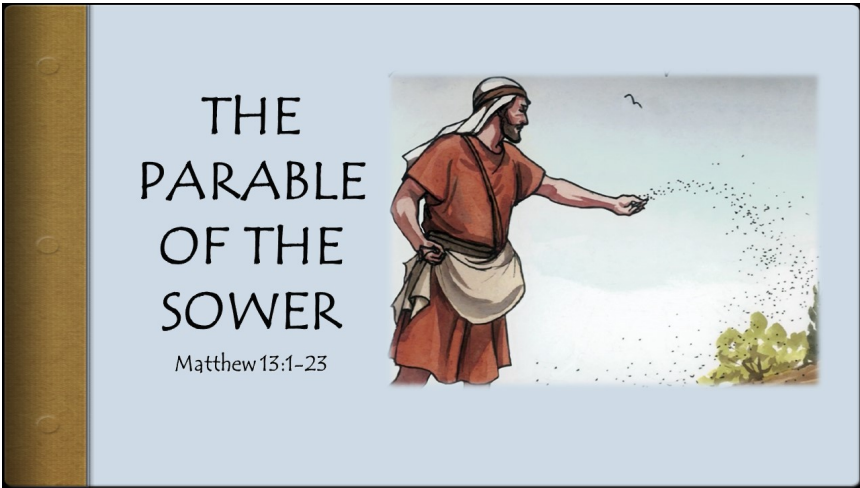
Vocations - "The seed that falls on good ground will yield a fruitful harvest." (Matthew 13:23)
